



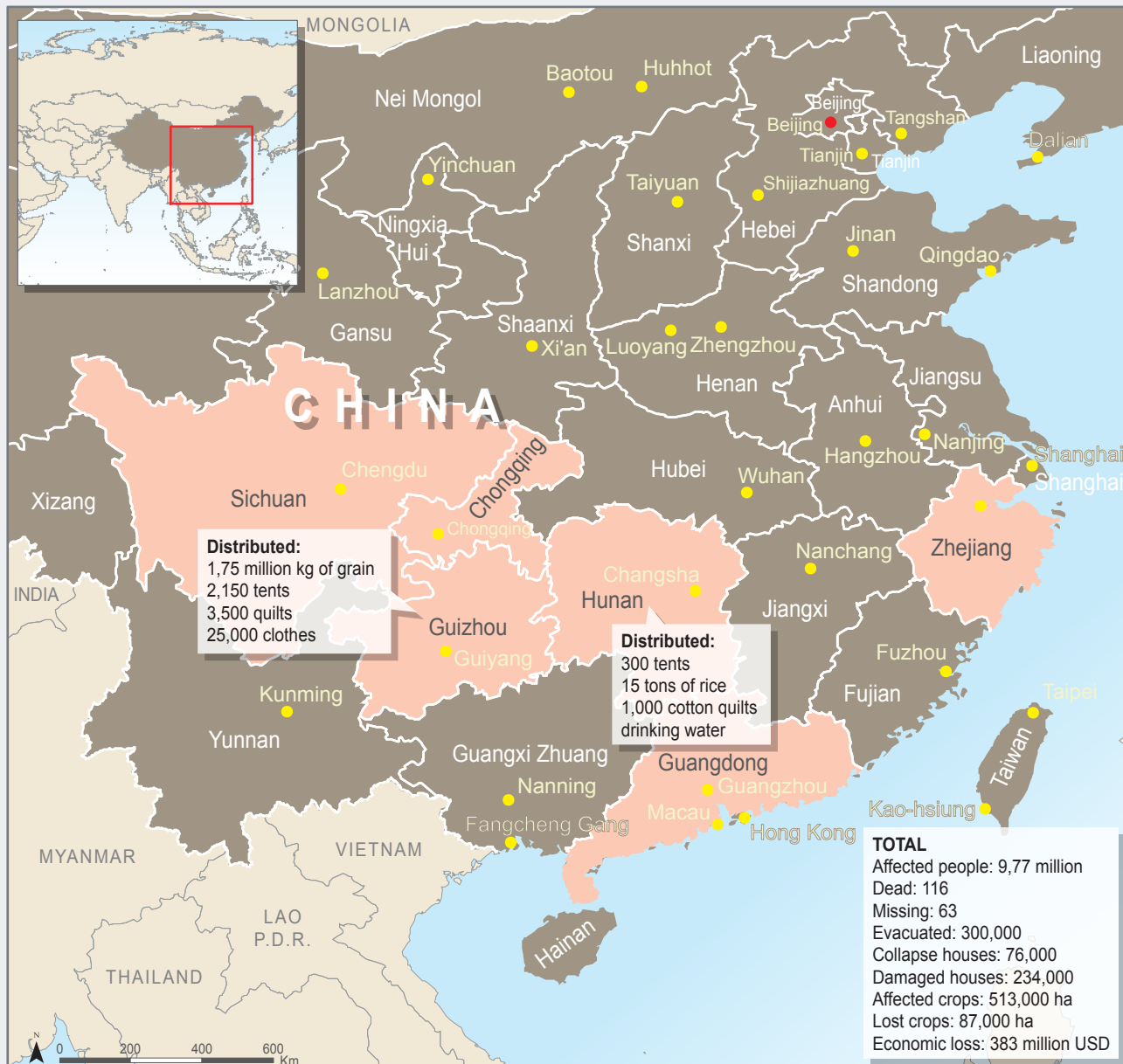
# China: Floods

OCHA Situation Report No. 1

" From 31 May to 2 June 2005, there were heavy rains in South China from the southeast of Sichuan Province to the east of Zhejiang Province. "



## SITUATION

The rainfall exceeded 200 mm in 24 hours in western and central parts of Hunan Province. Due to the heavy rains, severe flash floods, landslides and mud and rock flows occurred in Hunan, Guizhou and Sichuan Provinces.

## ACTION

The Ministry of Civil Affairs has enacted the third level of the Emergency Response Plan. The Ministry consulted with various ministries to coordinate response and relief activities in disaster affected areas.

The Red Cross Society of China is distributing relief items such as quilts, tents and disinfectant to the families displaced by the floods.
