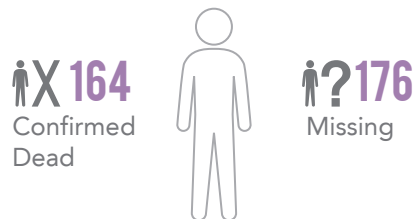
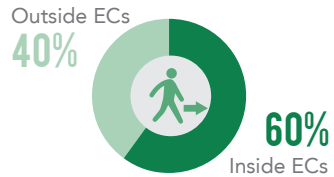
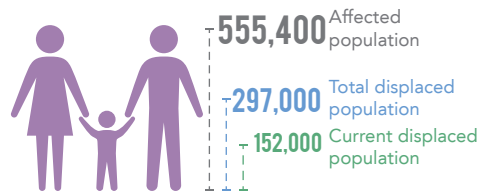
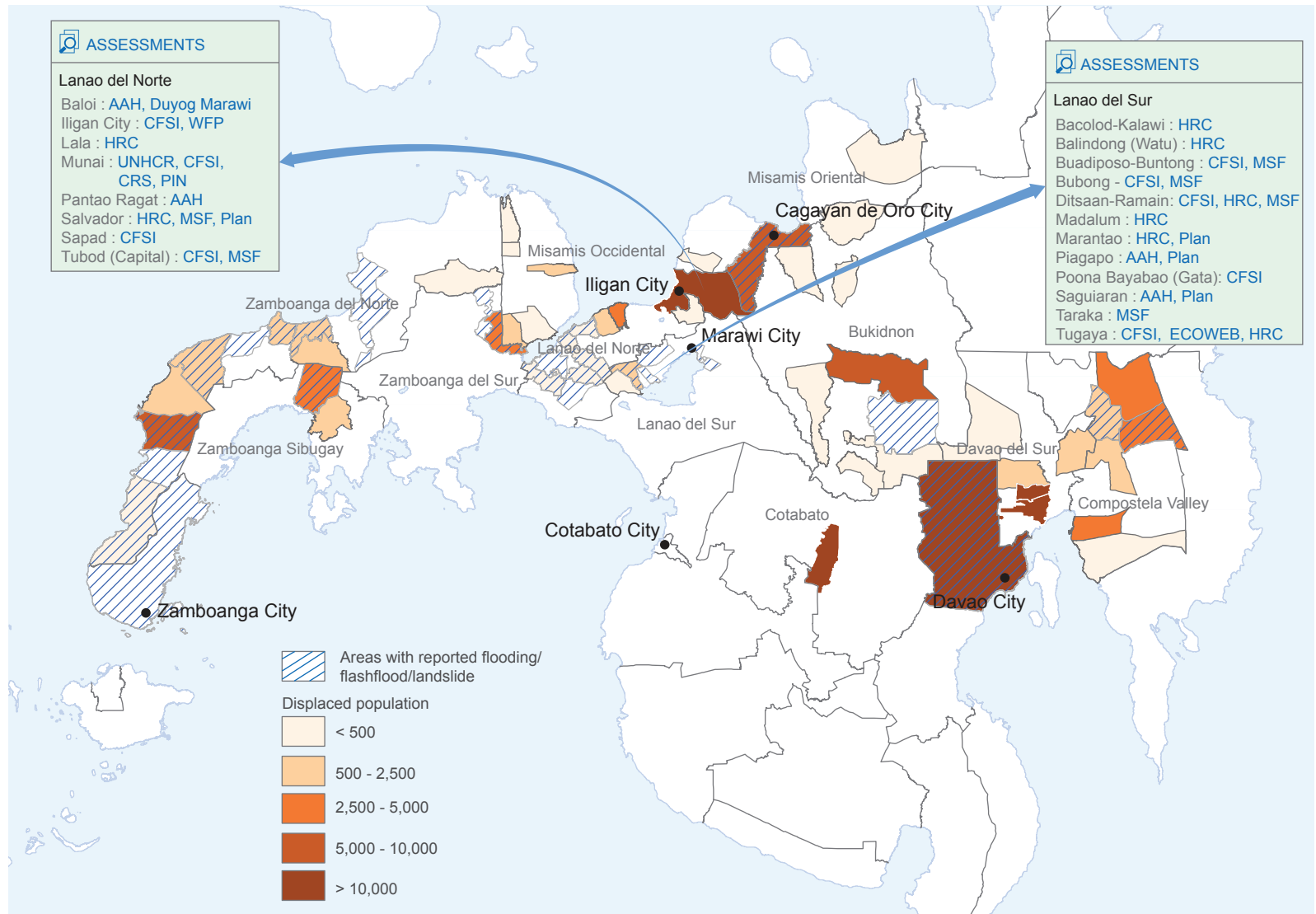




Tropical storm Tembin (TS) made landfall in Davao Oriental in the morning of 22 December and crossed various provinces across Mindanao causing flash floods and landslides. Severe flooding and landslides have been reported in Cagayan de Oro City and in a number of towns in Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Zamboanga del Norte and Zamboanga Sibugay provinces. The Mindanao Humanitarian Team and its local partners are undertaking needs assessment and supporting local government units in the humanitarian response.



NDRRMC is still validating the total deaths with the numbers expected to rise as search, rescue and retrieval teams locate the missing people believed to be buried in mud or swept by flood waters.
