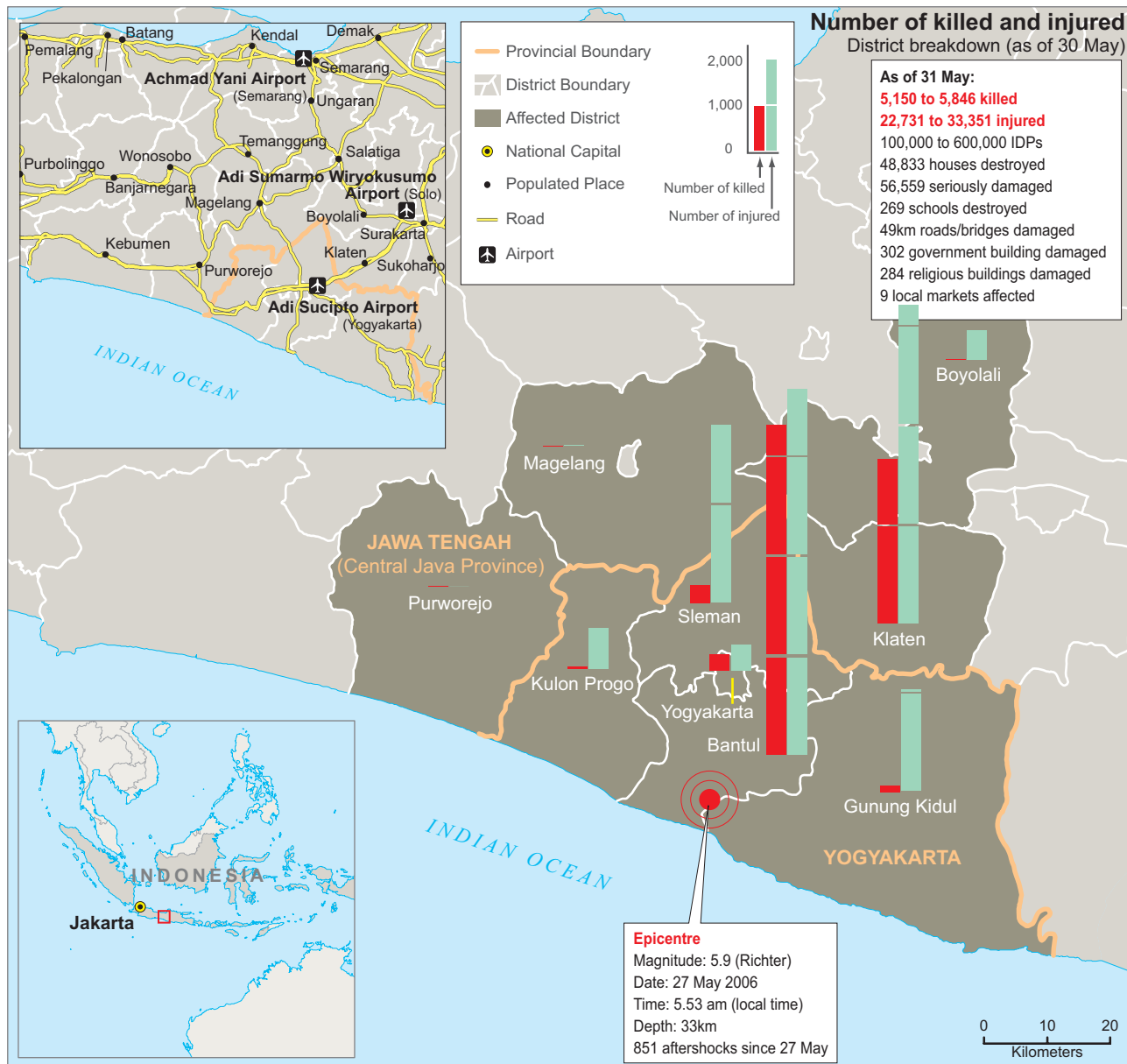


# Indonesia: Earthquake

## SITUATION

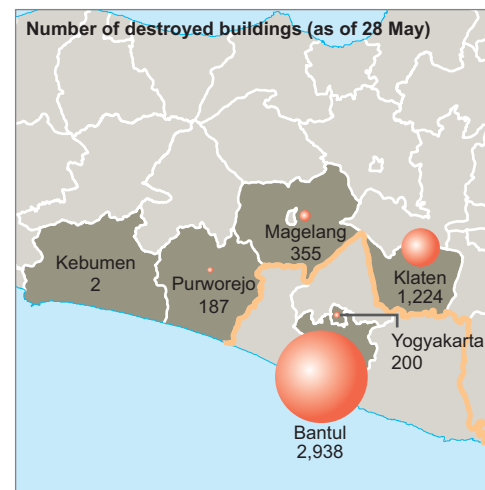
M5.9 earthquake struck Yogyakarta Province on 27 May. 5,150 to 5,846 people reported killed, 22,731 to 33,351 injured and 100,000 to 600,000 displaced IDPs. Need for damage assessment outside of Bantul and Klaten. Damage in Klaten more serious than initially thought.

## ACTION

Government of Indonesia welcomes international assistance but classifies this earthquake as "local disaster". Ministry will provide grants to survivors and for rebuilding of houses. WHO reported needs in orthopedic supplies and antibiotics. Lack of bed sheets, mattresses and medical equipment such sterile kits. UN preparing Emergency Response Plan, containing immediate need and requirement information.
