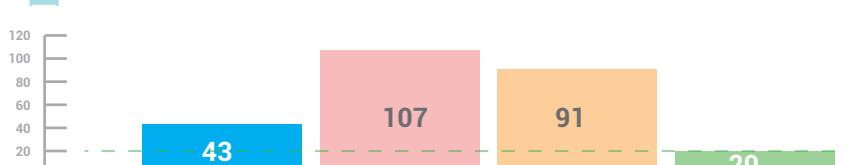

CCCM

DRC, Internews, IOM

- Intentions Assessment results published by DRC
- Internews provided radio communication for the women centres
- IOM continued replacing lost registration cards at the GFD Site whereby 1,217 cards have been replaced so far.



Education

UNICEF, INTERSOS, World Vision, War Child

- INTERSOS has completed damage assessment on affected the education support facilities .



Food Security

World Vision, WFP

- 40,112 people have been distributed rations containing cereals, pulses and vegetable oil through the World Vision general food distribution, finalised on Saturday.



Health

IMC, IOM, MSF

- The Clinic operated normally where 235 consultations done , the trend for top medical conditions were , Upper Respiratory Track Infection 101 (42%), Malaria 60(25%), Acute watery diarrhea 15(6%).
- A total of 2,884 individuals reached with health messages
- Outpatient unit reached 244 Individuals ,while at the community 2,640 individuals were reached.



Logistics

IOM, WFP

- Logistics cluster barge offload has been completed



NFI/Shelter

DRC, IOM, Medair

- 6,340 households have been distributed with mosquito nets, blankets, sleeping mats and Kangas by Medair



Nutrition

IMC, MSF, UNICEF, World Vision

- Nutrition Integration at the Health Facility continued as normal routine.
- 45 children under the age of 5 years were identified with malnutrition during POC screening.
- 8,660 children under the age of 5 years have been provided with supplementary feeding through the GFD



Protection

DRC, IMC, INTERSOS, HDC, UNHCR, UNICEF

- UNICEF facilitated the reunification of families of 4 children from Malakal town back to the PoC.
- 80 women and girls of reproductive age were provided with Sanitary kit (AFRIpads and pair of underwear)
- A total of 403 children (182 girls; 221 boys) participated in the PSS activities. 183 children (92 girls & 91 boys) attended in the morning while 220 in the afternoon (90 girls & 130 boys).



Security

UNMISS

- UNMISS Security Section is following up with Engineering Section to fix a number of holes and breaches in the perimeter fence.



WASH

IOM, Solidarités International

- 492,100 litres were pumped - 12 litres/person/day.
- The construction of the foundation for the installation of a new T70 storage tank at the treatment plant is ongoing.
- Disposing of waste water from water points is going on; 17.2m³ was cleared today.
- Solidarités desludged 39.2m³ of liquid waste from latrines in Sector 1 and the old PoCs.
- Solidarités disposed of 5.8m³ of liquid waste manually pumped from latrines in Old PoC at the end of last week (immediately after the displacement of people IDPs to the Old PoCs.)
- 480 pee/poo bags were distributed to families in the old PoC by Solidarités
