



Bangladesh: Monsoon Floods

"Parts of Bangladesh experienced continuous heavy rainfall in the first week of October."



SITUATION

Non-stop rainfall and water from upstream of India caused flash floods in north and north-western districts of Bangladesh. 19 people dead, while thousands have been marooned. More than 2,500 thatch houses destroyed.

ACTION

Two BDRC/Federation joint assessment teams made assessment of flood in northern districts. BDRCS sent 900 family kits (candles and matches, cooking utensils and plastic sheeting) to affected areas of Joypurhat and Naogan. BDRCS will send 700 family kits in the coming days to Kishorgari and Hossainpur Unions of Palashbari Upazilla in Gaibandha district.
