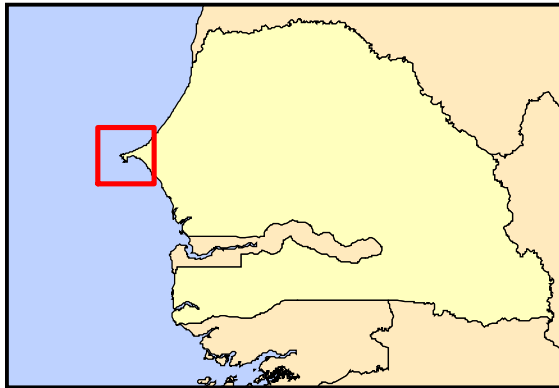


Senegal: Cholera

South District: 29
District of Guediawaye: 26
Center District: 11
District of Pikine: 10

Total: 95

Government doctors reported a cholera breakout in Dakar after early warning systems were triggered by eight reported cases. The number of cases is increasing rapidly and has reached a total of 95. The cases are due to limited access to safe water and sanitation in the affected districts. The epidemic reportedly began on 11 October.

The most affected places are in the Dakar suburbs of Pikine, Guédiawaye, Thiaroye and Colobane.
