OCHA Situation Report No. 1

"Social and economic demands together with the Government's plan for exporting national gas led to large demonstrations that caused violent clashes, especially during the week of 11 to 17 October."

According to the most recent information, around 70 people died and 400 were wounded. Impact on infrastructure included damage to: roads, railroads, parks, electric posts, traffic lights, footbridges, urban and public properties and facilities.

El Alto:

Total cost of damages: USD 373,400
 Access to the international airport interrupted
 Declared an emergency zone

La Paz:

Total cost of damages: USD 167,000
 All access highways blocked
 Declared an emergency zone
