Flood, Rainfall And River Situation; Summary of Water Levels; Flood Forecast (24 & 48 Hrs); Latest Weather Situation; Heavy Rainfall Warning; Weather Warning Message; Forecast; Districtwise Flood Status; Responses from different Organizations and Reports on Damage and Relief Activities

Current Situation: Maritime ports of Chittagong, Cox's Bazar and Mongla have been advised to keep hoisted local cautionary signal number three (r) three. All fishing boats and trawlers over North Bay have been advised to remain in shelter till morning tomorrow and then afterwards they may proceed with caution. Heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely to occur at places over Rajshahi, Dhaka, Khulna, Chittagong and Sylhet divisions during next 24 hrs. The Brahmaputra-Jamuna is flowing below danger level at all points. The Ganges-Padma is flowing above danger level at Goalundo and Bhagyakul. The Meghna at Bhairab Bazar continued falling. Small rivers surrounding Dhaka and Narayanganj observed fall. Flood situation around Dhaka city especially in the eastern part of Dhaka is likely to improve further.

FLOOD, RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY (as on AUGUST 14, 2007)

FLOOD OUTLOOK

- The Brahmaputra-Jamuna is flowing below danger level at all points.
- The Ganges-Padma is flowing 23 cm & 29 cm above danger level at Goalundo and Bhagyakul respectively. The river is likely to recede further at Goalundo and Bhagyakul in the next 24, 48 & 72 hrs.
- The kaliganga at Taraghat and the Dhaleswari at Jagir are in falling trend and are likely to continue falling.
- Flood situation in the districts of Manikganj, Munshiganj, Faridpur, Rajbari, Madaripur, Shariatpur, Gopalganj, Chandpur and Dohar & Nawabganj upazila of Dhaka is likely to continue improving further in the next 24, 48 & 72 hrs.

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Situation Report

- The Meghna at Bhairab Bazar continued falling. The flood situation in the districts of Narayanganj, Narshingdi, Brahmanbaria, Kishoreganj & Gazipur will continue to improve further in the next 24, 48 & 72 hrs with the water receding in the river Meghna.
- Small rivers surrounding Dhaka and Narayanganj observed fall. The rivers are expected to fall in a lower rate for next 24, 48 & 72 hrs.
- **Flood situation around Dhaka city especially in the eastern part of Dhaka is likely to improve further and will continue improving in the next 24, 48 & 72 hrs.**
- **The land depression lies over sub Himalayan West Bengal and adjoining area as well marked low (at 6AM today) and is likely to move in north-westerly direction and weaken gradually by giving precipitation (Bangladesh Meteorological Department forecast). Recession of flood water in the central and south-central districts may slightly be delayed by cautionary signal number 3 in the Bay of Bengal.**

