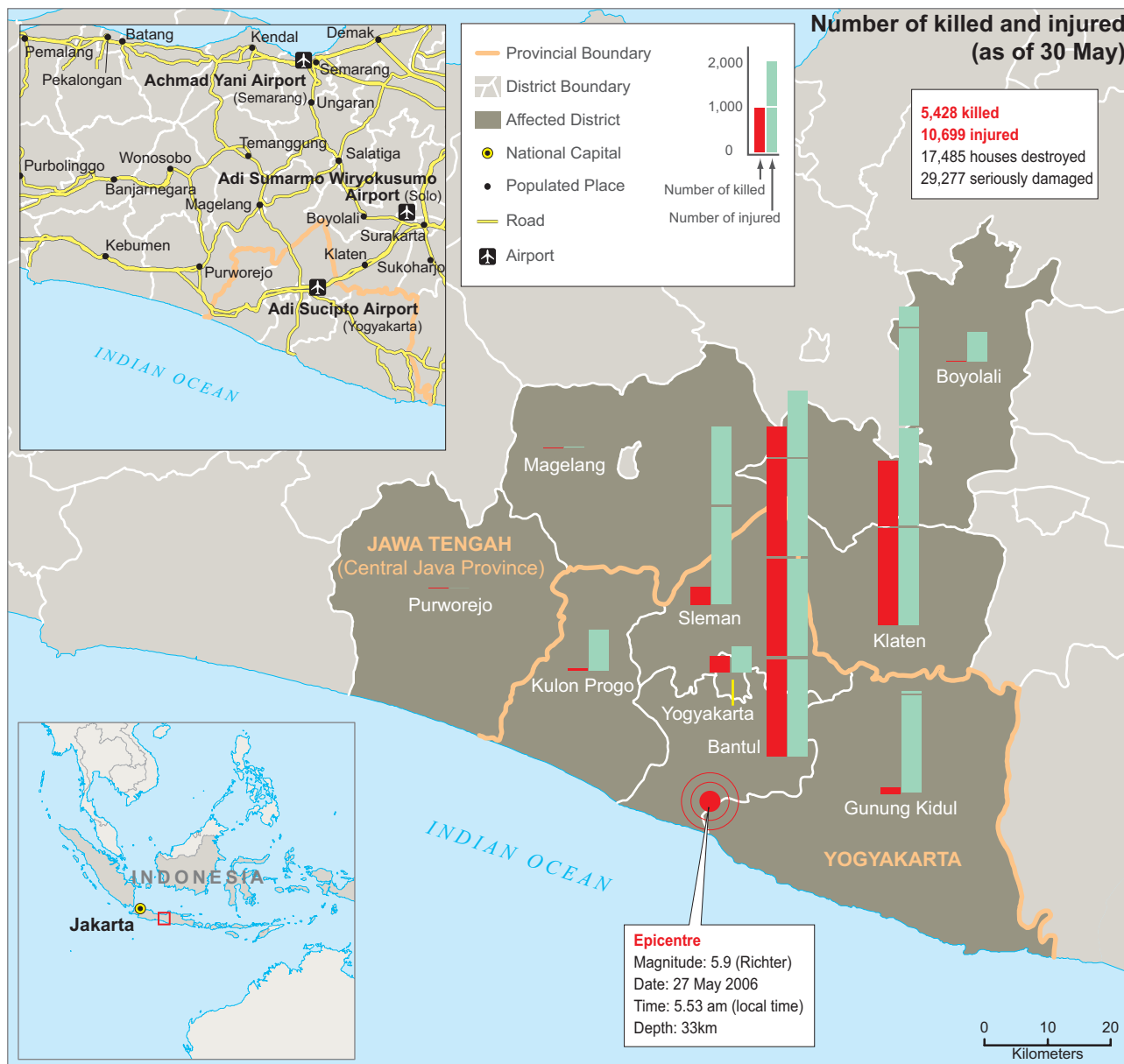


Indonesia: Earthquake

SITUATION

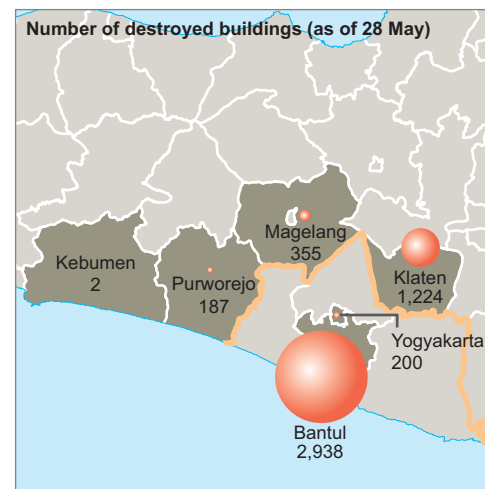
M5.9 earthquake struck Yogyakarta Province on 27 May. 4,568 to 5,428 people reported killed, 100,000 to 200,000 are homeless. 22,048 patients have received treatment in hospitals. Hospitals reported to be overwhelmed in all affected areas. Access to food and cooking facilities badly affected.

ACTION

Gol working to assess damage, renew power to hospitals, release funds for emergency relief and immunize children under five. Bantul coordination meeting among international responders reviewed field assessments and humanitarian response to date in WATSAN, shelter, health, psychosocial (child protection), education and food sectors.
