

Nigeria: Ongoing Cash Activities (as of September 30 2017)

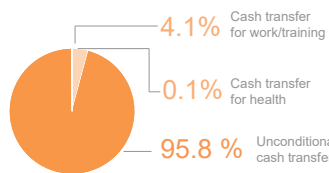
SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Cash Working Group coordinates the implementation of Cash Transfer Programmes in north-east Nigeria. In September 2017, 28 unique organisations (including implementing partners) reported ongoing cash activities in 33 LGAs.

Beneficiaries by conditionality

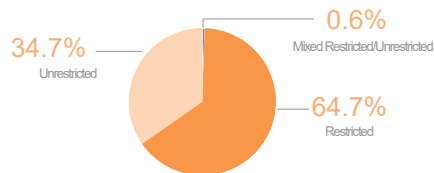


Conditional Cash Transfer is where beneficiaries are required to fulfil an obligation or activity to receive cash.

In Adamawa, a programme from the State Primary Health Care Agency supported by the European Union and UNICEF provides stipends to pregnant women upon fulfillment of conditions attached to focused antenatal visits, hospital delivery, postnatal care, birth registration and completely immunized children.

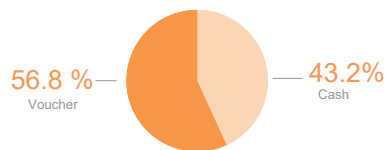
Unconditional Cash Transfer does not require beneficiaries to do anything specific to receive the cash or grant.

Restriction, by household



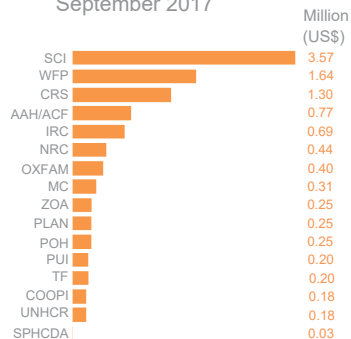
Restriction refers to limits on the use of a transfer, after it has been received by a beneficiary. Restrictions may describe either the range of goods and services that a transfer can be used to purchase, or the places where a transfer can be used, or both.

Modality, by household



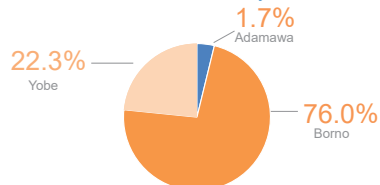
Assistance modality refers to the form of assistance – e.g. cash transfer, vouchers, in-kind, service delivery, or a combination.

CASH DISBURSEMENT

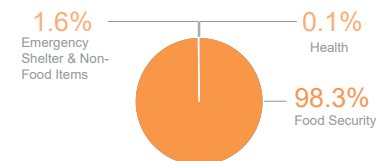


The exchange rate of 320 Nigerian Naira to US Dollar was used where relevant.

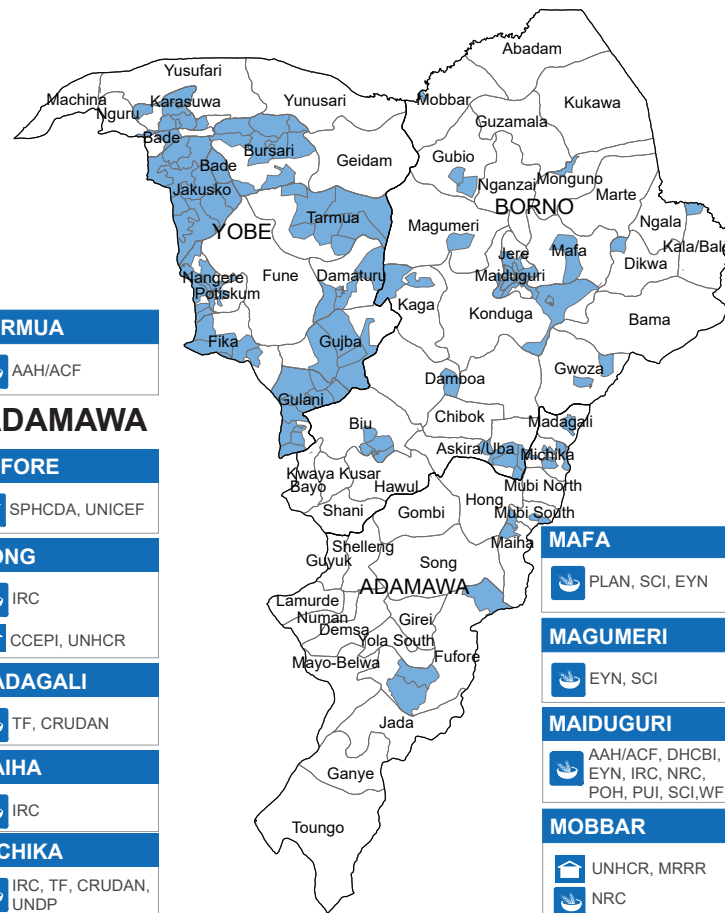
