



Chad: Refugees from the Central African Republic

"Some 10,000 refugees from the Central African Republic, mainly women and children, have crossed the border into southern Chad."



SITUATION

Due to the conflict between the government of the Central African Republic and a group of unidentified armed men, refugees are being displaced into Chad. A relocation operation to move the refugees to an existing camp in Gore is underway.

ACTION

Chad Red Cross and UNHCR will assist transporting refugees from the CAR border to the Amboko refugee camp near Gore. Chad Red Cross is also providing health assistance, food and non-food distributions.
