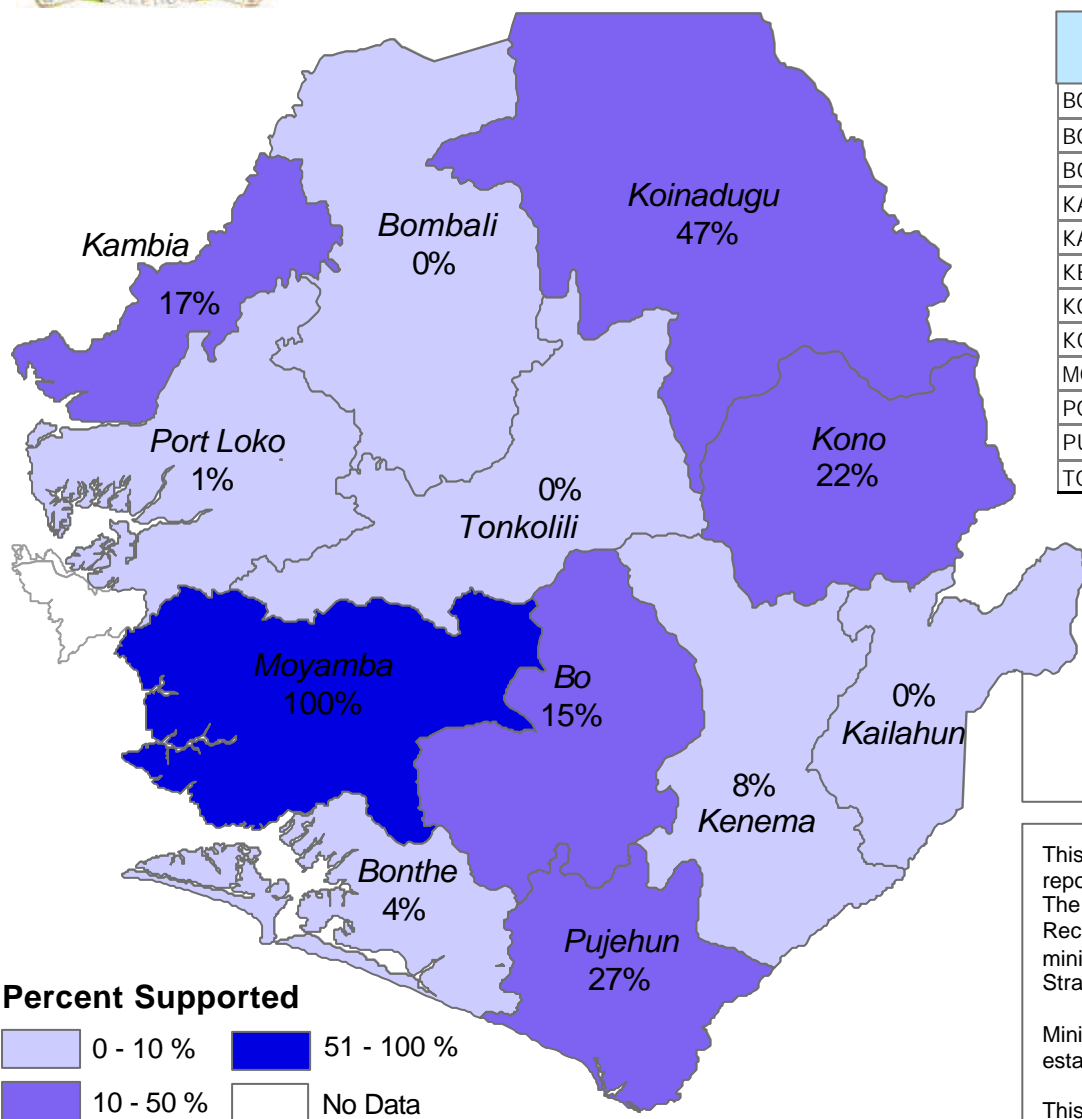




Percentage of Separated Children Receiving Community Support

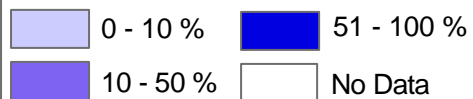

Of 3002 registered separated children outside Western Area, 532 were receiving, or had received community-based support (18%).