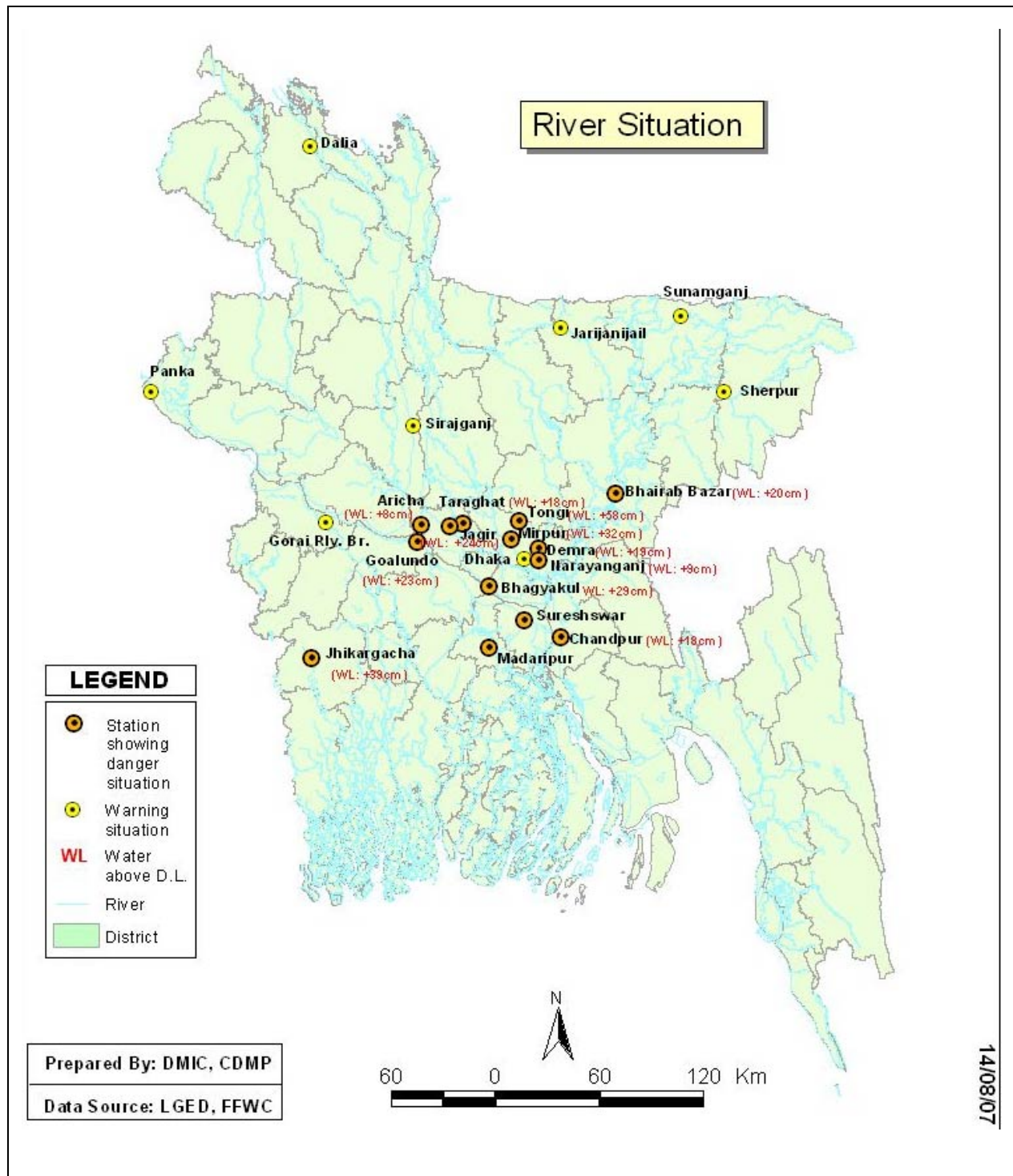

The Brahmaputra-Jamuna at:

- 1) Serajganj is likely to fall by 1 cm and may flow 56 cm below danger level
- 2) Aricha is likely to fall by 5 cm and may flow 11 cm below danger level

The Kaliganga at Taraghat is likely to fall by 14 cm and **may flow 4 cm above danger level**

The Tongi Khal at Tongi is likely to fall by 5 cm and **may flow 53 cm above danger level**

The Turag at Mirpur is likely to fall by 6 cm and **may flow 26 cm above danger level**

The Buriganga at Dhaka is likely to fall by 5 cm and may flow 51 cm below danger level

The Balu at Demra is likely to fall by 3 cm and **may flow 16 cm above danger level**

The Tongi Khal at Tongi is likely to fall by 4 cm and may flow 49 cm above danger level

The Turag at Mirpur is likely to fall by 3 cm and may flow 23 cm above danger level

The Buriganga at Dhaka is likely to fall by 4 cm and may flow 55 cm below danger level

The Balu at Demra is likely to fall by 4 cm and may flow 12 cm above danger level

GENERAL RIVER CONDITION

- 12 water level monitoring stations are flowing above danger levels: (The Balu at Demra by 19 cm, the Lakhya at Narayanganj by 9 cm; the Turag at Mirpur by 32 cm, the Tongi Khal at Tongi by 58 cm; the Kaliganga at Taraghat by 18 cm; the Dhaleswari at Jagir by 24 cm & at Rekabi Bazar by 48 cm; the Padma at Goalundo by 23 cm & at Bhagyakul by 29 cm; the Kobadak at Jhikargacha by 39 cm; the Meghna at Bhairab Bazar by 20 cm and lowest water level at Chandpur by 18 cm.)
- Water Level stations: Rise: 17 Fall: 42 Steady: 2 Not reported: 2
- The Rivers in Brahmaputra, Ganges and Meghna basins have been observed to both rise & fall. But, most of the rivers in the South Eastern Hill basin have been observed to rise.

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LATEST WEATHER SITUATION (as on AUGUST 14, 2007 at 1600 BST)

SQUALLY WEATHER UNLIKELY.

MARITIME PORTS OF CHITTAGONG, COX'S BAZAR AND MONGLA HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO LOWER SIGNAL.

