#### I. Incident Profile

- Continuous heavy rains was experienced in CARAGA Region from January 14-17, 2010 due to the prevailing Low Pressure Area (LPA) affecting Eastern Mindanao starting January 16, 2010.
- Said weather disturbance triggered flooding and landslides in the provinces of Agusan del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Surigao del Norte Dinagat Island which resulted to the following effects:

#### II. Effects

##### A. Affected Population

- A total of **8,250 families** or **40,198 persons** were affected in 31 barangays of six (6) municipalities of the above provinces, broken down as follows:

**A. Casualties**

- **Two (2)** persons were reported dead in San Francisco, Agusan del Sur identified as **Lovely Agonos**, 9 years old and **Jalyn Noja Encarnacion**, 11 years old, both are from Purok 7A Brgy. Pagapua who were drowned due to strong current.

**B. Damages**

- Roads to New Visayas and Brgy. Ladgada in San Francisco, Agusan del Sur was rendered not passable due to high flood water
- The slope protection in Cagdianao, Brgy. Poblacion in Dinagat Island incurred damages with an estimated cost of P1.0M

**III. Actions Taken**

- As per request of OCD CARAGA, NDCC-OPCEN facilitated the release of 55 sacks of rice from the NFA for the LGUs of Santiago and Jabonga in Agusan del Norte, LGU of San Francisco in Agusan del Sur and LGU of Mainit in Surigao del Norte
- NFA Regional Office prepositioned 13,300 bags of rice in the Province of Dinagat Islands.
- The Local Government of Jabonga in Agusan del Norte conducted pre-emptive evacuation of residents from Brgys. Colorado, Magsaysay and Poblacion, Likewise, provided food assistance to the affected families.
- Search and Rescue Teams from Agusan del Sur assisted in the conduct of SAR operations of the 2 children who were drowned in Brgy. Tagapua in San Francisco.
- Local Government Units affected by the flashflood conducted assessment on the extent of damages incurred in their respective areas.
