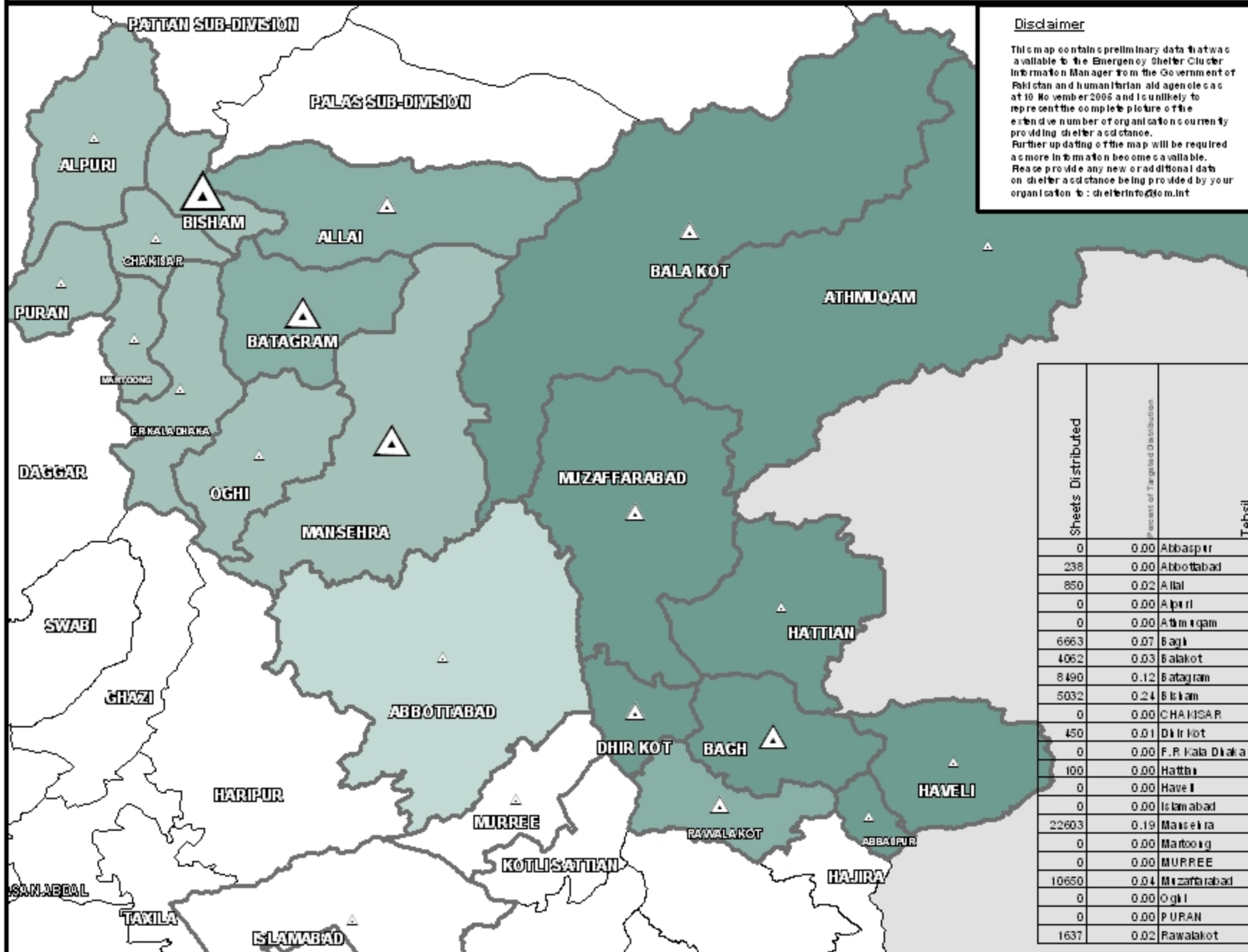

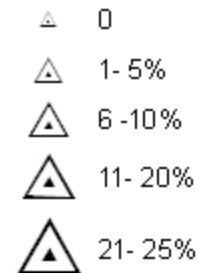

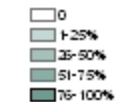
Disclaimer
