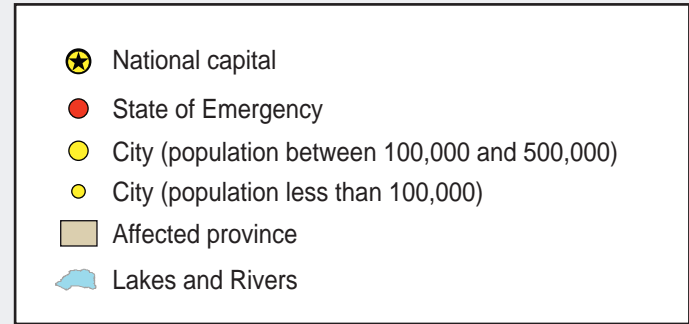
SITUATION

Heavy rains in late May and early June have caused extensive flooding in the northwest and northern regions of Bulgaria. A state of emergency has been declared in the eight highlighted municipalities.

ACTION

The State Agency Civil Protection, Fire Brigade, Police and other partners have been coordinating response activities. The Bulgarian Red Cross is in regular contact with the agency's Crisis Management Centre.
