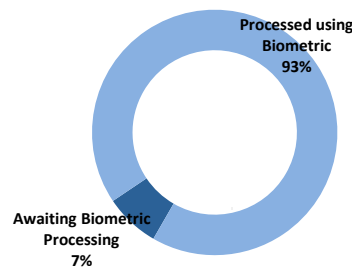

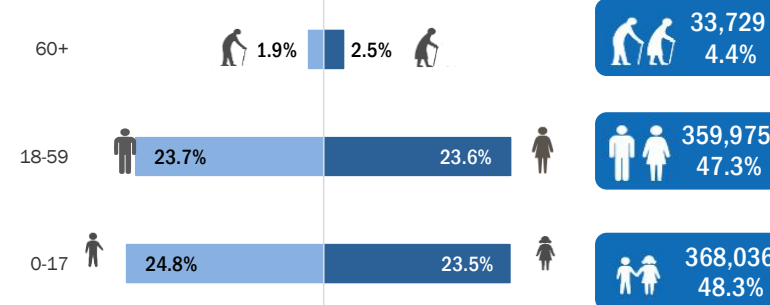

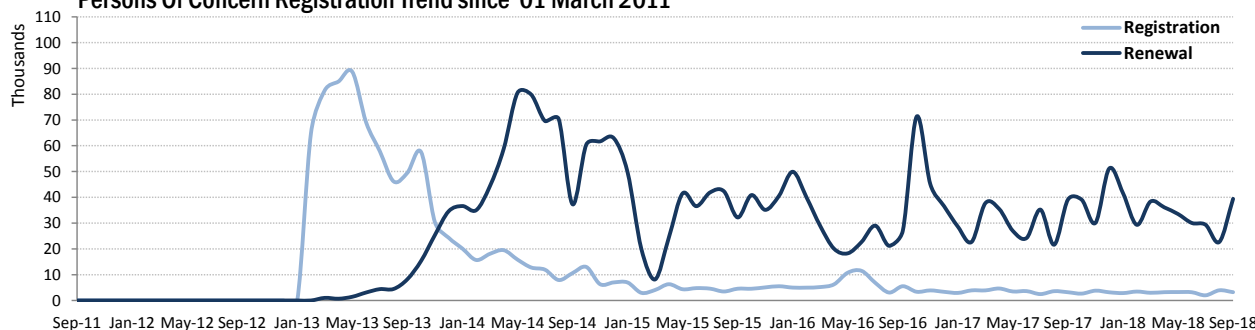

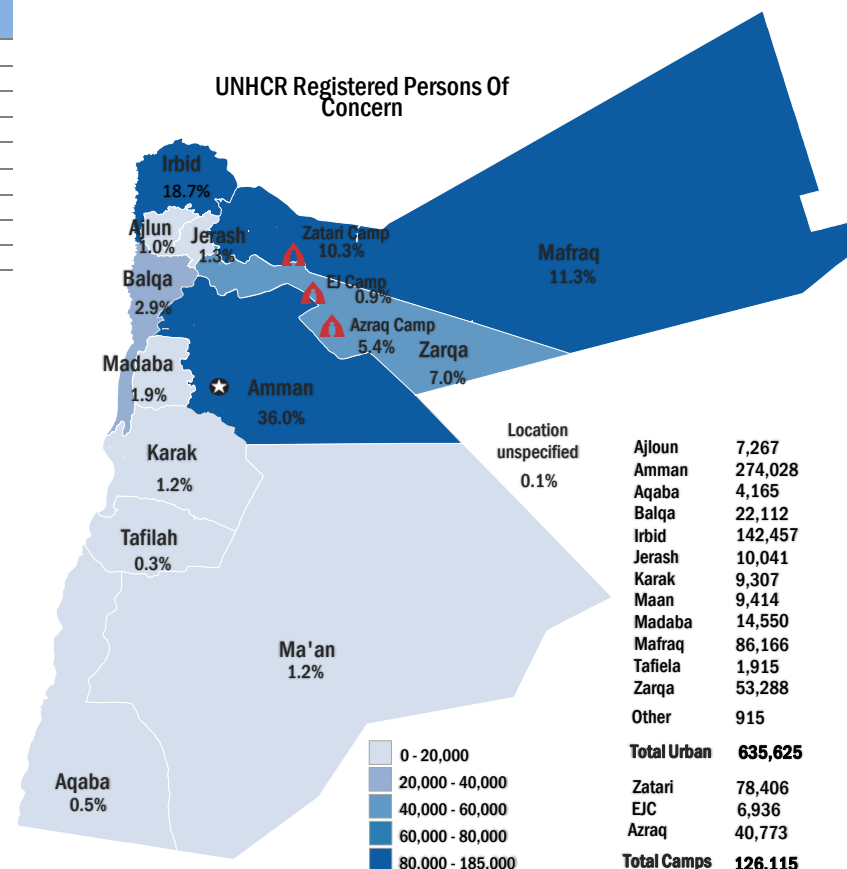
**Persons Of Concern Registration Trend since 01 March 2011**
