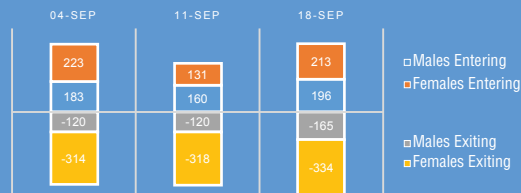


Bentiu
 Bentiu PoC **101,350** ↑
 Bentiu Town **32,723**

- 409 new individuals entered the PoC, a significant increase on 291 the previous week. 79% from Leer and all citing security and access to humanitarian services as key reasons.
- Camp management and Protection are working together to address GBV risks faced by female IDPs when collecting firewood outside of the PoC.
- Camp management and Protection continue advocating for return of biometric registration in PoC.

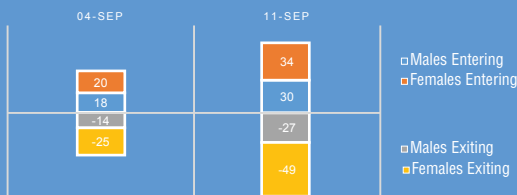
Bentiu PoC Movement Trend Tracking

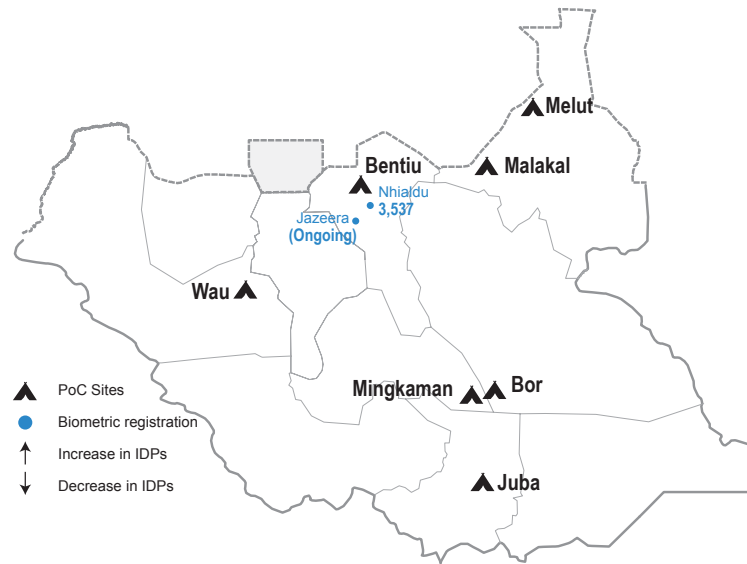
- Camp management has been reaching out to Health, Shelter and WASH partners and strengthening relationships to encourage regular participation in coordination meetings.
- IDPs who wish to participate in community leadership elections are collecting signatures to stand on ballot.
- Camp management identified 42 vulnerable families to move into new communal shelters, once construction is complete.

- Camp management coordinated with partners and community leaders to support GFD in Dethoma 1 and where they set up a lost cards and complaints desk.



Malakal
 Malakal PoC **33,028**
 Malakal Town **4,083**

- Approximately 500 people entered Malakal Town to escape an outbreak of fighting in Balliet County.
- SFP and Camp Management are conducting learning sessions with the community to address illegal construction of shelters in the PoC.

Bor
 2,001

- Camp management coordinated with OCHA, and UNMISS RRP and State Administrator to find an emergency solution to dumping liquid waste from latrines which are full and posing a health hazard.

Tongping, Juba
 1,289 ↓

- 2,687 IDPs have relocated to UN House since movements began on 28 July and approximately 1,289 registered IDPs remain at the site.
- No relocations since 14 September due to violence directed at humanitarians, reportedly encouraged by the new camp chairman. Relocation scheduled to re-start on 21 September.

UN House, Juba
 39,380 ↑

- All newly arrived IDPs have been moved from temporary communal shelters to individual shelters.
- Construction of individual shelters is ongoing.
- Biometric registration will begin on 20 September.
