"The food security situation in the arid and semi-arid regions of Kenya is rapidly deteriorating."



SITUATION
 2.5 million people require emergency food aid (at 100% food ration) and other non-food interventions. 2 died from starvation in El wak division of Mandera district. High level of malnutrition among children and mothers. Livestock in poor condition. Mass deaths of livestock in Mandera and Marsabit districts. Water situation deteriorated with most water pans and dams drying up. Food situation continues to deteriorate.

ACTION
 DSG Mandera conducted assessment. Kenya Red Cross working closely with government to explore ways and means of reaching the 26,000 people in Takaba and El wak divisions in Mandera district who are at risk of starvation using existing resources.
