"Heavy rains in July and August 2005 caused widespread destruction and loss of life in Sudan."



SITUATION

Stagnant water has increased mosquito breeding areas. Burst drainage and sanitation systems creating a health risks in the streets.

ACTION

Immediate material and psychological support provided to the affected population. United Nations Joint Logistic Centre (UNJLC), Sudanese Red Crescent and Sudanese Government assisting in evacuation and supplying relief resources.
