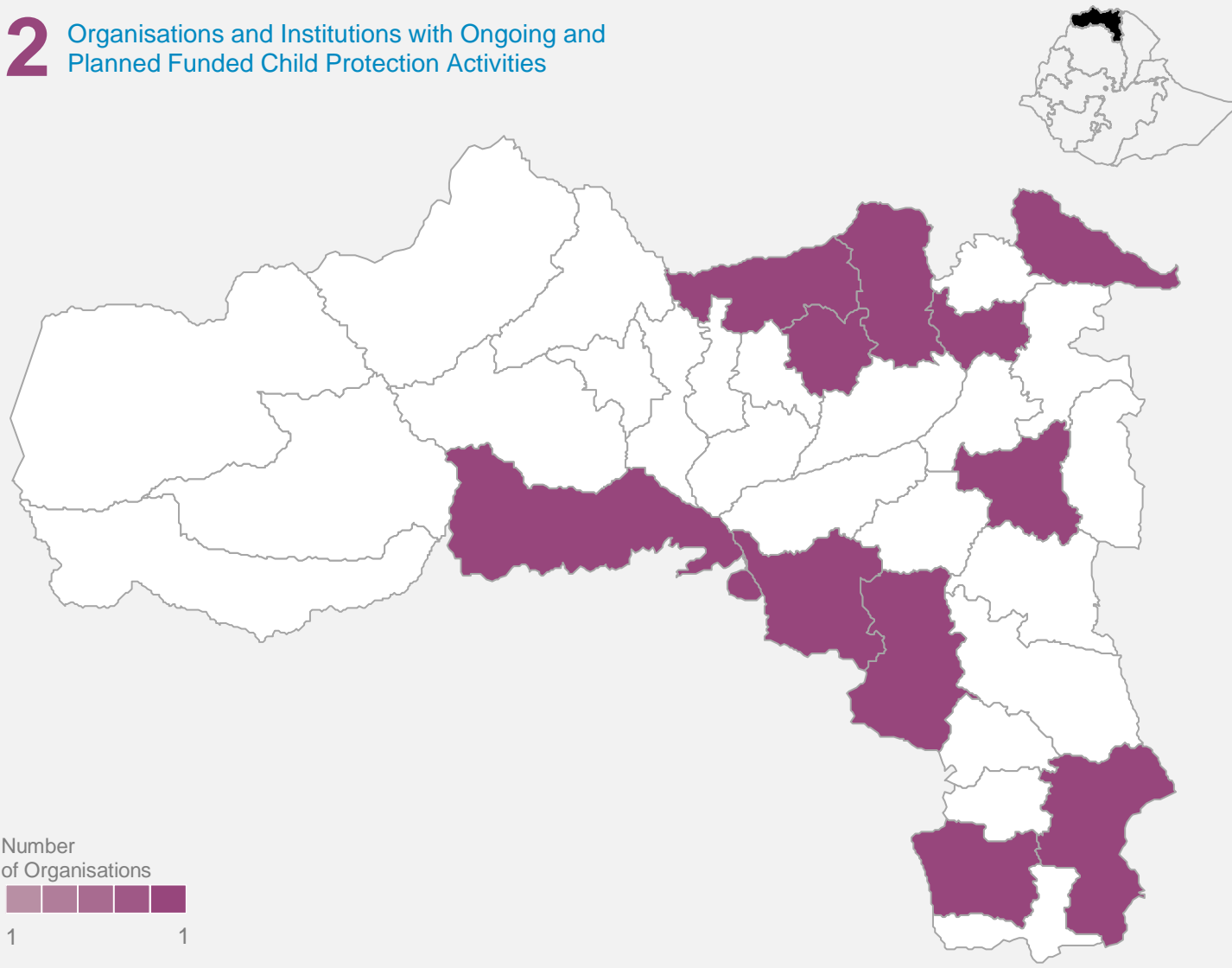
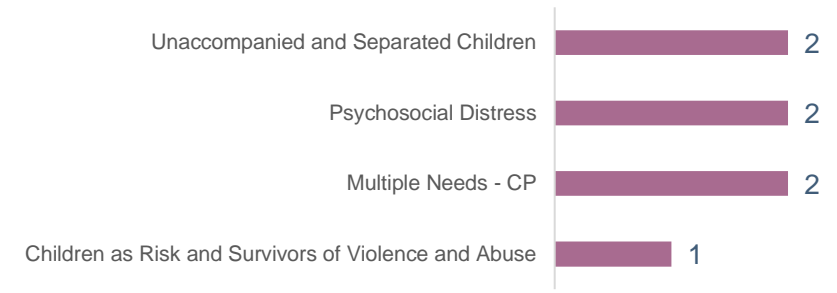




