HUMANITARIAN SITUATION

People in the Central African Republic continue to face insecurity and threats to their well-being: one in five Central Africans is internally displaced or a refugee in neighboring countries. In 2023, the number of people in need of humanitarian assistance and protection is estimated at 3.4 million, of which 2.4 million are targeted by the Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP).

From January to June 2023, humanitarian actors provided life-saving assistance to **1,045,382** people, at least in one sector. However, gaps remain in assistance provided to affected populations, with several sectors receiving little or no funding compared to the same period in 2022. This situation has been further aggravated by the effects of the current crises in the Sudan and southern Chad, which have led to the massive influx of returnees and asylum-seekers to the northeast and northwest of the country, and the increase in food prices are exacerbating the vulnerabilities of the population.

Estimated funding needs for the 2023 humanitarian response has increases from \$465 million to \$533.3 million, due to the addendum developed in May in response to the impact of the Sudan crisis on Central African Republic. As of June 30, only **34.5% of funds have been mobilized**, leaving a shortfall of \$349.4 million.

STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES (SO)

SO1- In 2023, the critical physical and mental well-being needs of 1.2 million shock-affected people are met in a timely manner by inclusive multisectoral emergency assistance that protects their human rights.

SO2- In 2023, the living conditions of 1.8 million people affected by protracted displacement or the impact of crises on their resilience are improved and their human rights protected.

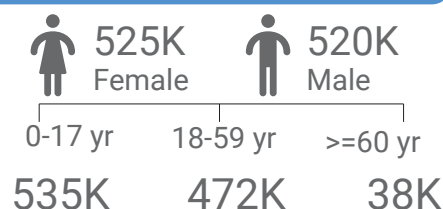

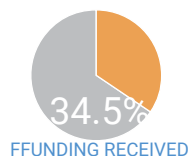
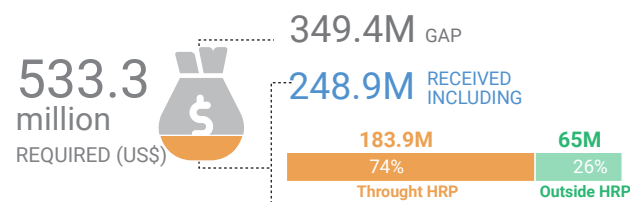

