

## RECENT ESCALATION OF VIOLENCE (Since 20 January 2018)

**98,000** PEOPLE FROM AFRIN DISTRICT REGISTERED AS DISPLACED OUTSIDE AFRIN

**75,000** IN TAL REFAAT    **15,500** IN NABUL    **8,500** IN ZAHRAA

**FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT IS LIMITED** WITH DISPLACED PEOPLE REPORTEDLY NOT ALLOWED TO MOVE ON TO ALEPPO CITY

PRIMARY AND SECONDARY STUDENTS FROM **310** SCHOOLS HAVE BEEN DEPRIVED OF THEIR EDUCATION SINCE 30 JANUARY DUE TO SCHOOL CLOSURES

**48** SCHOOLS IN AFRIN DISTRICT HAVE BEEN HIT CAUSING PARTIAL DAMAGE TO MOST

ALL **16 SCHOOLS** IN TAL REFAAT ARE BEING USED AS IDP SHELTER RESULTING IN NO EDUCATION TAKING PLACE

## HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

TO RESPOND TO LARGE INFLUX OF INTERNALLY DISPLACED PEOPLE, THE UN IS SCALING-UP RESPONSE TO PEOPLE IN NEED. AID THAT WAS ALREADY DELIVERED INCLUDES:

FOOD	<b>6,015 READY TO EAT RATIONS</b> AND 1,000 BUNDLES OF BREAD (DAILY) TO ZAHRAA AND NABUL
HEALTH	<b>MEDICAL SUPPLIES FOR 29,000</b> IN ZAHRAA AND NABUL, <b>HEALTH SUPPLIES SUFFICIENT FOR 33,700</b> BENEFICIARIES DELIVERED TO AFRIN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
NUTRITION	<b>NUTRITION SUPPLIES FOR 6,500</b> U5 CHILDREN AND PREGNANT AND LACTATING WOMEN IN AFRIN CITY
WASH	<b>250,000 LITERS OF WATER</b> PROVIDED PER DAY THROUGH WATER TRUCKING IN AFRIN CITY NEIGHBORHOODS
PROTECTION	<b>CHILD FRIENDLY SPACE AND COMMUNITY CENTRE</b> (SERVICES FOR CHILD PROTECTION, PSYCHO-SOCIAL SUPPORT AND GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE) IN ZAHRAA AND NABUL

THE UN STANDS READY TO DELIVER MULTI-SECTORAL ASSISTANCE TO **50,000 PEOPLE IN AFRIN AND TAL REFAAT** ONCE APPROVALS ARE PROVIDED AND SECURITY GUARANTEES ARE PROVIDED BY ALL PARTIES. COMMODITIES HAVE ALSO BEEN PRE-POSITIONED TO DELIVER ASSISTANCE ACROSS THE BORDER FROM TURKEY.
