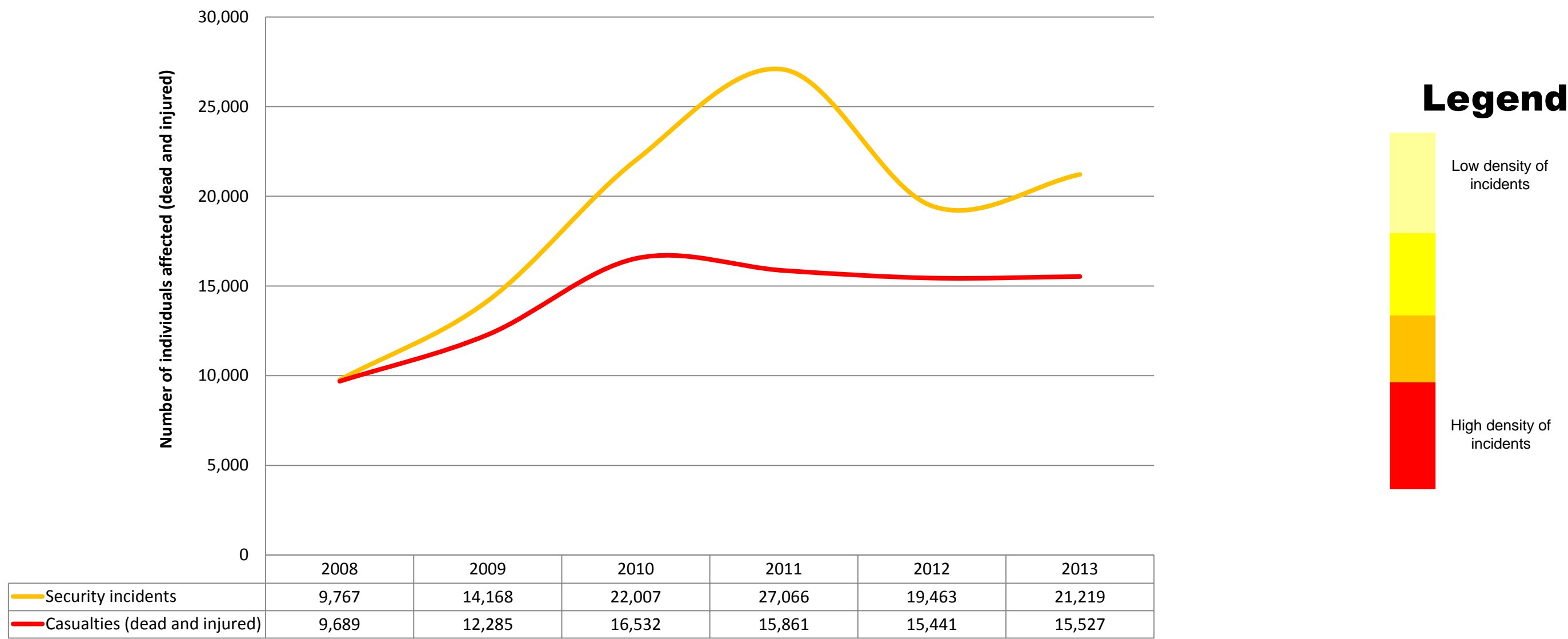
Spatial density of security incidents observed for the period 2008 to 2013 for all the categories monitored

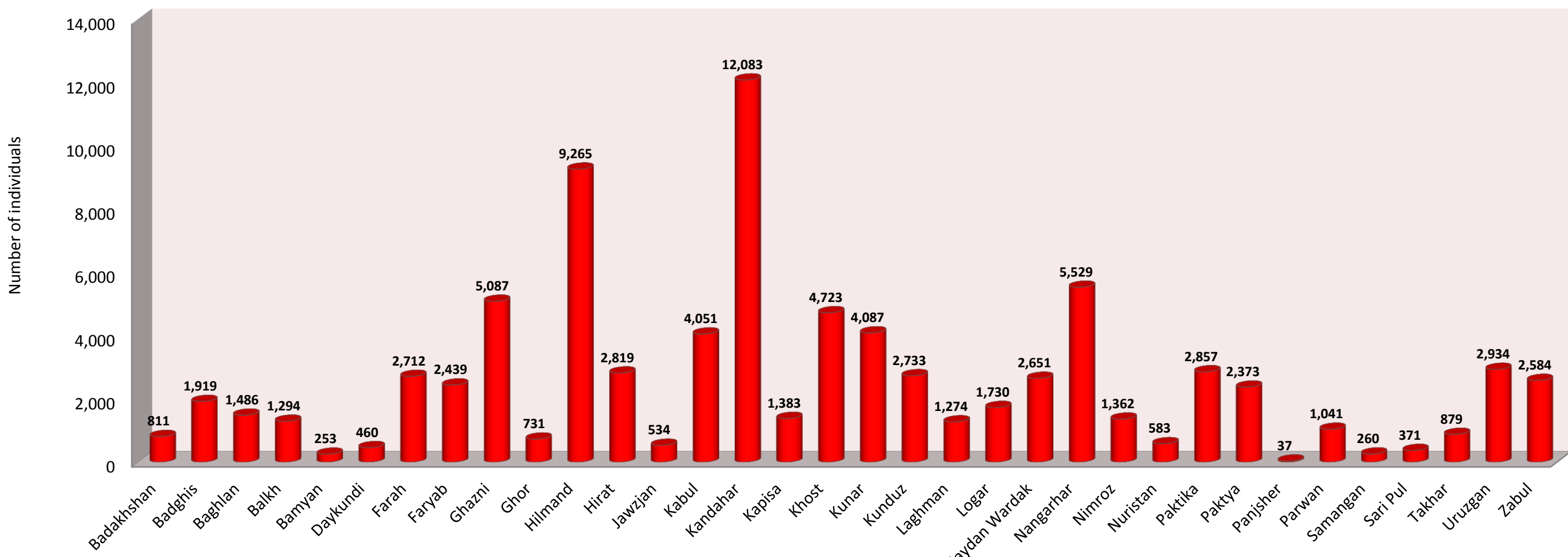
Comparison between number of security incidents monitored and number of individuals affected (dead and injured) for the period 2008 to 2013
