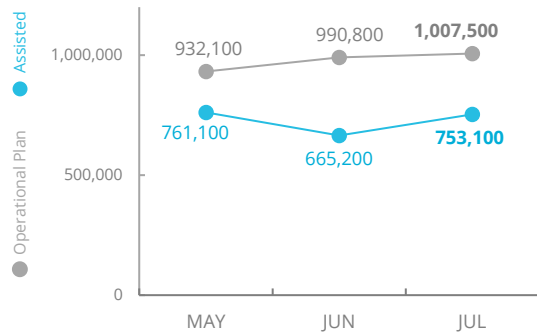


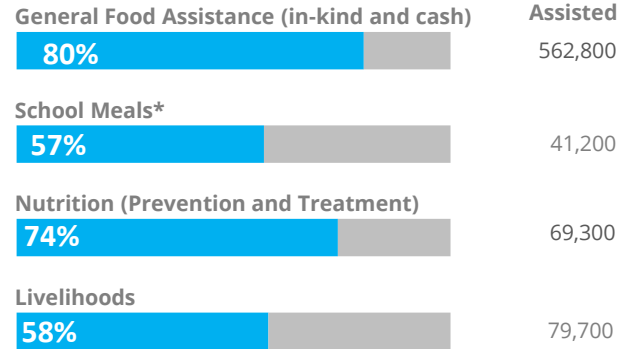

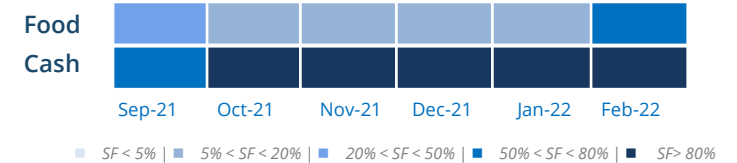

## AVERAGE MONTHLY FUNDING REQUIREMENTS (US\$)

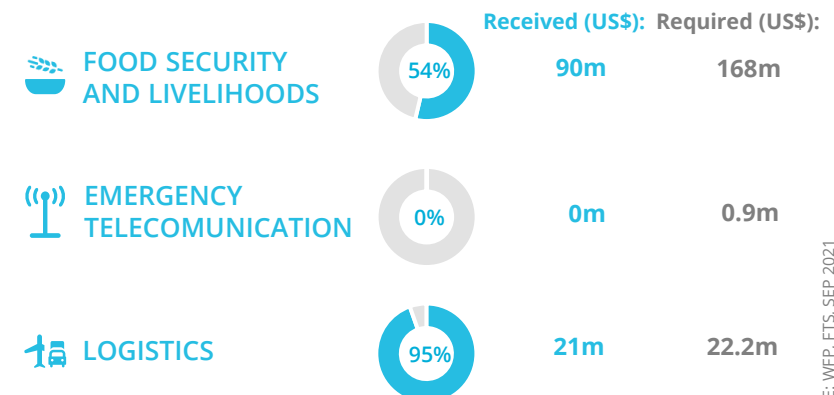


