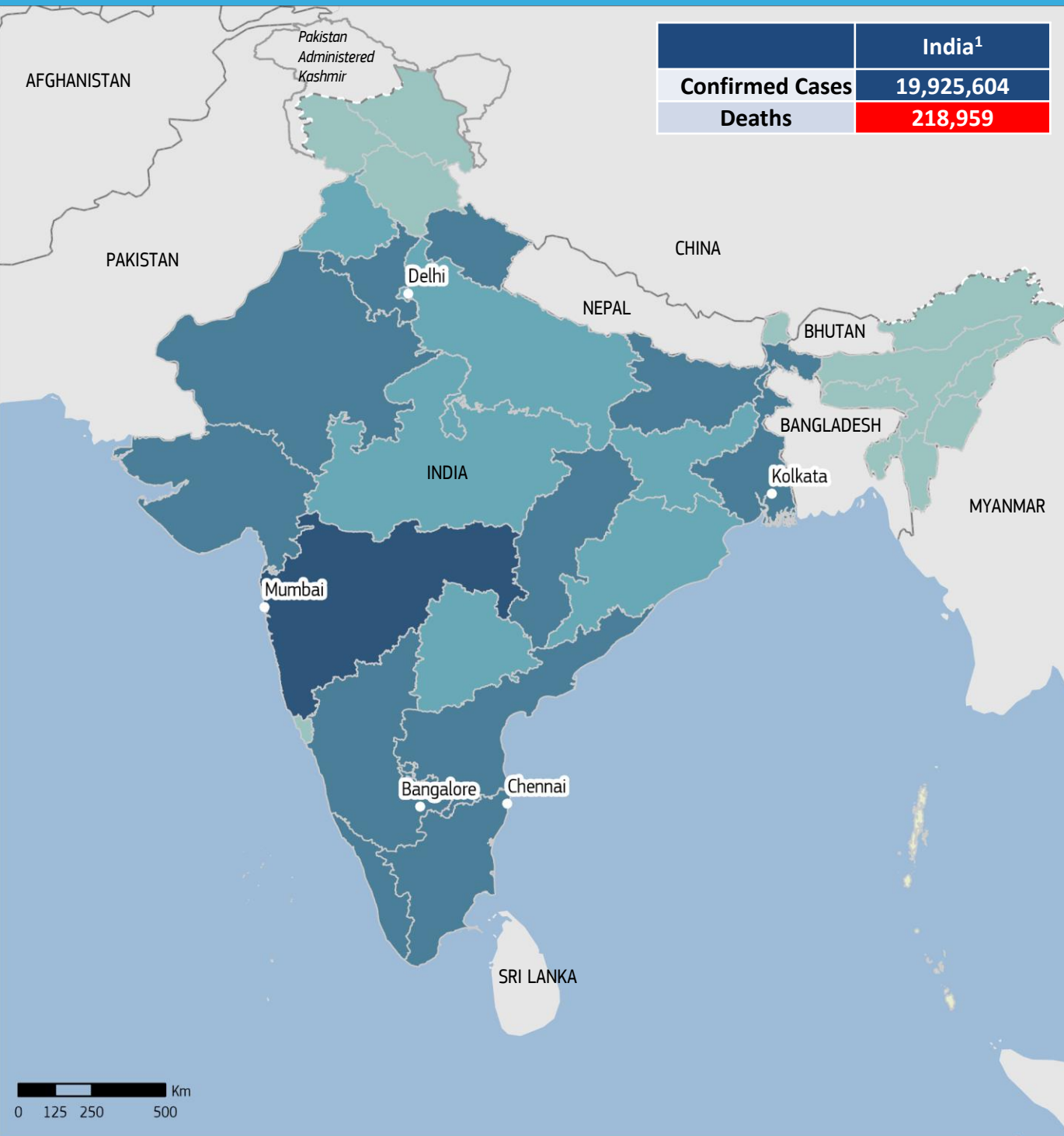

UCPM RESPONSE

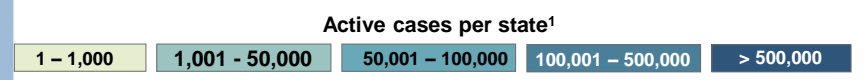
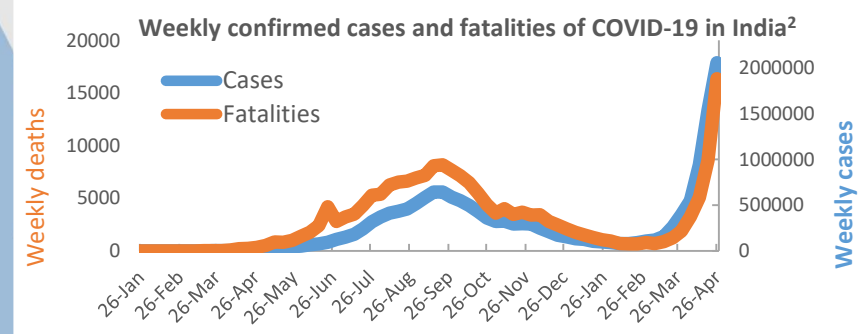


On 23 April, the Union Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM) was activated to support India in its response to Covid-19. The requests cover liquid oxygen (and related required appliances), ventilators and medicines used in the treatment of COVID-19.

Offers have been made by Austria, Belgium, Czechia, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Portugal, Romania, Spain, and Sweden. As of 4 May 2021 offers from Belgium, France, Ireland, Italy and Romania were delivered in full, while partial offers from Germany were also delivered. More deliveries are foreseen to reach India in the coming days.
