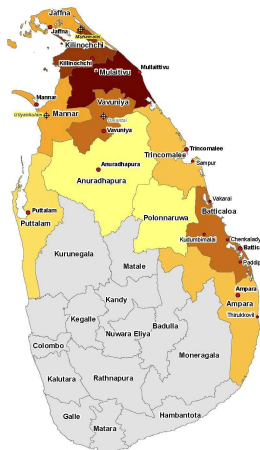

JAFFNA DISTRICT

Situation update

- The security situation remained tense across Jaffna District during the reporting period and regular artillery shelling continued. The areas close to the FDLs, mainly around Muhumalai and Nagarkovil, were particularly volatile, with armed clashes and military confrontations reported almost daily. On 30 October, heavy fighting was reported at the FDLs close to Eluthumadduwal, followed by artillery shelling by the LTTE from Poonaryn towards SLA positions. Fighting and shelling in this area was again reported on 3 November.
- During the early hours of 2 November, a flotilla of naval craft was attacked off the coast of Nagarkovil by LTTE Sea Tigers and a battle ensued.
- Restrictions on telecommunication remains unchanged with mobile phones functioning intermittently and only selected CDMA phones being operational. The curfew remains in place from 2100 - 0430 hours daily.

Displacement>Returns

- There are initial reports of a small number of IDPs arriving from the Vanni. Agencies are following up and more information is expected to be available soon.

KILINCHCHI & MULLAITHIVU DISTRICTS

Situation update

- General security situation of Vanni remains tense. It has been reported that Kilinochchi town was shelled and the military operation in Poonakary division continues.

Displacement>Returns

- According to GA-Kilinochchi, the total number of IDPs in the district continues to increase following ongoing confrontations in Poonakary division as well as aerial bombardments recently reported in Paranthan. It is also reported that there has been displacement of people from Semmankunru and Kiranchchi towards the Tharmapuram and Visuvamadu areas.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- On 31 October, the RDHS Kilinochchi reported that a portion of the fourth quarter drugs were transported to Kilinochchi during the reporting period. The RDHS also reported 16 malaria patients have now been identified and treated in Kilinochchi during the month of October while 194 snake bites cases were admitted in the Tharmapuram hospital facility, where two died after failing to respond to treatment. In the meantime, road accidents have increased significantly in areas of dense IDP concentration. In October, 540 accidents were reported including 2 deaths in Tharmapuram.
- The Psycho-Social Promotion Forum, a newly inaugurated structure comprising representatives from health, education, District Secretariats and religious dignitaries, organized an 18 day training programme on psycho-social issues for 40 staff members of those institutions. The training began on 1 November in Mullaitivu and is being conducted by local NGO Annai Illam. Newly trained staff will be deployed amongst the IDP sites in order to assist those psychologically affected by the conflict.
- On 03 November, the UN dispatched a food convoy into the Vanni region. The 29 truck WFP convoy carried 426 MT of food to feed 121,714 IDPs for 7 days.
- On 06 November, RDHS-Mullaitivu reported that he expects two lorry loads of medicines from the third quarter allocation to be transported from Vavuniya in the coming days while the approval for the fourth quarter drugs is still pending. Two malaria cases were identified in the district last week. Health volunteers and RDHS staff are implementing an Anti-Malaria campaign in the district.
- Shelter and Wash continues to be a priority for IDPs in the Vanni. Thousands of IDPs are without adequate shelter and open defecation is widespread due to the lack of toilet facilities. The RDHS of Kilinochchi has expressed concern at the likelihood of outbreaks of water borne disease unless conditions are improved particularly now with the resumption of seasonal monsoon rains.

MANNAR & VAVUNIYA DISTRICTS

Situation update

- The security situation in Mannar District is tense with a noticeable increase in the number of cordon and search operations conducted during the reporting period.
- The security situation in Vavuniya remains tense. On 30 & 31 October, military presence on the streets increased during the two-day national teacher strike.

