



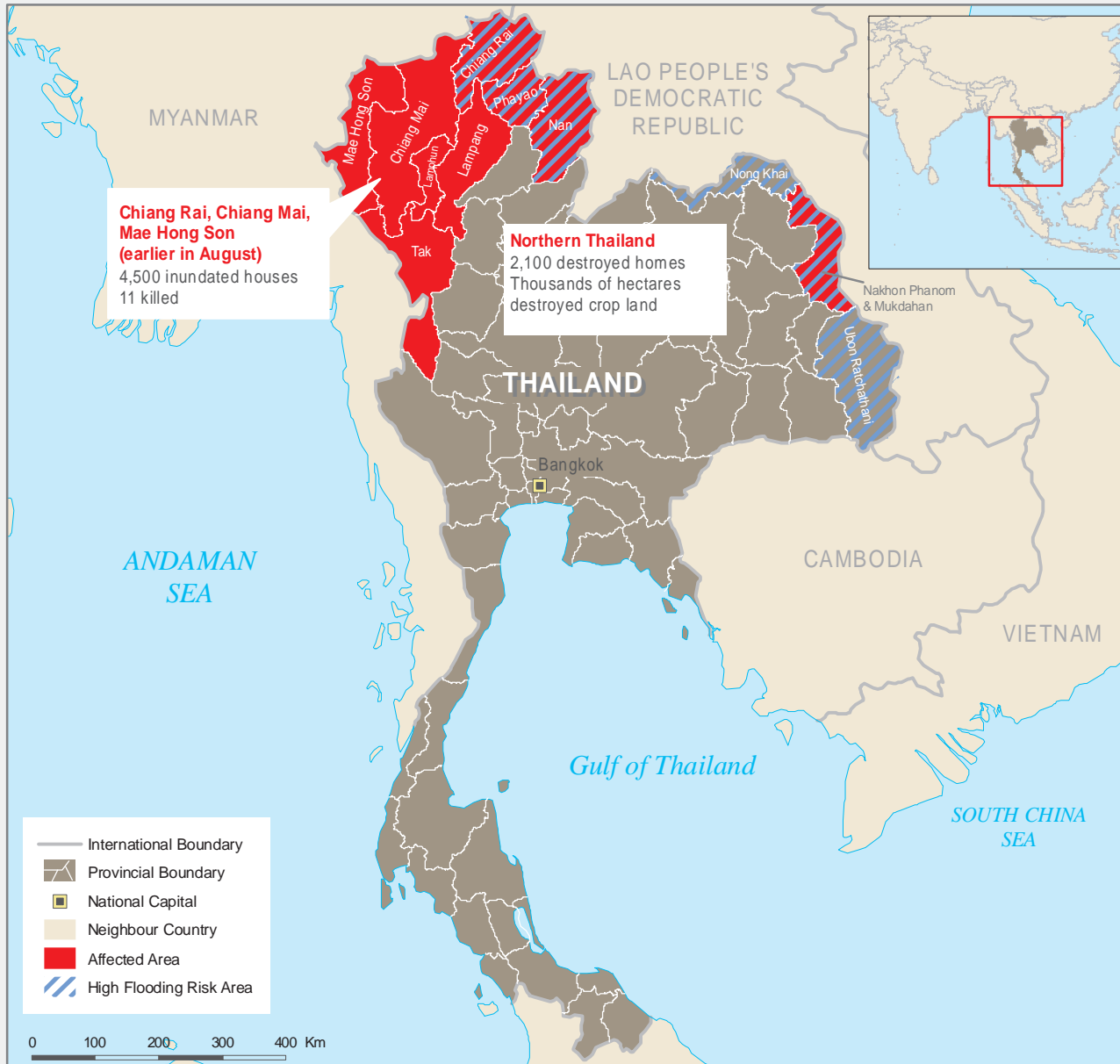
Thailand: Floods

"Over 100,000 families have been affected by severe flooding in Northern Thailand...which commenced in the middle of August."



SITUATION

100,000 families affected by major flooding in northern Thailand. Damage to housing and agriculture due to torrential rains and flooding along Ping river. Possibility of flash floods in seven provinces in north and northeast.

ACTION

Thai Red Cross Society distributed 5,900 parcels and medicine kits in Chiang Mai; 1,000 in Nakhon Phanom province.
