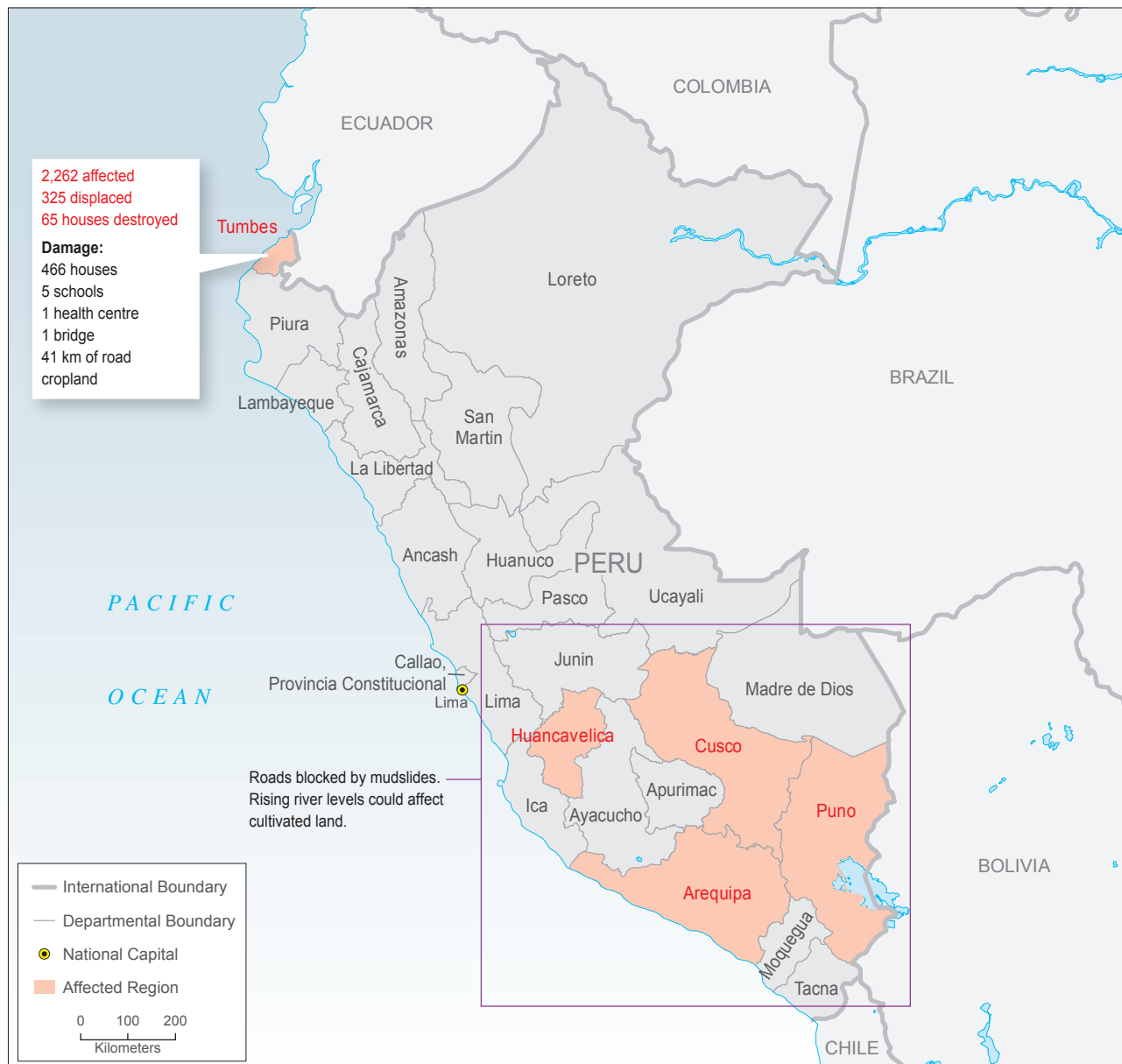

SITUATION

Schools, a health centre, transportation, and agriculture have also been affected. Affected population poor and unable to cope with situation. Torrential rains and mudslides have also affected southern area of Peru. World Meteorological Organization and local organizations are predicting possible "la Niña" phenomenon and more rains in coming days.

ACTION

Damage assessments in affected areas are ongoing. Regional Committee of the Civil Defence working with local committees to provide support to affected areas. Hygiene kits, kitchen sets, shelter, sand bags, plastic sheeting and other materials distributed to families.