EXPECTED SHORTFALLS



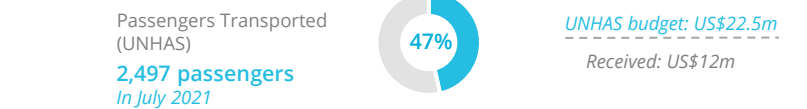

## WFP-LED AND SUPPORTED CLUSTERS

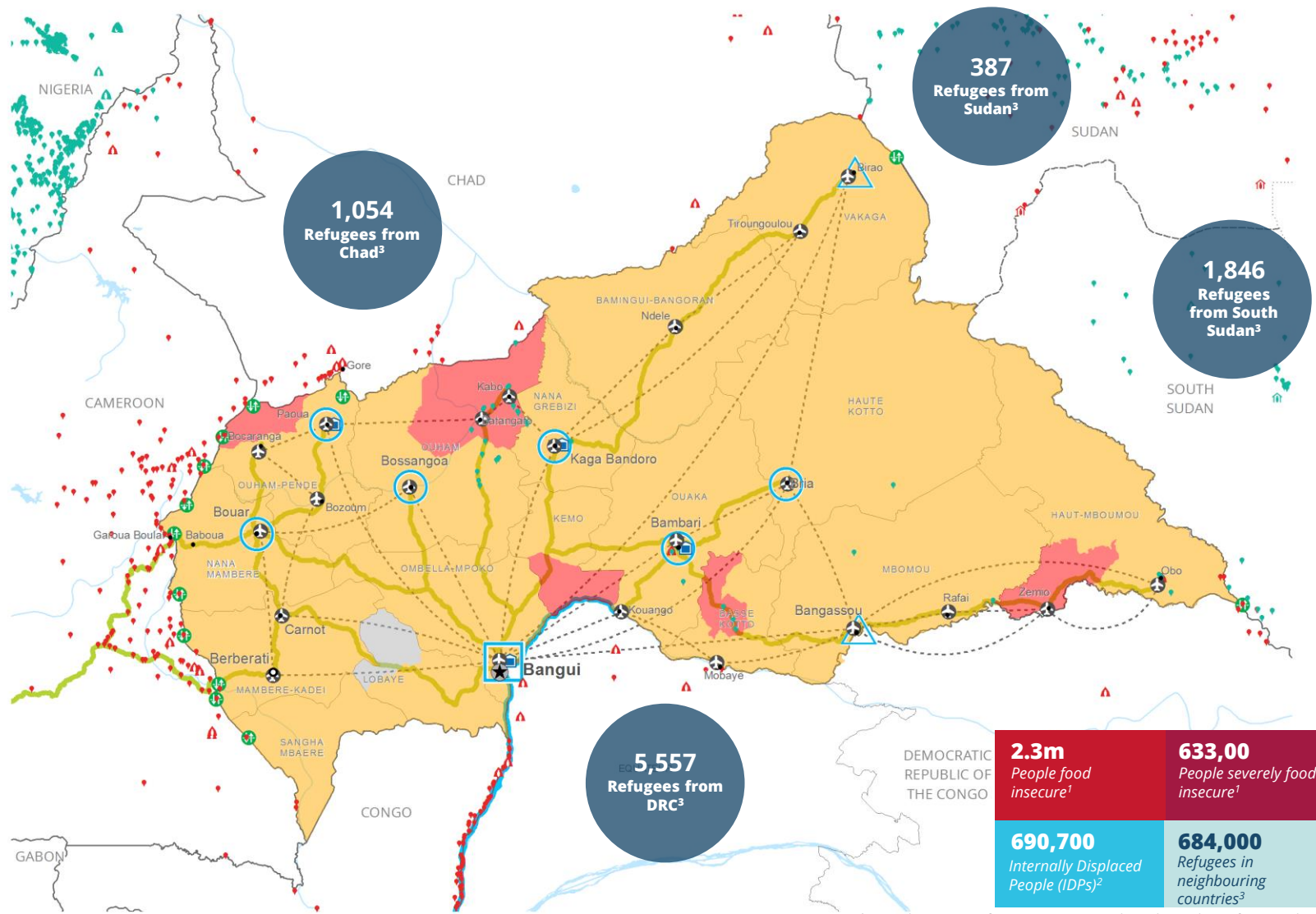

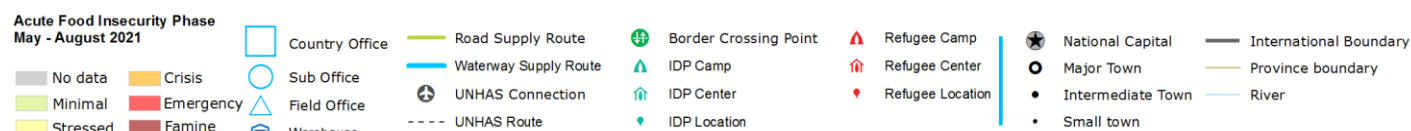
## UN HUMANITARIAN AIR SERVICE (UNHAS)
