

# Indonesia: Flash floods and landslides

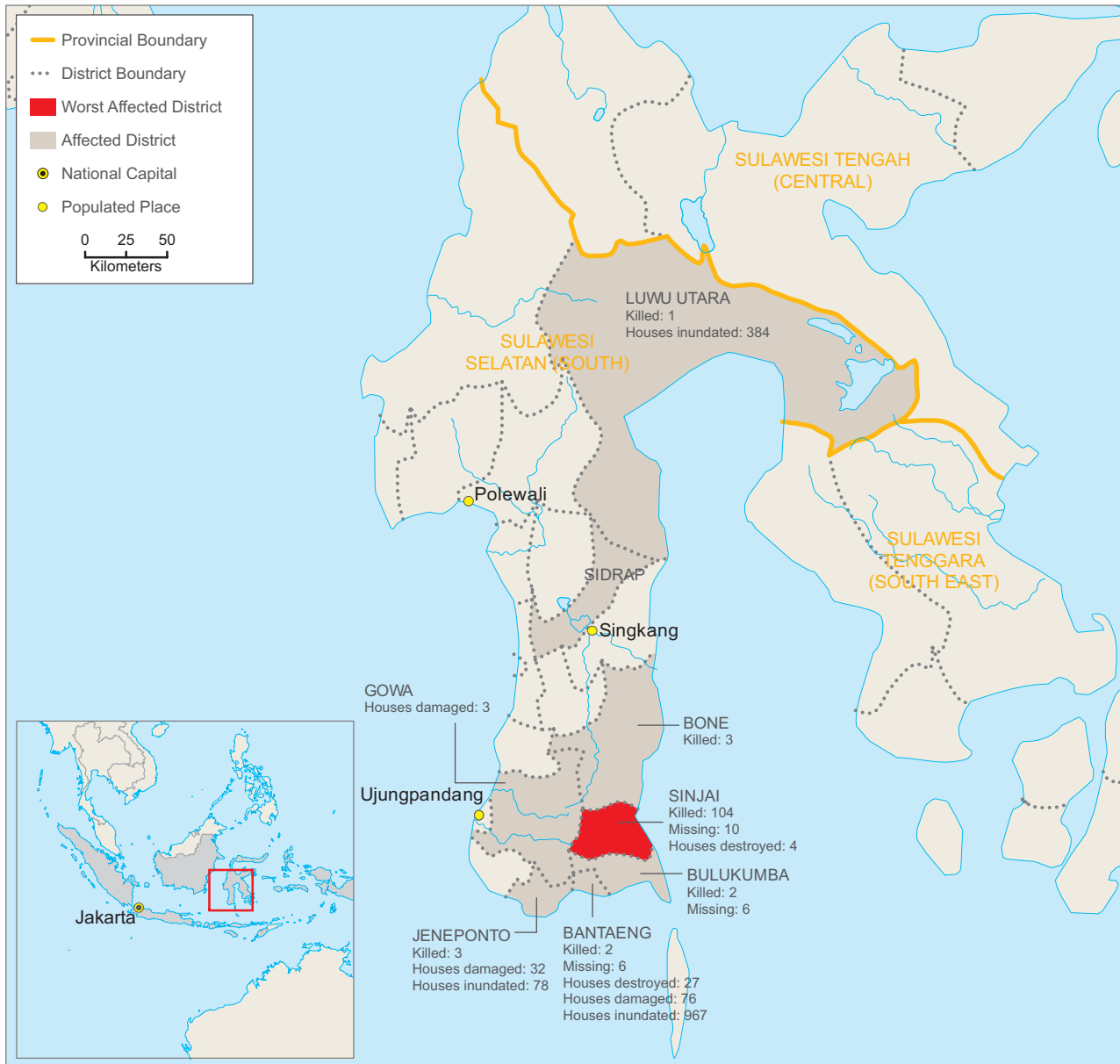

## SITUATION

One to two metre height flash floods hit eight districts in South Sulawesi. Gowa and Sidrap districts also hit by landslides. Reports of significant damage to houses, inundation of rice fields and overflow of fishponds. Main roads and bridges blocked, cutting off access to affected areas.

## ACTION

Indonesian Red Cross, local government and volunteers providing support. Distribution of food and non-food items by Ministry of Social Affairs. Health posts opened by Ministry of Health at provincial and district levels.
