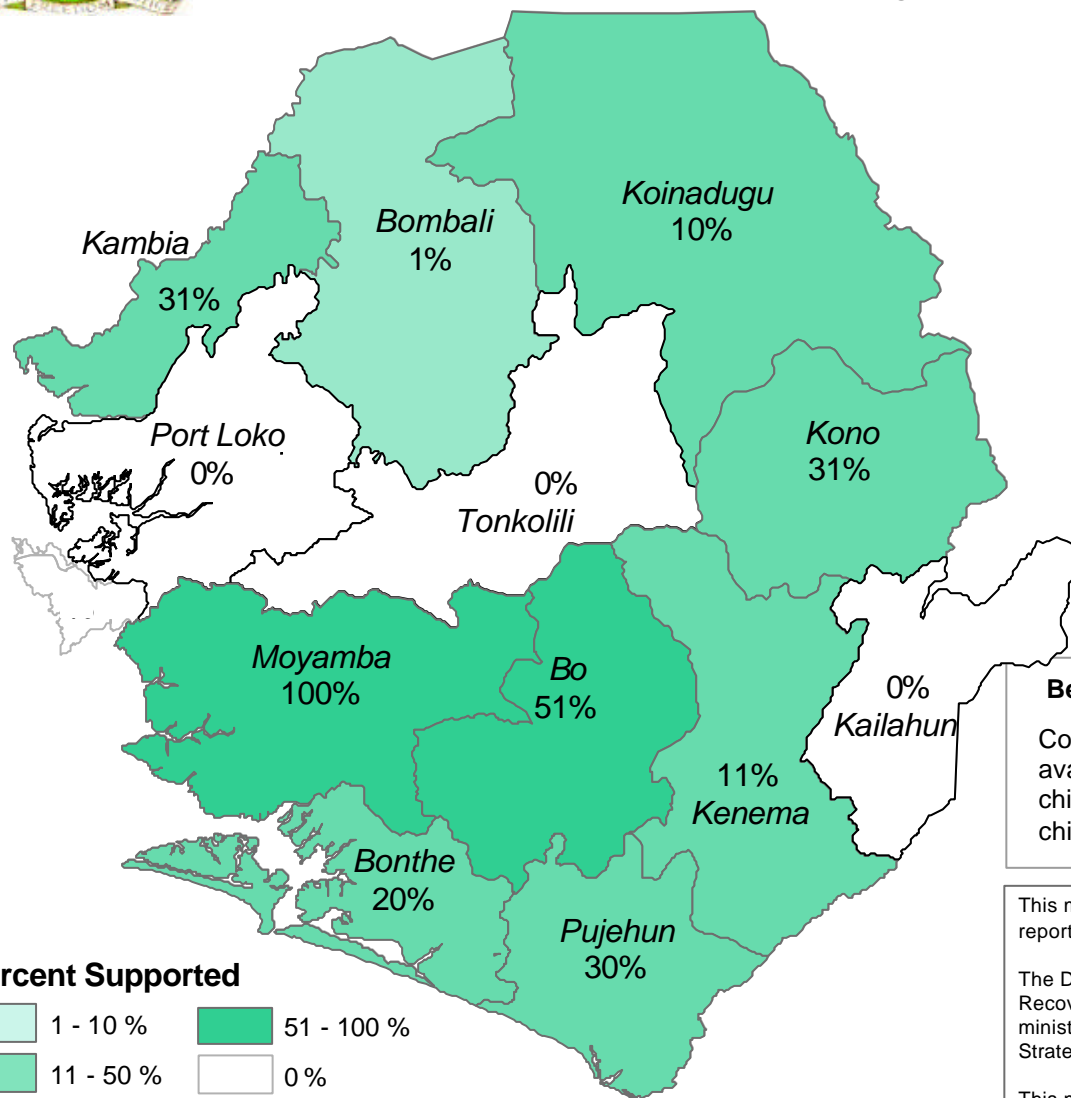

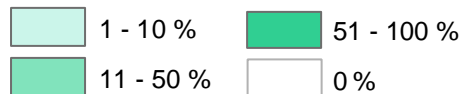
Of 3917 registered child soldiers outside Western Area, 419 have received community-based support (11%).
