

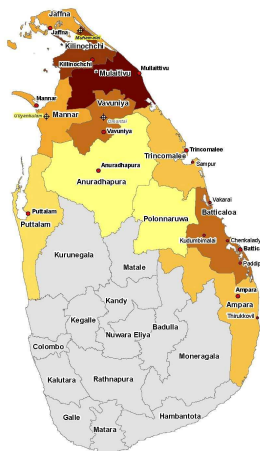

**JAFFNA DISTRICT**

**Situation update**

- The general security situation in the peninsula remained tense during the week, especially in the areas around the FDL. Checks on vehicles and personnel in the mainland and islets have increased. Cordon and search operations especially in the Thennamarachchi area have increased. Roads continue to be blocked regularly to allow military convoy movements.
- All UN, INGO and other International Agencies participated in a progress review meeting with the GA and SF Commander at Kankasanthurai on 18 October.
- On 23 October, a full day hartal was implemented in the peninsula as a sign of protest against the LTTE attack on a cargo ships on 22 October.

**MANNAR & VAVUNIYA DISTRICTS**

**Situation update**

- The general situation in Vavuniya and Mannar District remains tense and potentially volatile. Security forces remain on high alert and regularly carry out cordon and search operations.
- Restrictive procedures at Medawachchiya and at checkpoints along the A14 road continue.

**Displacement>Returns**

- Small numbers of IDPs continue to arrive in Mannar by sea from LTTE controlled areas. The population at the Sirukkandal IDP site now stands at 142 families (323 individuals), whereas 217 families (497 individuals) are accommodated at the Kallimodda site.

**Sector Developments/Gaps**

- WFP transported 755 MT of mixed food commodities including 403 MT of rice, 250 MT of wheat flour, 71.4 MT of lentils and 30.8 MT of vegetable oil to provide a week's ration for approximately 210,000 beneficiaries in the Vanni.

- The District Relief & Resettlement Coordination Meeting took place on 20 October and was chaired by GA Mannar. A suggestion to the constrained space at the Sirukandal and Kalimodai IDP sites was to transfer some IDPs to Vavuniya or to the Jeevodayam camp, which is currently empty but having structures which can be occupied by IDPs.
- RDHS expressed need to have a specialist/ surgeon at Mannar Hospital, where patients not willing to be transferred from the hospital or to other areas for surgery and emergency medical attention can be treated.
- From 18 -19 October, a training workshop on emergency response, Camp Management and Protection of IDPs was held for Government servants including DS, ADS, social service officers and GNs and was jointly organized by the Ministry of Resettlement & Disaster Relief Services and District Secretariat with GA Mannar as chair. IDP related issues such as protection, camp setting and its management, effective emergency response, preparedness and role of government officers and UN&I/NGOs were taken up and explained with UNHCR facilitation.
- WFP reports GA Mannar requested to start Vulnerable Group Feeding (VGF) in Mathakiramam and Periyamurippu for 250 families. According to GA, the livelihood opportunities of these two villages are affected by the volatile security environment.
- World Vision handed over food packages to GA office Vavuniya, to be transported in the GA convoy to Vanni targeting 250 IDP families for two weeks.

### TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT

#### Situation update

- The North East monsoon has started with several areas in Trincomalee district experiencing showers. In the past years, heavy rain disturbed access to Muttur, Seruvila and Eachchilampattai for a few days and in some areas people were temporarily displaced. On 22 October, the GA called UN agencies, I/NGOs and ICRC, dealing with Disaster Risk Management activities, for a meeting to discuss preparedness for floods and cyclones that could possibly affect the district within the next two months. Another meeting is required to discuss further details.
- On 20 October, UN agencies and NRC conducted a joint assessment mission to Kaddaiparichchan North GN, Muttur DS division. The low risk certificate was signed by the GA on 8 October.
- On 17 October UNHCR organized a discussion on relocation in Muttur East with relevant agencies and district authorities. Issues discussed included Information & Consultation, Compensation, Shelter & Infrastructure and Livelihood. The outcome of the discussions will be used as guidance/support in further discussions on relocation.
- The Mine Risk Education Unit at the Kachchari, Trincomalee, reports that a UXO exploded when a person was cutting a tree in Amman Nagar, Muttur. No casualties were reported. The Low Risk Certificate was issued in January 2008. So far, hardly any mine related incidents have occurred in the return areas.

#### Displacement>Returns

- On 20 October, 21 families returned to Naloor GN Division from Kiliveddy IDP transit site. On 21 October, 53 families (158 individuals) returned to Chenaiyoor GN division from the Kiliveddy IDP transit sites. On 23 October, 44 families (148 individuals) returned to Chenaiyoor from IDP sites in Batticaloa district and 13 families (44 individuals) returned to Chenaiyoor from the Killiveddy IDP transit site.

#### Sector Developments/Gaps

- PIN organized from 15-17 October an advanced development training module on communication skills in Town and Gravets for beneficiaries from Kinniya.

## BATTICALOA DISTRICT

### **Situation Update**

- The situation unchanged compared to last week. On 20 October, Monday hartal (total shut down) observed very strictly in Batticaloa District in protest of the 2 grocery workers missing and found dead. All shops, schools, Government offices etc were closed, no transportation was in functional. The function of Humanitarian agencies also hampered on that day.

### **Displacement>Returns**

- Government statistics of 15 October 2008 show there are 11,268 IDPs (2,984 families) in the district.
- On 16 October, the GoSL resettled 71 families (210 Individuals) to Chenaiyoor and 1 family (6 individuals) to Kattaiparichan South in Trincomalee district.
- GoSL organized another return movement to Chenaiyoor, Muthur on 23 October. 44 families (142 individuals) are expected to be resettled during this movement.

### **Sector Development/Gaps**

- JEN started its new project in Kiran DS division to support livelihoods of returned families in the area. The project will focus on Vahanery and Punanai West GN divisions; so far, needs assessment and beneficiary selection completed and total beneficiaries will be 360 individuals from 6 villages.
- A mission consisting 05 senior officials of ILO Colombo was in the district from 15-17 October on a fact finding mission. The purpose of the mission was to study the current situation on livelihoods of the district particularly in the resettled DS divisions and to see how best ILO can support further in the district if possible. The officials had discussions with the relevant heads of departments and officials from GA's office including GA in order to get more information about livelihood needs and the ground situation. They also had several discussions with the agencies (UN, INGOs and NGOs) together with the heads of the funded projects, chamber of commerce etc. Further, field visits were made in Muruthanai resettlement village in Kiran DS div and Vaharai to get firsthand knowledge and information of the resettled areas. Consequently, a discussion was also held with DS Kiran and DS Vaharai.
- UNICEF supported the Nutrition Rehabilitation Programme (NRP) screening process in collaboration with RDHS in resettlement areas of Batticaloa district. Among the screened children, 50 had severe and acute malnourishment. UNICEF agreed with Valaichenai MOH to support transportation for the NRP programme. UNICEF delivered stationeries to RDHS to use for NRP record keeping in all MOH areas where the programme is being implemented.
