Darfur

NORTH & SOUTH DARFUR

► Background

Due to recent conflict on the border of North and South Darfur, new displacements were reported in the areas of Shangil Tobayi and Negeha. Distributions of essential items from the NFI Common Pipeline were completed by Oxfam-America on 18 November; however, Oxfam-America identified a further 120 households in need of support.

SOUTH DARFUR

► Background

The South Darfur Humanitarian Country Team is investigating unconfirmed reports of a possibly large influx of arrivals in Manawashi, Mershing and Kurmje. The movements are originating from the vicinity of Shangil Tobayi and Um Dressaya in North Darfur, where NFI distributions were carried out recently.

WEST DARFUR– No changes from previous report

► Background

As a result of inter-tribal conflict, residents of Twera and Umdam fled to Armankul. An inter-agency mission conducted on 13 December reported approximately 379 households displaced.

Southern Sudan

CENTRAL EQUATORIA

► Background

Following inter-tribal fighting on 29 September, populations were displaced from Gemieza and Mangala Payams to Terekeka, Muni, and Nyori. Distributions to households in need in Terekeka were completed on 31 October; however registration of IDPs in Muni / Nyori is pending due to the security situation. The registration is planned for early January 2010. Additionally, in late November, inter-tribal conflict displaced 488 individuals (99 households) to Lainya.

JONGLEI

► **Background**

Fighting in Le-Kuangole Payam in March displaced 7,500 people to Pibor.

On 28 August, in Liith Payam in Twic East County, inter-tribal conflict displaced populations to Panyagor.

Additionally, on 19 September, inter-tribal conflict in Duk Padiet reportedly displaced 260 households; however, the registration list is pending confirmation from partners.

Another 300 NFI kits, 600 jerry cans and soaps, and 1,000 plastic sheets were pre-positioned when the Bor-Pibor road became passable. Pre-positioning was done at the request of EP&R following their rapid inter-agency assessment on 15 October. However, distribution is pending until a partner for needs assessment and verifications can be identified.

LAKES – No changes from previous report

► **Background**

Inter-tribal fighting in Lakes State in late June displaced populations within Rumbek Cueibet Payam. Some distributions were conducted in July; however access was subsequently restricted and gaps remained. Inter-tribal fighting was reported on 16 November in Kalthok Village, Puluk Payam, Awerial County; an inter-agency rapid assessment will be planned when the security situation improves.

WESTERN EQUATORIA – No changes from previous report

► **Background**

Insecurity has hampered Sector Partner's response to displacements caused by LRA-related conflict over the last six months. In late August, IDPs were reported arriving from Ezo, however, assessments have been limited by insecurity and distance to locations where IDPs are identified, specifically Ezo and Naandi.

OCHA EP&R is on the ground in Yambio to coordinate the overall humanitarian response; as Sector Lead, UNJLC will continue to monitor and coordinate NFI assistance as required.
