



# China: Floods

"An estimated 255,300 people are reported to be homeless in China's Hunan province alone as a result of severe flooding."



## SITUATION

Severe flooding destroyed around 30,000 homes and damaged thousands more. Rural farmers in Hunan, Sichuan and Guizhou provinces have seen their crops, livestock, homes and belongings washed away by floods triggered by heavy rains which began on Tuesday 31 May.

## ACTION

RCSC branch has distributed quilts, tents and disinfectant to flood victims. The branch is continuing to run further checks on the disaster conditions and death toll and has requested quilts, rice, tents, clothing and disinfectant from the RCSC's headquarters-based relief division in Beijing.
