



Viet Nam: Typhoon Damrey

OCHA Situation Report No. 1

"On 26 September, Typhoon Damrey affected all coastal provinces from Quang Ninh to Quang Nam and Da Nang."



SITUATION

By 27 September, wind speed reached 133 km/h hitting provinces from Hai Phong to Thanh. 59 people have died and more than 13 people have been injured. The total death toll by Damrey in the Philippines, China and Viet Nam has reached at least 90.

Storm surges broke several sea dykes in Nam Dinh and Thanh Hoa province. Total number of evacuated people nearly 600,000.

Seawater penetrated inland 3-4 km in coastal provinces and following flash floods in the areas destroyed at least 1,194 houses and damaged 11,576 houses. Total damage estimated is VND 83 billion (approximately USD 5.3 million).

ACTION

The National Red Cross provided VND 100 million and 900 boxes of household kits to Nam Dinh, Thanh Hoa, Hai Phong, Ninh Binh and Thai Binh provinces. Provincial and local governments providing relief food and financial resources.
