Siafa
 Pop.: Approx. 190
 - Siafa gate opens twice daily, 7:30am and 2pm
 - Residents between the ages of 16 to 30 years require 48 hours prior coordination to cross

This month:
 - 2 May: No goods allowed entry
 - 18, 19 May: Gate closed
 - 29 May: Cooking gas bottles were allowed in for the first time since the beginning of the month.

Northwest Netzarim Junction
 Pop.: Approx. 48 people
 - A Palestinian police checkpoint and IDF observation towers, monitor and control resident access

Al Mawasi
 Pop.: Approx. 5,400
 - Checkpoint opens twice daily, 8am - 1pm and 2:30pm - 5pm
 - Male residents between the ages of 16 to 25 years require prior coordination

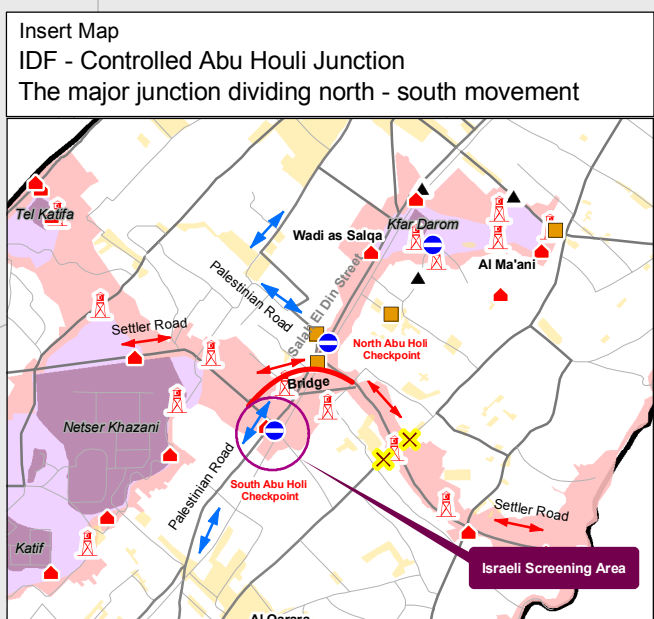
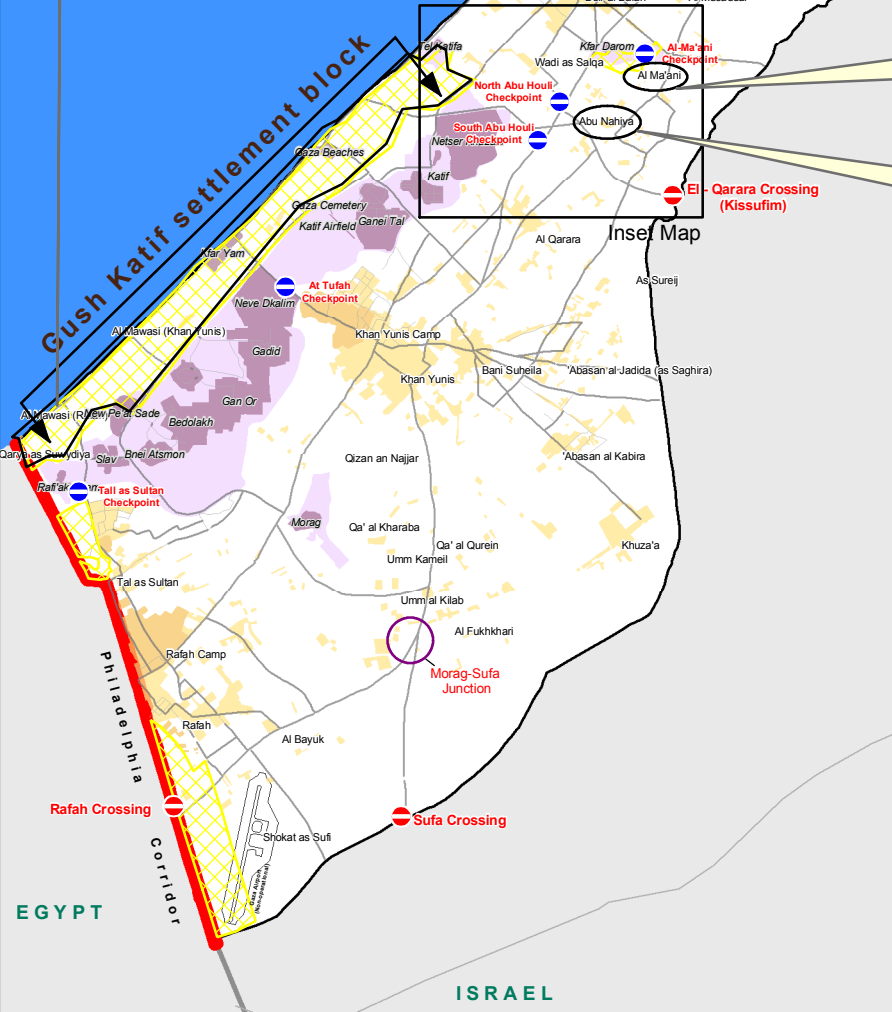
This month:
 - 11 May: Tuffah checkpoint open between 9:30am and 11am
 - 12 May: Tuffah checkpoint closed

Al Ma'ani
 Pop.: Approx. 140
 - Gate opens four times daily

Abu Nahiya
 Pop.: Approx. 150
 - Gate open 24hrs for residents
