

DSWD DROMIC Report #11 on the Earthquake Incident in Leyte as of 21 July 2017, 4PM

SUMMARY

1. Number of Affected Families / Persons

- a) To date, **4,130 families** or **16,052 persons** have been affected in **27 barangays** in **Region VIII** (see Table 1).¹

- b) **20 Evacuation Centers** are currently open with **2,070 families** or **8,439 persons**; while **1,954 families** or **7,426 persons** are staying outside the ECs with their relatives or friends (see Table 2).¹

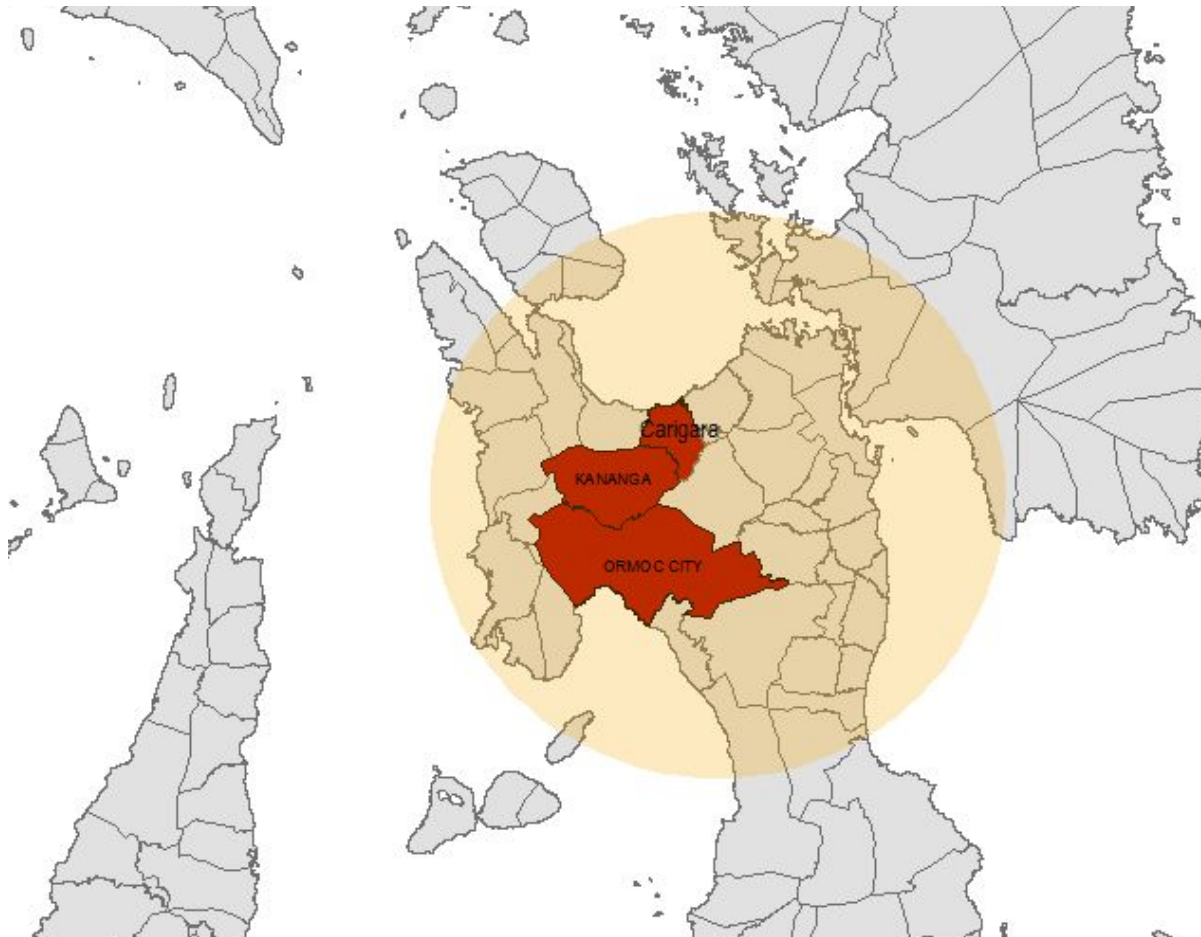

The significant decrease in the number of affected families is due to the ongoing validation conducted by the staff from the City government of Ormoc joined by DSWD FO SWAD teams. Validation activities for the other affected barangays in Ormoc City is still on-going.