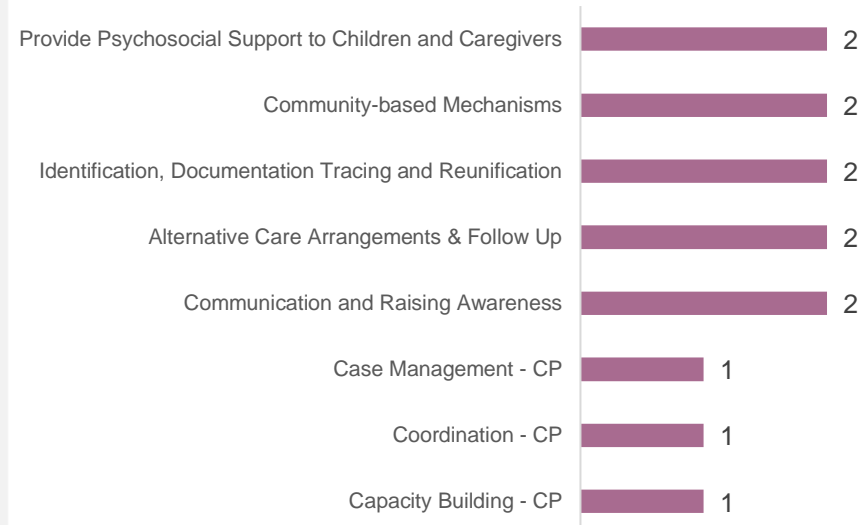

Number of Organizations by Need Addressed



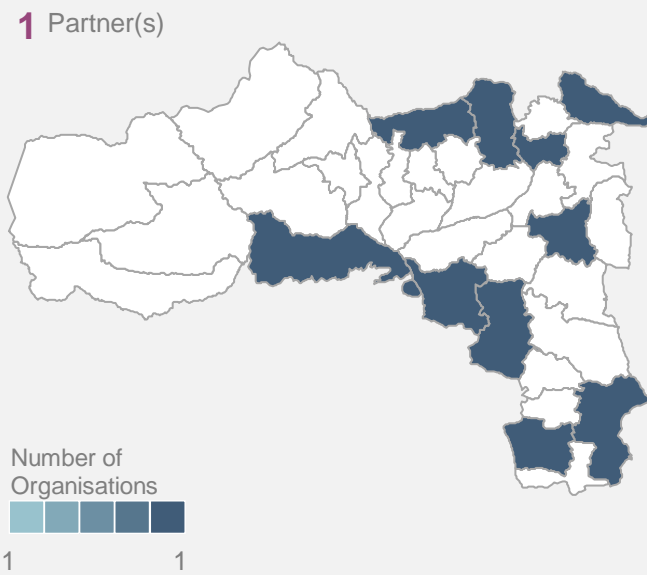
Number of Organizations by Standard Strategy



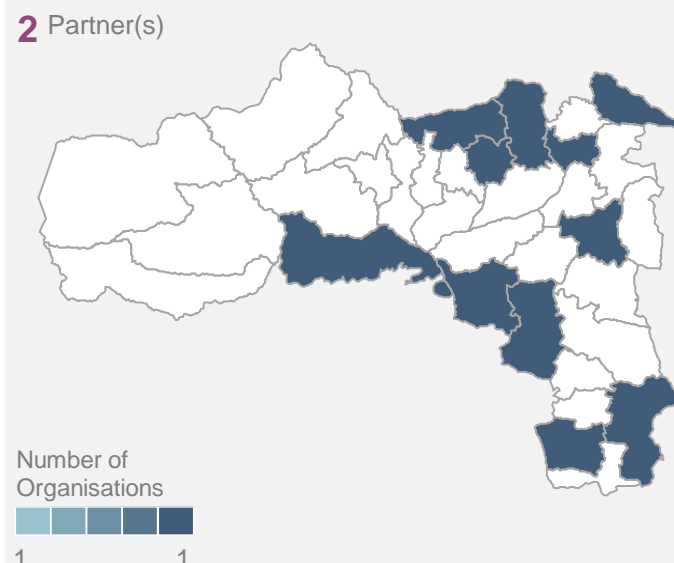

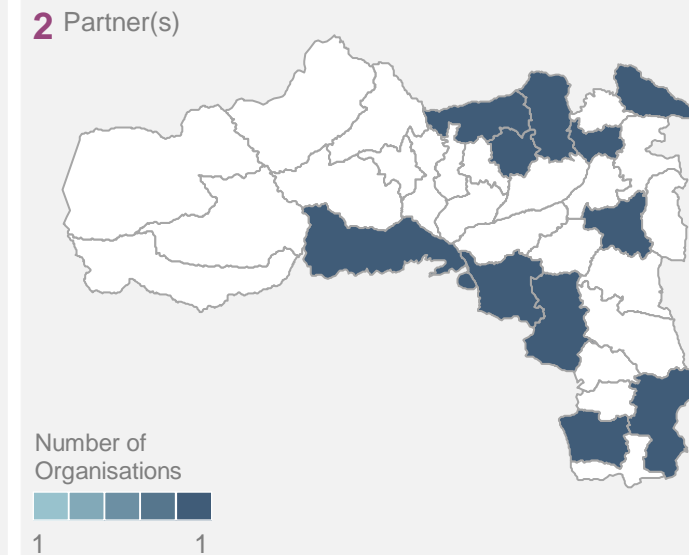

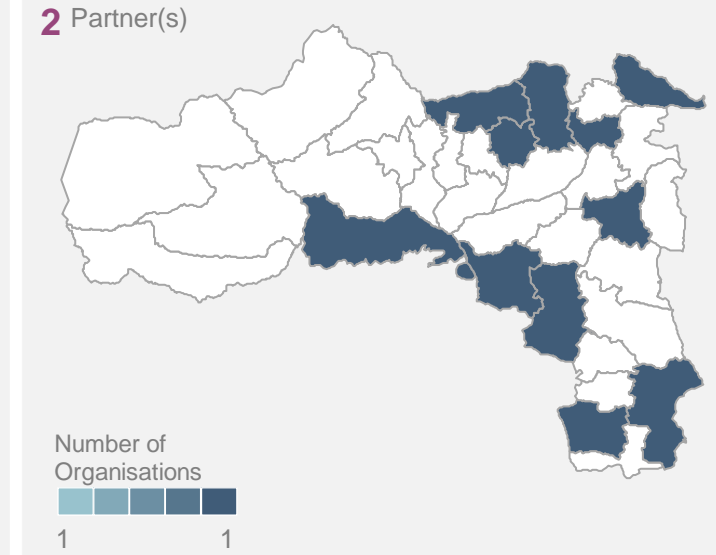
