Interpretation

As of 27 July, about 6 077 000 people of provinces of Fujian, Jiangxi, Hunan and Guangdong have been affected in various degrees. A total of 56 100 houses collapsed and 60 600 were damaged. Approximately 142 930 hectares of farmland were affected, of which 11 750 ha were completely ruined. 34 people have been killed, 75 are missing and more than 1 347 000 people were evacuated.