2. Damaged Houses

To date, there are a total of **3,639 damaged houses** in Region VIII; **2,155** of which are **partially damaged** while **1,484 are totally damaged** (see Table 3).

16 July 2017, 6PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A total of P293,700.00 was provided by DSWD to cover the hospital bills (P238,700.00) and additional financial assistance (P55,000.00) of the 39 injured individuals. SM Foundation has donated relief packs (containing the following items: 7 pcs. Noodles, 2 tins sardines, 1 tin meatloaf, 1 kg. rice, 6 liters bottled water): 1,000 relief packs for Ormoc City, and 1,000 relief packs for Kananga, Leyte Received the following donations from North Western Samar State University (NWSSU), USWAG, SONS, TCES, FHAR, CCNHS, SPNHS, SARSA - Main Campus: 300 packs family food packs (4 bottled water, 2 instant noodles, 3 biscuits, 2 canned goods); 5 kg. rice; 23 pcs. soap; 12 sachets milo; 10 pcs. 3-in-1 coffee; 12 tins mega sardines Received the following donations from North Western Samar State University (NWSSU) – San Jorge ISSC, Buenavista National High School and San Jorge National High School: 67 packs rice; 50 packs family food pack (1 kl rice & 1 sardines); and 142 pcs. noodles. Power supply has been partially restored; although still experiencing rotational power brown out.
8 July 2017, 2:00PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Burial assistance was already provided to the families of the 2 dead persons. Additional cash assistance of P5,000 each shall also be given to them by Monday of next week.
7 July 2017, 6:00PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DSWD-FO VIII provided initial relief augmentation to Ormoc City including 100 Family Food Packs (FFPs), 200 pcs. malong, 100 pcs. blankets, 100 pcs mats, 67 pcs Australian Tents and one tent from UNHCR. In Kananga, Leyte, 2 casualties (dead) were reported: 1 caretaker of the building and 1 participant of the SLP training of security guards. Out of the 60 participants in the SLP training of security guards, 3 individuals were injured, and the rest already went home. No reported casualties and damages on infrastructures in Jaro, Leyte. Electric switch yard in the municipality collapsed. The entire region is experiencing power blackout due to damage of 2 units of 138 KVA power distribution line in Tongonan, Ormoc City where the geothermal plant is located. Communication networks are up and functional except for poor, unstable internet connection.

6 July 2017, 8:30 PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 60 families in Ormoc City have already camped outside their houses due to fear of the aftershocks. They are in need of tents, as reported by the SWADT member. • 40 individuals were brought to the hospital for treatment of minor injuries such as bruises; they have already went home after treatment.
6 July 2017, 7PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All SWAD Teams had already been alerted and directed to closely coordinate with the LSWDOs.
6 July 2017, 6PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The DSWD-Field Office VIII is currently coordinating with the concerned LGUs to determine the extent of damage and the number of affected families. • Ongoing assessment of Municipal Action Teams in coordination with Municipal Social Welfare Offices (MSWO) and Local Government Units (LGUs)

7 July 2017, 6:00 PM to Present	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DReAMB Central Office is on Blue Alert. • DSWD RETT Team is on standby and ready for deployment to FO VIII. • The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of the DSWD is continuously coordinating with DSWD-Field Office VIII for updates on the extent of damages and number of affected families and individuals.
7 July 2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DReAMB has prepared 15,000 Family Food Packs for delivery to FO VIII. Needed documents are ready for the procurement of Family Tents for possible augmentation. • DSWD FO VIII was directed to activate the Regional Response Cluster for immediate response. The National Response Cluster is currently activated in Iligan City in response to the ongoing conflict in Marawi City while at the same time monitoring the incident in Region 8.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of the DSWD continues to closely coordinate with the concerned DSWD-Field Offices for significant reports on the response actions for the Earthquake Incident in Leyte.
