



Russian Federation - Floods

OCHA Situation Report No. 1

"Although weather forecasts predicted ten days of dry and warm weather, four days of downpour caused the increase of water levels of several rivers by up to 0.5 m related to their critical values."

Floodwaters have swept through Siberia (Kemerovo, Altay, and Tomsk oblasts) and the South-Ural region (Kourgan oblast) of the Russian Federation.



22 towns and villages with more than 5,000 houses inhabited by 23,529 people have been inundated and 10 people have died. 2,445 people had to be relocated from their places of permanent residence.