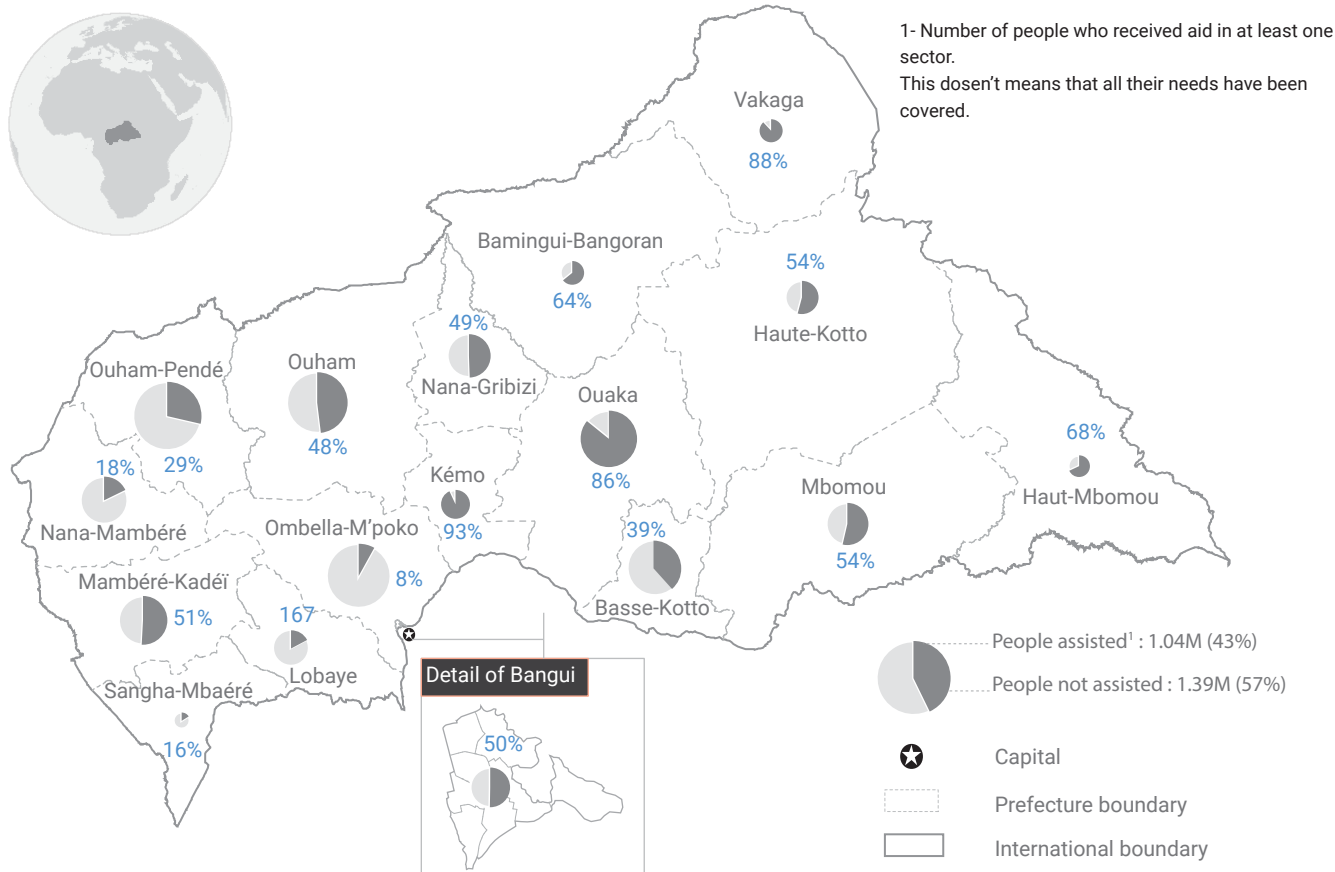

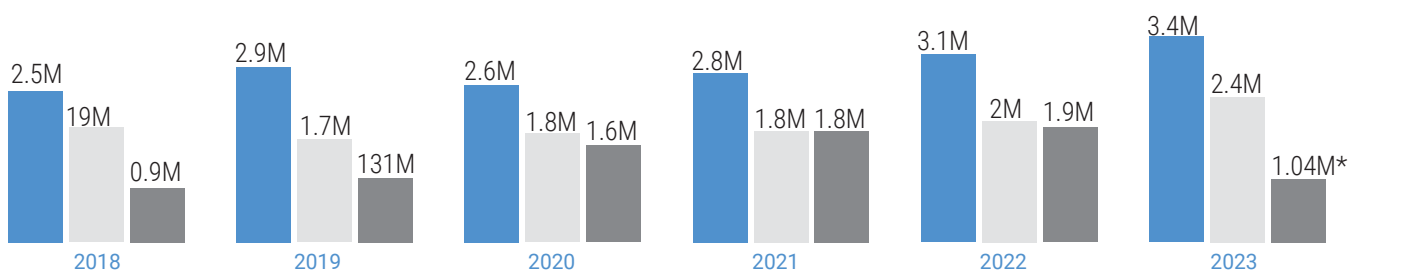

PIN, TARGET AND ASSISTED TREND BY YEAR

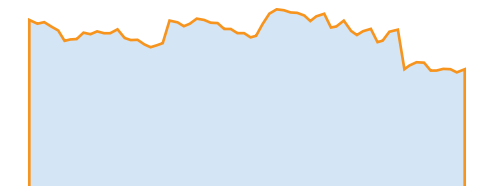

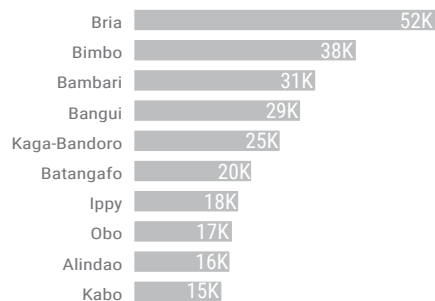

TOP 10 PREFECTURES HOSTING IDPs



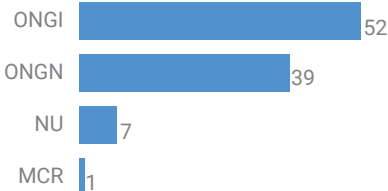
