

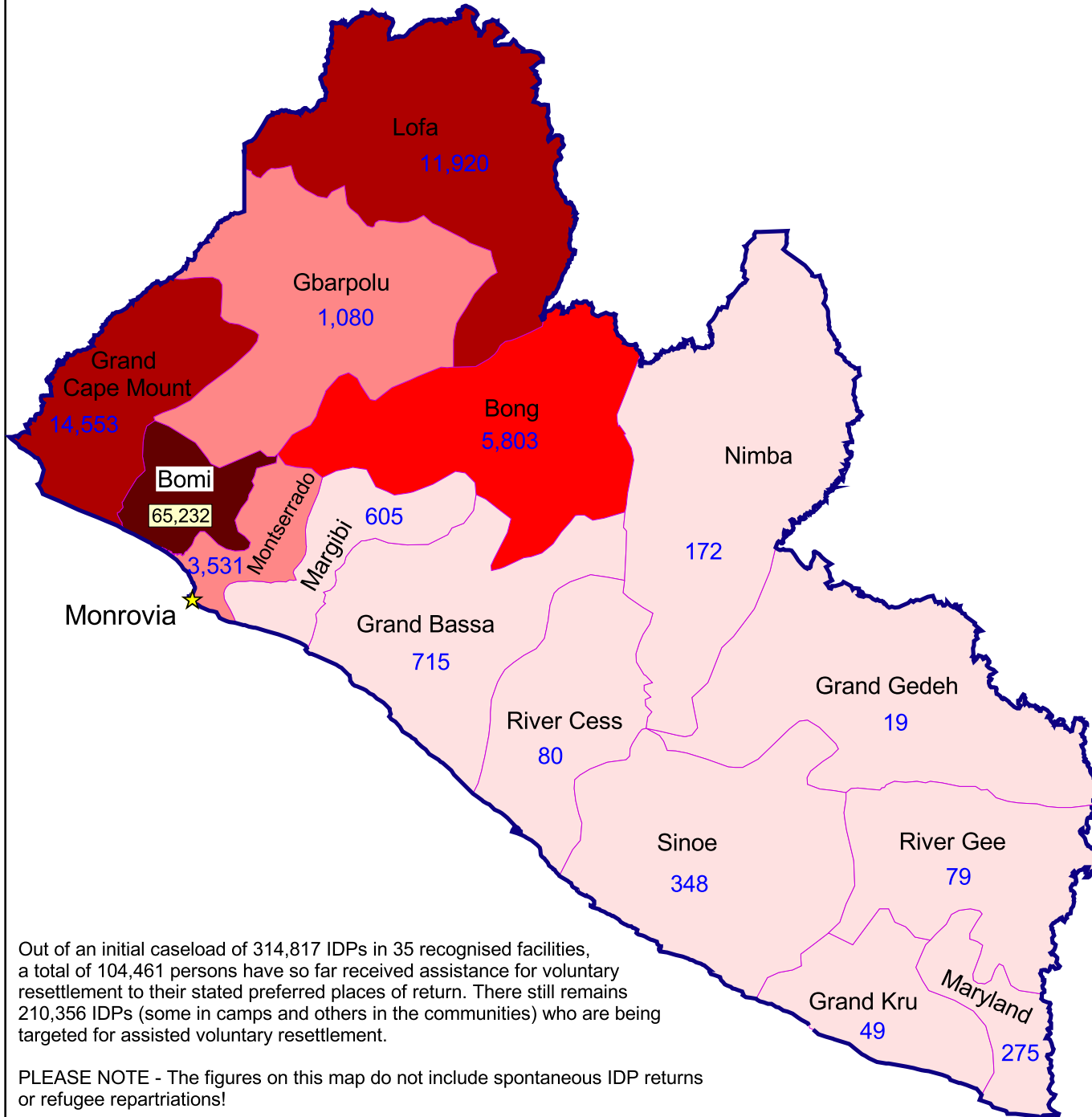
IDP Resettlements Update

Boundaries depicted do not represent official endorsement by the Government of Liberia or by the United Nations. Many boundaries were derived from small scaled maps and will be updated as soon as better information is available.

Out of an initial caseload of 314,817 IDPs in 35 recognised facilities, a total of 104,461 persons have so far received assistance for voluntary resettlement to their stated preferred places of return. There still remains 210,356 IDPs (some in camps and others in the communities) who are being targeted for assisted voluntary resettlement.

PLEASE NOTE - The figures on this map do not include spontaneous IDP returns or refugee repatriations!

Resettlement assistance package for recognised IDP households ready to voluntarily resettle comprises: a two months' food ration, transportation allowance (or assistance in the case of vulnerables) to their declared place of preferred return and a unit of NFI kit.
