

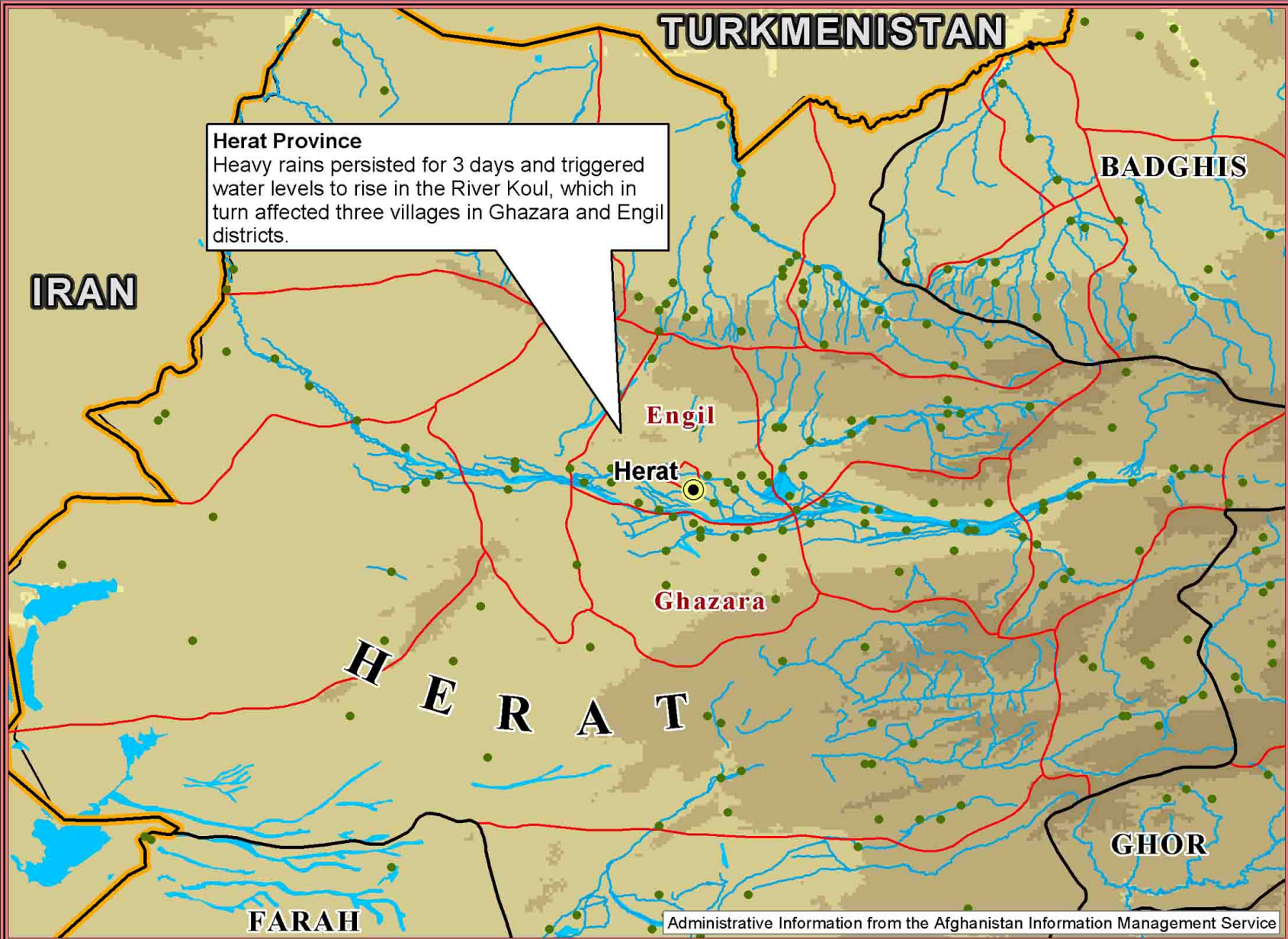
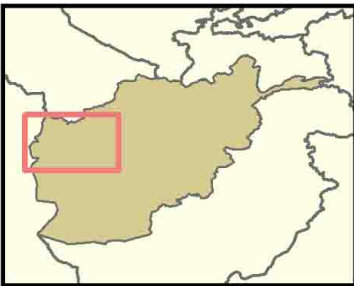


# Afghanistan - Floods

Occurred on 17 January 2004

"On 17 January, heavy rainfall in the Herat region of western Afghanistan resulted in floods that damaged some five hundred houses and affected thousands of families."



**Herat Province**  
Heavy rains persisted for 3 days and triggered water levels to rise in the River Koul, which in turn affected three villages in Ghazara and Engil districts.
