"Several moderate earthquakes hit eastern city of Van and south-eastern cities of Adana and Hakkari 25 Jan. 2005. Two people were killed and a total of 22 people were injured."



SITUATION

Several moderate earthquakes hit eastern city of Van and south-eastern cities of Adana and Hakkari on Tuesday, 25 Jan. 2005. Quakes were felt also in the cities of Sirnak, Batman and Siirt. Two people were killed in the Hakkari earthquake. Another 22 people were injured when they jumped off balconies in panic. 80 buildings reported damaged.

ACTION

Red Cross and Red Crescent: 80 tents provided to the Provincial Crisis Center by the Hakkari Branch. A team of 8 people has been deployed along with 27 tents and 1,000 blankets by the Southeastern Anatolia Regional Disaster Response and Logistics Center (Elazig). 100 tents, 1,000 blankets and 100 heating stoves dispatched by the Van Branch. Mus Branch currently loading tents and heating stoves.