HEAVY RAINFALL WARNING (as on AUGUST 14 at 1200 BST)

UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF WELL MARKED LOW OVER SUB-HIMALAYAN WEST BENGAL AND ADJOINING AREA AND ACTIVE MONSOON OVER BANGLADESH HEAVY TO VERY HEAVY RAINFALL IS LIKELY TO OCCUR AT PLACES OVER RAJSHAHI, DHAKA, KHULNA, CHITTAGONG AND SYLHET DIVISIONS DURING NEXT 24 HRS COMMENCING 03 PM OF A4 AUGUST 2007.

WARNING MESSAGE (as on AUGUST 14, 2007 at 0930 BST)

THE LAND DEPRESSION OVER WEST BENGAL AND ADJOINING BANGLADESH MOVED NORTH-NORTH-WESTWARDS AND NOW LIES OVER SUB-HIMALAYAN WEST BENGAL AND ADJOINING AREA AS A WELL MARKED LOW (AT 06 AM TODAY, THE 14TH AUGUST 2007). IT IS LIKELY TO MOVE IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION FURTHER INLAND AND WEAKEN GRADUALLY BY GIVING PRECIPITATION. UNDER ITS INFLUENCE STEEP PRESSURE GRADIENT PERSISTS OVER NORTH BAY. SQUALLY WEATHER MAY CONTINUE TO AFFECT THE MARITIME PORTS.

MARITIME PORTS OF CHITTAGONG, COX'S BAZAR AND MONGLA HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO KEEP HOISTED LOCAL CAUTIONARY SIGNAL NUMBER THREE (R) THREE.

ALL FISHING BOATS AND TRAWLERS OVER NORTH BAY HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO REMAIN IN SHELTER TILL MORNING TOMORROW AND THEN AFTERWARDS THEY MAY PROCEED WITH CAUTION.

WEATHER FORECAST (VALID FOR 24 HOURS COMMENCING 09 AM TODAY)

Synoptic Situation: The land depression over West Bengal and adjoining Bangladesh moved north-northwestwards and now lies over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and adjoining area as a well marked low (at 06 AM today the 14 August, 2007). It is likely to move in a northwesterly direction further inland and weaken gradually by giving precipitation. Under its influence steep pressure gradient persists over North Bay. Monsoon is active over Bangladesh and moderate/ strong over North Bay.

Forecast: Light to moderate rain/T. showers accompanied by tempo. gusty/squally wind is likely to occur at many places over Rajshahi, Dhaka, Khulna, Barisal, Chittagong and Sylhet divisions with moderately heavy to heavy falls at places.

Day temperature may rise slightly over the country.

EARTHQUAKE OCCURRENCE MESSAGE (as on AUGUST 13, 2007 at 1800 BST)

An earthquake occurred on 13 August 2007 at 14 hours 28 minutes 41.71 seconds. The distance of the Epicentre was about 337 kms from Agargaon, Dhaka Seismic Observatory. The magnitude of the earthquake was 3.7 in Richter scale (Minor).

DISTRICTWISE FLOOD STATUS

Dhaka Division

Dhaka

Overall flood situation of this district have been improved. DC himself distributed relief to kamrangir char, sultanganj and many areas of this district. Nawabganj, Dohar and Dhamrai area have been affected by diarrhoea. Medical team is active there.

Narayanganj

Situation has been improved further. The Meghna and the Shitalakhya both are continuing to decrease.

Munshiganj

DC has been visited flood affected area last 13th August. At present overall flood situation improved further and getting normal. People started to return to their home from the flood shelters.

Tangail

DC is visiting flood affected area and monitoring relief distribution process. Flood situation is improving. Situation has been improved at all places except Mirzapur upazila. The Bangladesh Army is helping the local administration continuously.

Faridpur

Flood water moved away. DC is visiting flood affected area and monitoring flood distribution process. Flood situation has got better.

Rajbari

Flood situation is almost normal. People started to return home from shelter. River is receding and flood situation of the district is developing

Madaripur

Flood situation is likely to improve but rehabilitation process is going to prepare. River is falling rapidly and the situation is improving at a very good pace. People from different flood shelters started to return to their homes.

