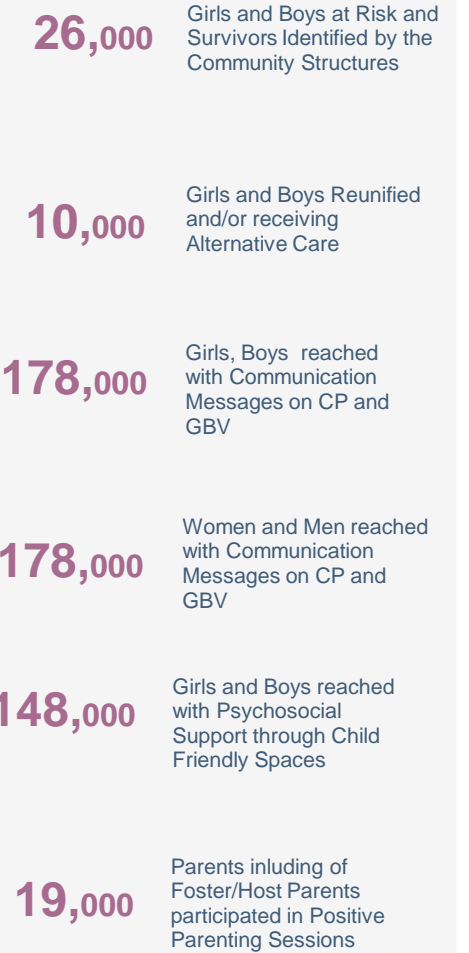
Number of Organizations by Need Addressed



Number of Organizations by Standard Strategy

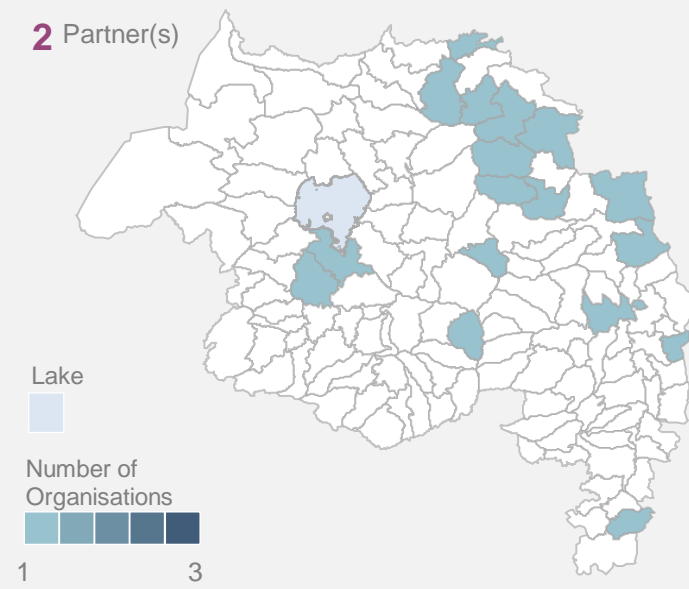


Operational Response Plan 2016 Planning Figures



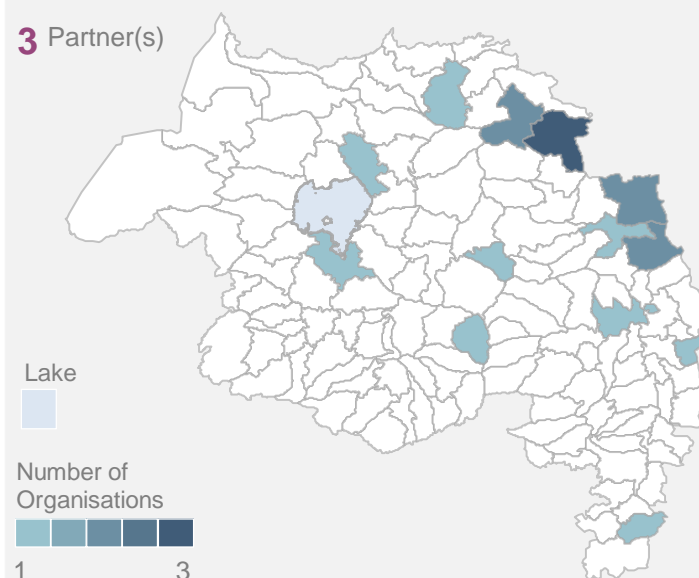

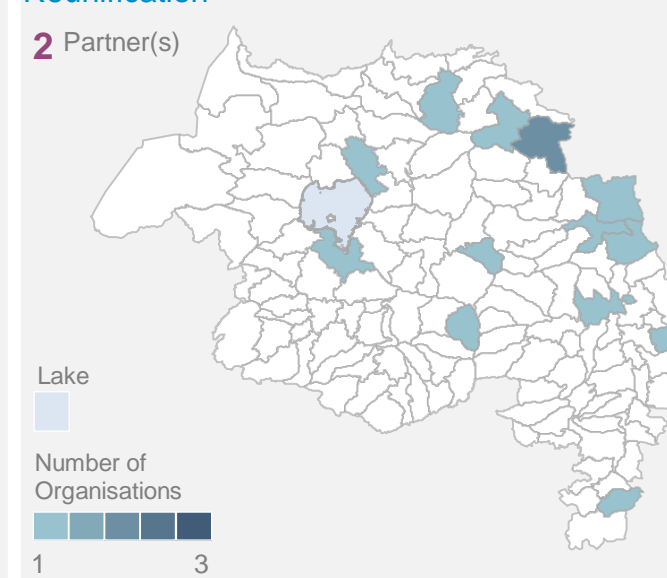

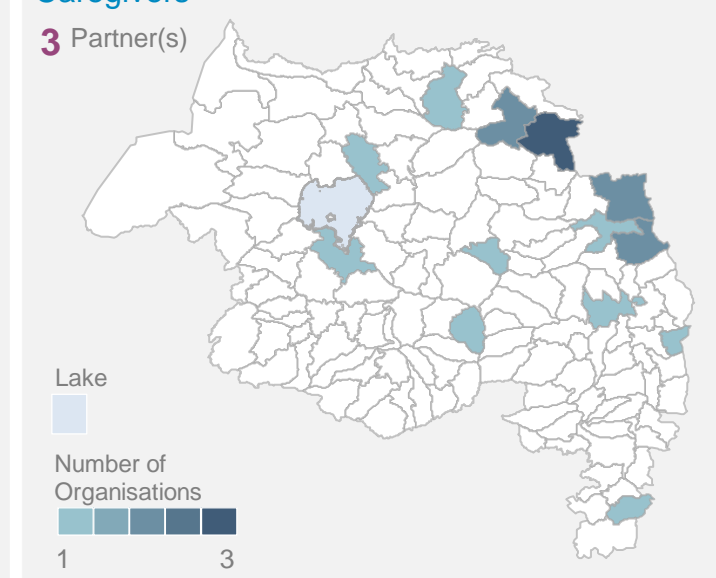
