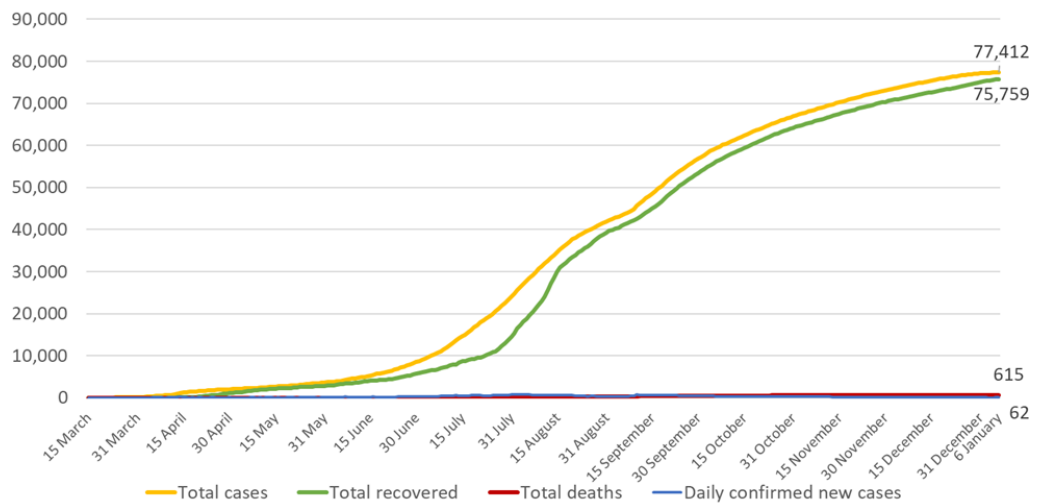

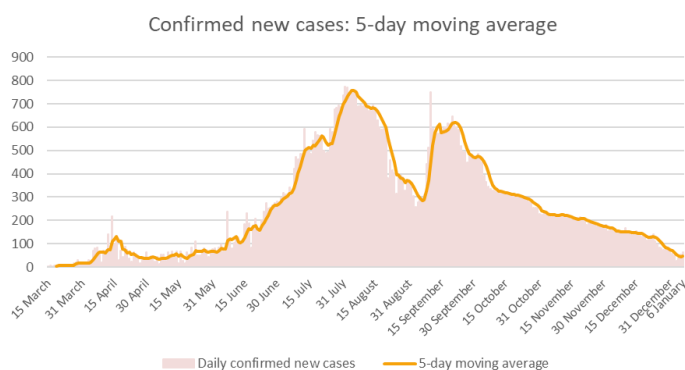
COVID-19 cases in Uzbekistan

- Checkpoint on the Uzbek-Tajik border resumed its work for the first time since March 2020

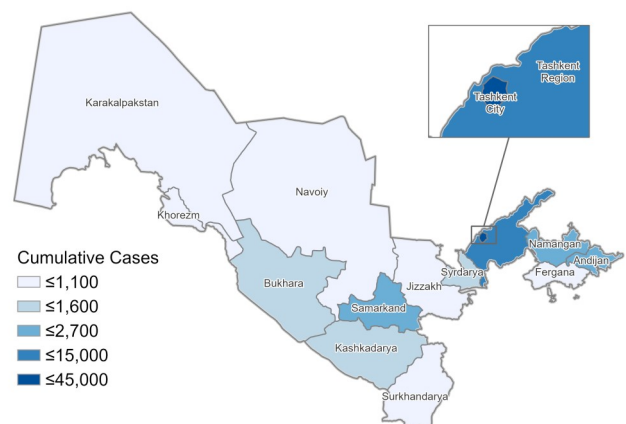
EPIDEMIOLOGICAL UPDATE



This chart shows the daily increase in confirmed new cases, as well as a 5-day moving average which helps smooth out the 'noise' from short-term fluctuations by averaging the data from the last five days reported.

Latest National COVID-19 Response News

- As of 6 January, **1,038 patients are being treated** in medical institutions, of whom **155 are in serious condition and 30 are in critical condition** (MoH on coronavirus.uz and via Public Relations Dept).
- Checkpoint “Jartepa”, located on the border of Uzbekistan and Tajikistan in the Urgut district of the Samarkand region, resumed its work for the first time since March 2020. Currently only international cargo transportation is allowed to pass through the checkpoint. Additional information on when people be allowed to cross the border through this checkpoint will be publish by the Customs department (podrobno.uz).
- More than 12 thousand passengers from 12 countries arrived to Uzbekistan by air over the past week with 21 of them being diagnosed with COVID-19 after taking rapid COVID-19 antigen test on arrival. Testing is carried out at airports, train stations and border points at the

expense of visitors. This procedure also applies to those who have a certificate with a negative PCR COVID-19 test. ([Ministry of Health](https://ministryofhealth.uz) and podrobno.uz)

- Uzbekistan to build a distribution center for COVID-19 patients in the Khatlon region on the south of Tajikistan. It is planned to be finished in spring 2021 (gazeta.uz).
- A group of 20 Afghan medical workers arrived in Uzbekistan to study country’s experience in the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of COVID-19. They will take master classes in infectious diseases hospitals in Zangiata region, get acquainted with the work in central and family polyclinics, and visit Samarkand region (gazeta.uz).