Displacement>Returns

- WFP is providing food rations at the Sirukandal (145 families -326 individuals) and Kalimoddai IDP sites (221 families-500 individuals) in Mannar District.
- UNHCR has reported that 11 families (24 persons) left Kalimoddai and Sirukandal IDP sites and went to the Cultural Hall IDP site in Trincomalee. UNHCR and partners have been advocating for such movements for some time and this is seen as a positive step. IDPs continue to be transported to the Sirukandal site. 6 families (13 individuals) and 3 families (8 individuals) arrived last week.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- At a meeting with GAs of Vavuniya and Kilinochchi, the AGA of Mullaitivu, INGOs and UN, the GA Vavuniya requested that the agencies assist the government improve storage facilities at the GA compound. INGOs have been asked to hand over stocks of relief items they wish to transport to the Vanni so that transportation of the items can be facilitated through the GA convoy. At the same meeting the most urgent shelter need for 20,000 IDPs was discussed; shelter materials have yet to be given clearance to enter the Vanni while it is acknowledged that there are not enough shelter materials locally available in the Vanni to meet needs of the 5,000 most vulnerable of the 20,000 caseload. The GAs will work to find solutions to this problem.
- On 31 October, UNICEF jointly with Government, UNHCR and Solidar carried out a watsan assessment of 5 IDP transit centers out of the 8 proposed in Vavuniya. The sites assessed are (1) Varikuttiyoor School, Pavatkulam (2) Nellukulam Kalaimakal Vidyalayam (3) Nellukulam Open site (4) YMHA (5) Muthiah Mandapam.
- On 03 November, UNICEF commenced the planning process with the government for 2009 Education and 2009 WASH interventions in Mannar and Vavuniya.
- On 05 November, UNICEF reviewed pre-positioned emergency health stocks in Vavuniya to determine expiry dates.
- From 1-2 November, a household survey was conducted in Chetikulam, Vavuniya South education division with funding from UNICEF. The survey aimed to establish the number of out of school children and help design appropriate response strategies. A total of 120 A-level students who live and study in the area and selected teachers conducted the survey. Results will be available later in the week.
- On 30 October, UNICEF participated in a Child Protection Subcommittee meeting for Emergency Preparedness and response, which was led by Additional District Secretary Vavuniya, with UNICEF as secretariat.
- With support from UNICEF catch-up education programmes began in Mannar on 03 November for Vavuniya North displaced schools targeting 900 primary school children from grades 3 and 4 and 500 secondary children from grade 11.

- UNHCR conducted SGBV (Sexual and Gender-Based Violence) awareness activities at Manar IDP sites in order to help them better understand SGBV, learn to identify it within their families and communities and help them to minimize SGBV cases. To date, 20 different locations have benefited from these awareness-raising sessions. Likewise, alcohol awareness activities are conducted within the sites. Community mobilization and child-friendly spaces are also implemented on a regular basis.
- Oxfam GB reports that it will need to stop the fuel cost assistance allowance for water trucking done through the Nanattan DS office to the Sirukandal and Church compound IDP sites. It is reported that in other districts such as Vavuniya all the operational cost for water trucking is born by the Government, whereas in Mannar, there is a lack of funding for water trucking to IDP sites.
- SCiSL assisted 42 children at the Kalimoddai IDP site with school kits, play material and an education and recreational centre for Kalimoddai and Sirukandal.
- WASH agencies have noted that there are no separate water tanks close to toilets at Sirukandal and that IDPs use drinking water for sanitation purposes. IOM is assessing the situation for the construction of a tube well.
- On 03 November, UNICEF conducted a field monitoring visit to gauge child protection interventions being implemented at the Kalimoddai IDP camp by SLRCS with UNICEF funds. During the visit, modalities to start the implementation of a child friendly space (CFS) by SLRCS with UNICEF funds at the Sirukandal IDP camp (which has 98 displaced children) were finalized.
- 05 November, UNICEF held a contact meeting with the Thaladdhi Commander in respect of 39 separated/unaccompanied children who said that they had been refused permission to attend school by the Kalimoddai/Sirukandal camp management; despite earlier advocacy by the ZDE and UNICEF. The Commander committed to have the issue resolved on Monday.

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT

Situation update

- The overall security situation in Trincomalee District appears stable. Security forces though remain on alert and are conducting cordon and search operations, particularly in Trincomalee town and surrounding areas.

