



# Indonesia: Flash floods and landslides

"Flash floods and landslides triggered by torrential rains in Trenggalek District, hit six subdistricts on Wednesday 19 April 2006. Flash floods and landslides have killed 16 people and badly injured two others. Six people are reported missing."

## SITUATION

Flash floods and landslides hit at around 01.00 a.m. hours local time with height between 1.5 to 2 meters. Floods damaged telephone lines and cut electricity to many parts of district. More than 5 hectare paddy field inundated and more than 5,000 livestock missing. Infrastructure damages include health centers and market, access routes, irrigation system, a dam and four bridges.

## ACTION

East Java Governor distributed (20 Apr.) instant noodles, medicines, and cash. BAKORNAS PB to monitor emergency response and hand over some relief assistance. Indonesian Red Cross (PMI) deployed 45 SATGANA (Field Action Team) . PMI supporting evacuation process and providing health services, public kitchen, cleaning up locations, and distributing relief items.
