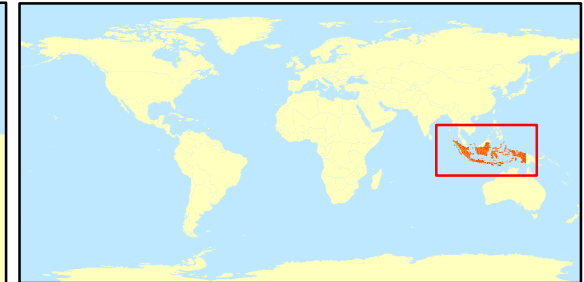
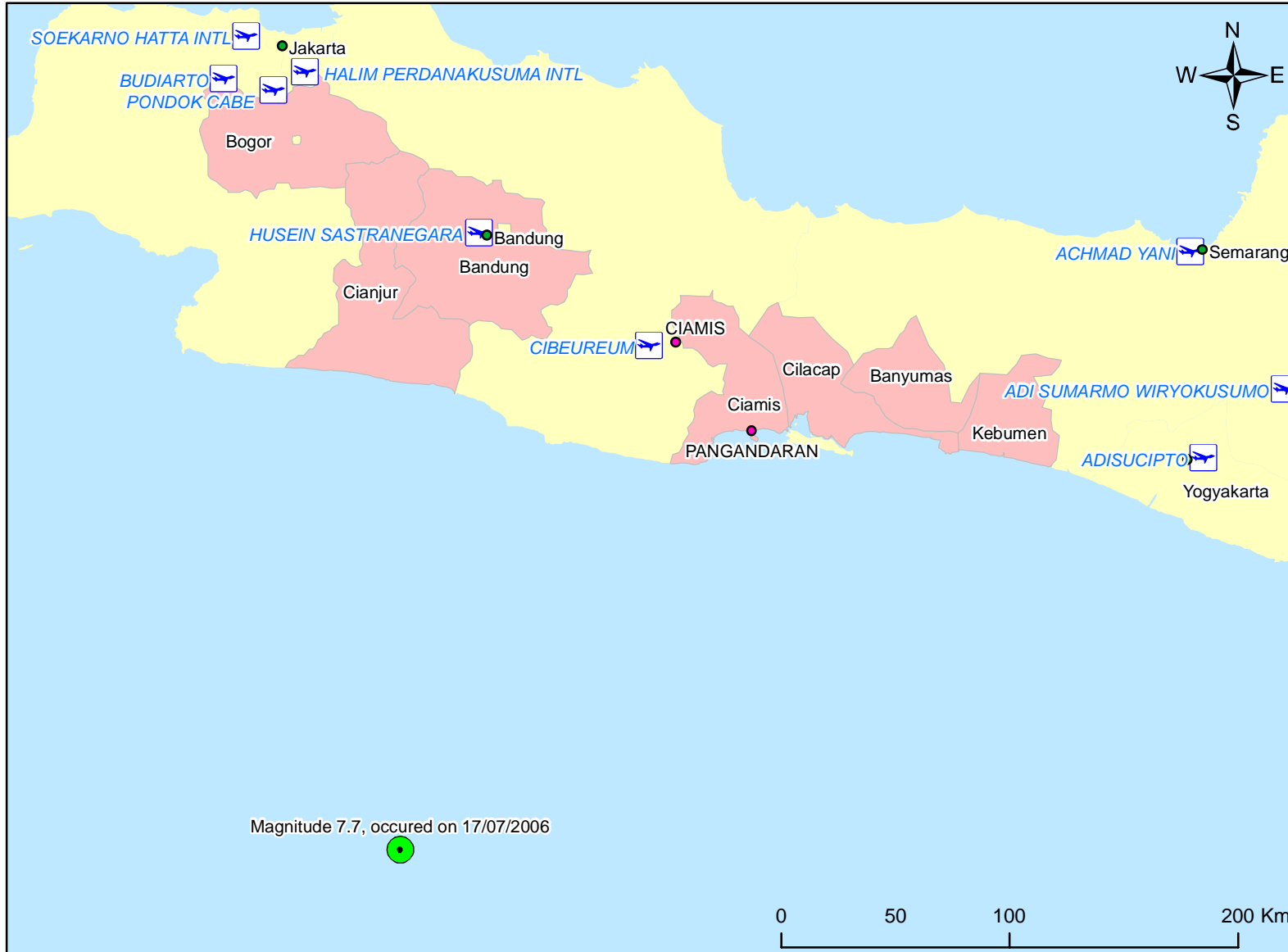




# Indonesia: Western Java Earthquake and Tsunami



Indonesian Red Cross (Palang Merah Indonesia/PMI) branches and chapters in the affected areas are responding to humanitarian needs created by the earthquake and tsunami which struck West and Central Java coast lines Pangandaran in southwest Java on Monday 17 July.

Some 28,400 people have been displaced by the powerful wave which left at least 256 dead.