Displacement/Returns

- On 06 October, 39 families left the Kiliveddy IDP Transit Site and returned to Kaddaiparichchan North. Government authorities plan to resettle 70 IDP families from Batticaloa district to Kaddaiparichchan North.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- Humanitarian agencies in Trincomalee district are looking at securing funds for shelter repair, core-house construction and watsan needs. Agencies noted that although needs still exist, funding is limited and it is not clear what activities agencies can commit to next year.

BATTICALOA DISTRICT

Situation Update

- The general situation remains unchanged. Cordon and search operations were reported on 30 October and 03 November in the Valachchenai and Kommathurai areas in the district. The number of security related incidents is low compared to the previous reporting period.

Displacement/Returns

- According to Government statistics, as of 31 October 2008, there were 10,658 IDPs (2,800 displaced families) in the district.
- GoSL has scheduled a resettlement movement to Perillaveli GN division in Kiran DS division on 11 November. 380 families (1,631 individuals) are planned to be resettled.
- GoSL plans to resettle 70 families (238 individuals) from Kattaiparichchan North in Trincomalee district, except Salaiyoor village on 07 November.
- On 30 October, UNHCR organized a joint assessment in the Veppavettuwana and Periya Pullumalai newly resettled areas of Chenkalady. UN organizations as well as INGOs were part of the assessment team.
- On 31 October, the DS of Manmunai North division invited representatives from Manpower IDP camp to discuss camp consolidation. 22 male IDPs attended. Manpower is prone to flooding and is located in a tense Muslim-Tamil border area, a concern which some IDPs had made known earlier. During the meeting the IDPs

agreed on the general principle of transferring, and will now discuss among themselves which families would like to transfer and to where. UNHCR provided them with the options such as the number of empty shelters in other camps and camp capacities. Transfer options include Saththurukondan 1&2, Zahira and Palameenmadu IDP sites. On 3 November, detailed consultations took place with each family in the camp on their preference and the assistance needed. The transfer has tentatively been scheduled for 10 November.

Sector Development/Gaps

- On 05 November, 9 organizations including the UN and INGOs conducted an assessment at 13 IDP camps in the district. The assessment was done through direct interviews with IDP camp committee members and IDPs residing in the camp. The team focused on several sectors including, shelter, water, sanitation, hygiene, disposal management, drainage system etc. The compiled report of the outcomes will be shared at the next IDP Technical Working Group meeting to be held on 7 November for further follow up and action by relevant agencies.
- At UNICEF's request the GA of Batticaloa arranged a review meeting to ensure WASH services prior to resettlement in Perillavelly GN division in Kiran DS. UNICEF agreed to provide water tanks and technical support.
- The Valaichenai Pradeshya Saba with the support of UNICEF supplied 210,000 liters of drinking water during the reporting period to Vadamunai, Uthuchenai, Muruthanai, Poolakadu, Thikilivettai and part of Koraveli GN division in Kiran DS.
- The UNICEF supported Nutrition Rehabilitation Programme has been extended to another 3 recently resettled villages in Kiran DS by the MOH team.
- The Emergency District Health, Hygiene & Nutrition Coordination meeting was held on 2 November. The provision of health, nutrition & hygiene facilities at Perillavelly GN division was reviewed as resettlement is planned for next week. UNICEF agreed to provide financial support for mobile NRP services to Kiran MOH (Medical Officer of Health) division including Perillavelly.
- Eight schools in Ampara and Batticaloa district were handed over to authorities through UNICEF support and care & maintenance plans have been introduced by TERM.
- 52 'catch-up education' centers are functional in all 4 educational zones in the district with the support of SCiSL.

AMPARA DISTRICT

Situation update

- The security situation in Ampara is generally stable though there continue to be concerns about disappearances. The situation in the Kanchikudichiaru area remains tense & volatile due to ongoing military operations.
- In Kalmunai, all shops, government & private sector offices were closed on 02 November due to a harthal. However, public transportation was operational to and from Kalmunai.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- UNHCR organized a joint UN /INGO needs assessment on IDPs displaced within Thirukovil DS division.
