1. EFFECTS

- a. Affected /Evacuated: A total of 79,244 families or 393,342 persons in 409 barangays in Regions IV-B, V, VI, VII and VIII were affected while 8,072 families or 39,604 persons were displaced and staying at 83 evacuation centers (Tab A)
- b. Casualties (Tab B)
 - i. Dead - 17 (2 IV-B, 9 Reg VI, 1 Reg VII and 5 Region VIII)
 - ii. Injured - 19 (13 Reg IV-B, 2 Reg VI, 2 Reg VII and 2 Reg VIII)
 - iii. Missing - 17 (4 IV-B, 2 Reg VI and 11 Reg VII)
- c. Damages
 - i. Damaged Houses (Tab C)
 1. Totally - 3,969 (1,765 Region IV-B, 1,366 Region VI, 1 Region VII and 837 Region VIII)
 2. Partially – 12,332 (4,065 Region IV-B, 5,495 Region VI, 10 Region VII and 2,752 Region VIII)
 - ii. Damage to Agriculture/Infrastructure – P433,840,000.00 (Tab D)
 1. Agriculture - P123,545,000.00
 2. Infrastructure - P310,295,000.00
 - iii. Damaged Power Lines
 1. Partial assessment of TransCo revealed that 30 structures (44 poles) were toppled.
 2. Eastern Samar (the hardest hit)
 - a. 14 toppled structures were seen along Taft- Borongan 69 KV lines affecting Eastern Samar Electric Cooperative (ESAMELCO)
 - i. Towns affected: Taft, Sulat, San Julian, Borongan, Maydolong, Arteche, San Policarpio, Oras, Dolores, Can-avid and Taft.

- a. three toppled structure were seen in Bgy Litonglitong, Paranas Socorro and Catbalogan affecting the Samar II Electric Cooperative (SAMELCO II) and 3 structure along Gandara-Palanas Cara 59 KV lines affecting Samar I Electric Cooperative (SAMELCO I).
- b. Towns affected were Tarangnan, San Jorge, Gandara, Sta Margarita and Calbayog City. (not yet energized.)

4. Leyte Province

- a. 6 toppled structures were seen in Brgy Cabagnaan and 3 critically leaning structures in Brgy Tagak all in Carigara, Leyte affecting Leyte III Electric Cooperative (LEYECO III).
 - i. Towns affected were Tunga, Capoocan, Carigara, Barugo and San Miguel.
- b. About 4 structures in Tanauan, 1 in Palo and 2 in Dulag all in Leyte were obstructed by vegetation affecting DORELCO.
 - i. Towns affected were Tanauan, Tacuranga, Palo, Tolosa, Javier, Dulag, Mac Arthur, La Paz, Julita, Abuyog and Mahaplag, Leyte.
- c. Another 3 structures obstructed by vegetations were along Babatngon Abucay 69 KV lines affecting LEYECO II
 - i. Towns affected were Tacloban, Palo and Babatngon.
- d. One structure with bottom pole broken found in along-Alang Leyte affecting LEYECO III and the
 - i. towns affected were Alang-Alang, Sta Fe, Jaro and Pastrana

5. Biliran Province

- a. 4 toppled structure, 2 critically leaning and 1 broken pole along Lemon-Biliran 69 KV lines affecting Biliran Electric Cooperative (BILECO).
 - i. Towns affected were Biliran, Naval, Cabugcayan, Caibiran, Culaba and Almeria. (Lines are still isolated)

6. TransCo's line inspectors continued on their line foot patrol inspection and conducted aerial inspection to determine the extent of transmission lines damaged.

iv. Other Structures Damaged

1. There were 140 motorized and non-motorized bancas/pump boats damaged in Romblon: 50 in Alcantara, 90 in Cajidiocan and San Jose amounting to P12.3 M.

2. Two (2) ports : Carmen Port and Cajidiocan Port in Romblon and other government structures and facilities like school buildings were also damaged
- d. Status Power Communication and Transportation
 - i. Region IV-A - Load restored in Quezon Province - 96.67%;
 - ii. Region IV-B Calapan City – 60 % still have no power;
 1. Abra de Ilog, Occidental Mindoro - still no electricity
 2. San Jose, Occidental Mindoro - 60 % of the municipality have no electricity
 - iii. Region V -load restored: in Albay Province - 0.00%, Sorsogon - 0.00%; Camarines Sur - 20.72%, Camarines Norte - 80.98%;
 - iv. Region VI - Panay - 90% of power restored
 1. The remaining 10 % are Northern Panay (Panitan-Culasi-Caticlan 69 kv lines), TransCo will help electric cooperative (AKELCO) in the repair of its distribution lines to hasten restoration; Boracay - Nabas –Caticlan 69 kv line - TransCo structure is under repair; Kalibo- Nabas 69 kv line already line tested and ready; TransCo will coordinate with AKELCO for their readiness to receive power at Caticlan at 12:00 NN yesterday
 - e. Status of Visayas Transmission Line Restoration (Region VII and VIII)
 - i. 69 KV Wright-Taft-Borongon-Mc Arthur - Ongoing clearing and repair works of damaged structure (schedule of energization - Dec 20, 2005)
 - ii. 69 KV Wright–Calbayog-Catarman-Allen Bobolosan Samar - Ongoing clearing and repair works of damaged structure (schedule of energization Dec 13, 2006)
 - f. Remaining Areas without Electricity
 - i. Caticlan-Boracay area (Aklan and Northern Antique);
 - ii. Eastern Samar – on going repair of toppled lines (all of ESAMELCO)
 - iii. Northern Samar - energized up to Catbalogan only
 - iv. Biliran Province – (BILECO)
 - g. Transportation
 - i. Region IV- B
 1. Malinao Bridge (Naujan) Calapan - collapsed detour bridges (not passable to all types of vehicles) (Alternate route from Victorai to Calapan City)
 2. East Coastal Road Southern Mindoro (Magsaysay –San Nicolas Section) hardly passable due to fallen trees and electrical post

3. Damian Reyes Road (Torrejos section) Marinduque - not passable due to slides
4. Tigui- Dampolan-Buenavista Road , Occidental Mindoro - hardly passable due to washed-out slope protection and landslides
5. Occidental East Coastal Road (Magsaysay-San Nicolas section) – hardly passable due to fallen trees and electrical posts

2. RESPONSE/CONSEQUENCE MANAGEMENT

a. Humanitarian Actions

i. Region IV

1. The 204th Brigade and 2 ID, PA are now conducting clearing operations in Mindoro Provinces
2. PDCCs Oriental Mindoro, Occidental Mindoro, Romblon and Palawan are now conducting relief operations and damage and needs assessment
3. Gov J Reyes will conduct aerial survey at Calamian Group of Islands today December 13, 2006
4. LGUs concerned conducted emergency relief and recovery operations, clearing of debris and rapid damage assessment in respective areas of responsibility

ii. Humanitarian Assistance (Tab D)

1. The NDCC facilitated the release of 800 sacks of rice PDCC Oriental Mindoro 500, 4th District of Cebu 300 and 2nd District Sorsogon
2. Estimated cost of assistance amounted to P1,600,972.00
