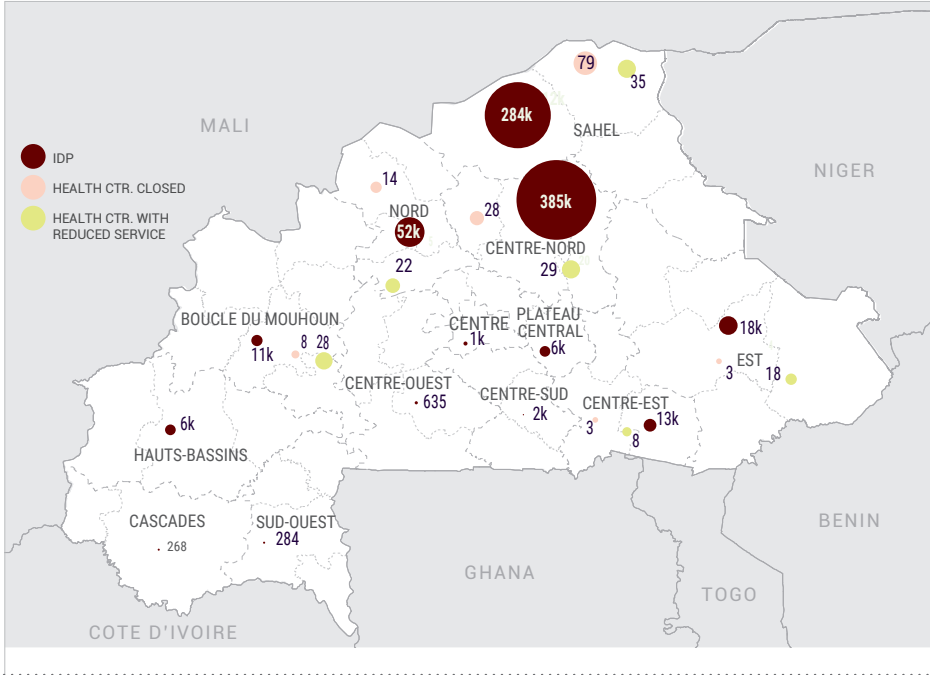




The humanitarian situation in Burkina Faso has deteriorated sharply over the past year. By the end of February 2020, nearly 780,000 people had been forced to flee their homes as a result of the violence. To date, more than 56% of the displaced are homeless or do not have adequate shelter. In January 2020, the exacerbation of violence against civilian populations, mainly in the provinces of Soum, Sanmatenga, Seno and Sourou, contributed to new displacements in these localities. The number of people in need of humanitarian assistance increased from 1.5 million in December 2019 to 2.2 million in January 2020. Also for the same year, according to the Humanitarian Needs Assessment, 948,000 people are in need of protection and 1.5 million people are dependent on humanitarian health assistance. To date, 338,000 students are deprived of access to education due to the closure of 2,527 schools as a result of insecurity. In 2020, the Humanitarian Response Plan estimates that US\$ 312 million is needed to provide emergency multisectoral assistance to 1.8 million people targeted by the humanitarian community.

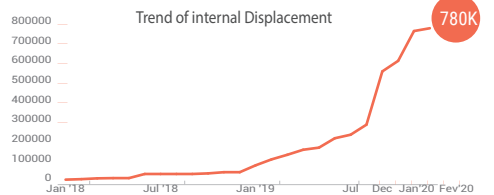

Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) per region and health centres situation

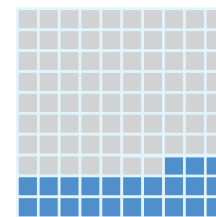

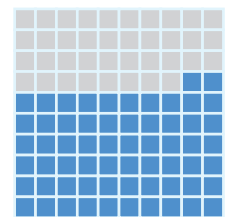

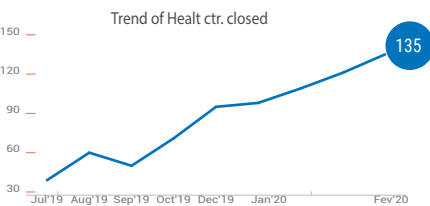

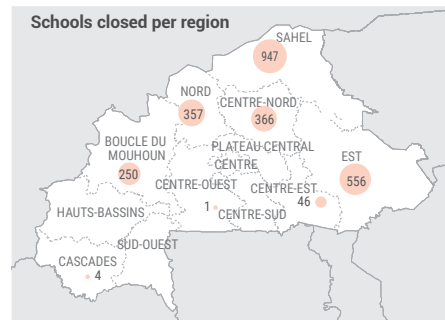

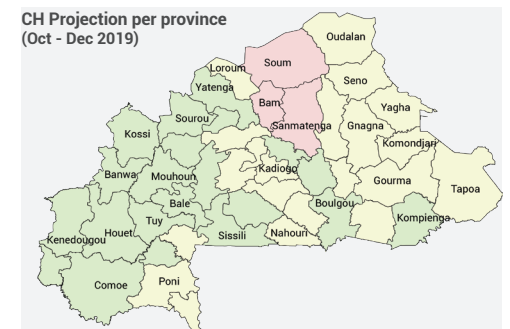

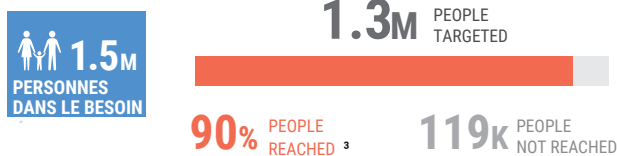
