"...a second wave of flooding began on Friday 27 June, when the main Brahmaputra river breached its banks at several places, currently leaving a total of 440,000 people homeless..."



In this second wave of flooding: 763 villages flooded; 160,000 people affected in 400 villages, Goalpara district.