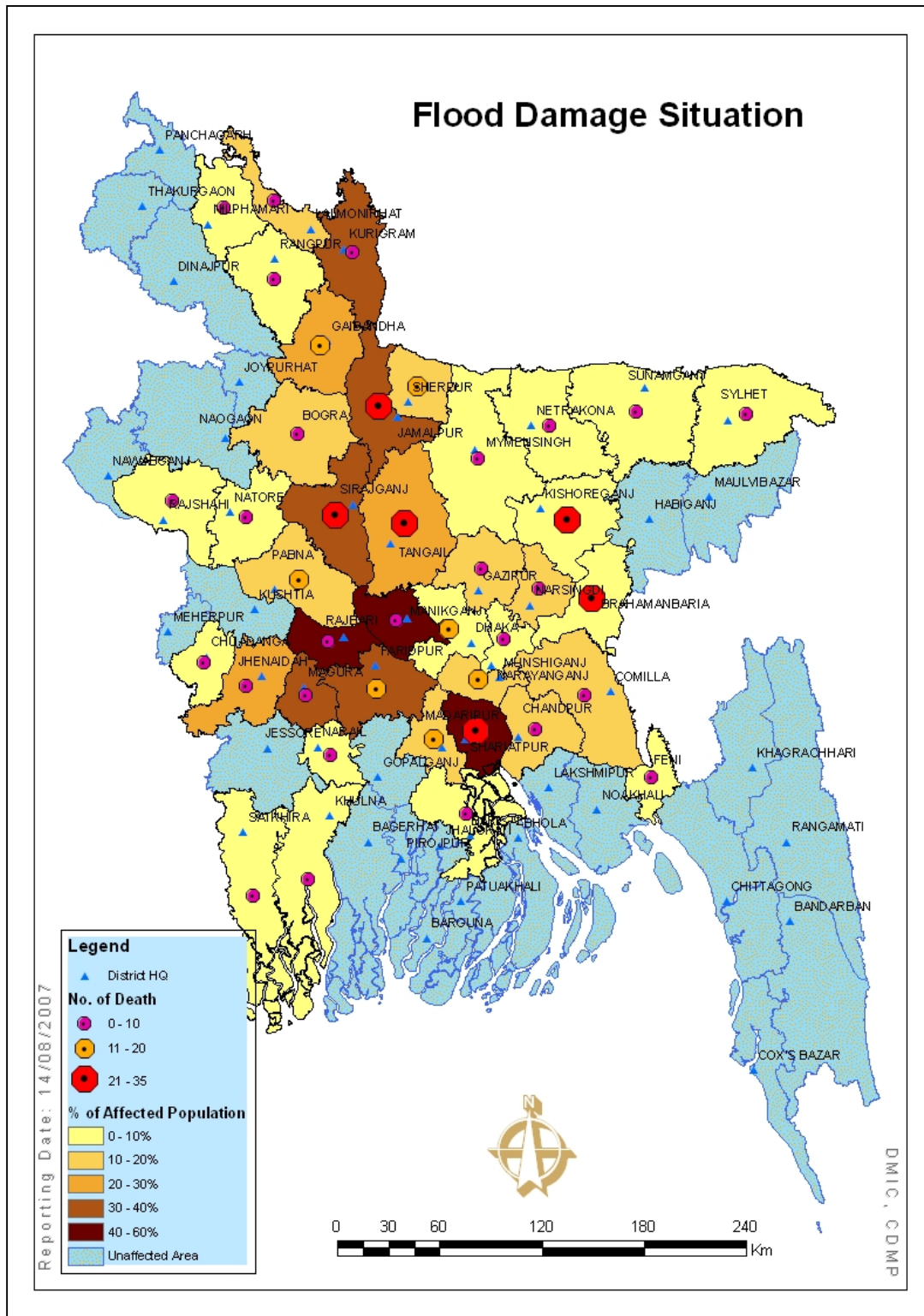
Sariatpur

DC is visiting flood affected area and monitoring relief distribution process. Water level of the rivers is continuing to decrease. Overall flood situation has started to improve. The International Red Cross Society has started to distribute relief among the affected people

Gopalganj

Water is decreasing. Overall flood situation started to improve. DC is visiting flood affected area and monitoring relief distribution process.

Bogra

Flood situation improved. Rehabilitation programme is on process. 241275 people, 48255 families of 3 pouroshovas and 29 unions of 4 upazilas are affected. 4300 people at 17high lands of Sariakandi, 200 people at Dhunot Pijela embankment 4000 people at Sonatola upazila embankment took shelter.

Other Districts

Other 29 districts (Manikganj, Narsingdi, Gazipur, Mymensingh, Jamalpur, Sherpur, Netrokona, Kishorganj, Rajshahi, Sirajganj, Pabna, Nilphamari, Lalmonirhat, Natore, Rangpur, Gaibandha, Kurigram, Khulna, Satkhira, Magura, Narail, Jinaidah, Comilla, B.Barua, Chandpur, Feni, Sylhet, Habiganj, Sunamganj) were flood affected. It has been informed that flood situation is no longer prevailed at these districts and preparation for post flood rehabilitation programme is on the process.
