

# Camp Departure Follow-up Survey

## Sept 2019 - 19 January 2021 | Round 31



### Overview

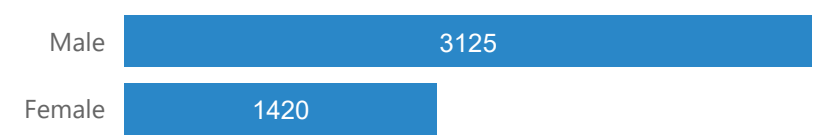
A Follow-Up Survey, jointly developed by the CCCM and Protection Clusters and the Iraq Information Centre (IIC), is conducted by the IIC with families leaving camps around 2 weeks after their departure, based on data provided by participating camp management agencies through the Camp Exit Survey. This dashboard presents an overview of the compiled data from all surveys conducted from their start in September 2019, to date. Data is indicative only to the number of people reached by the Iraq Information Center for follow-up calls. Needs represented are for families who have departed to out-of-camp locations.

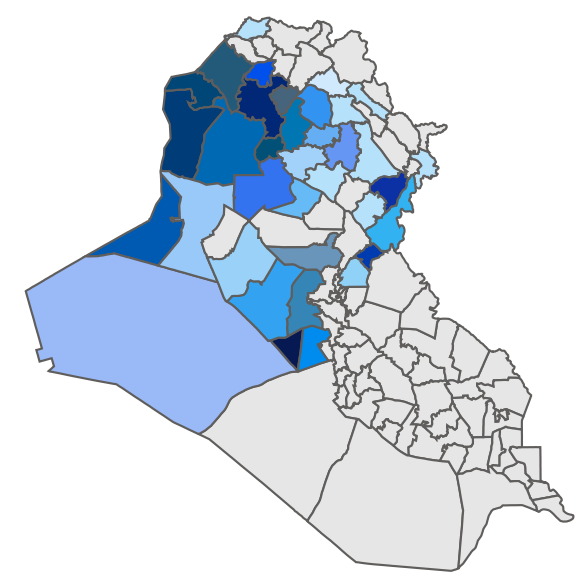

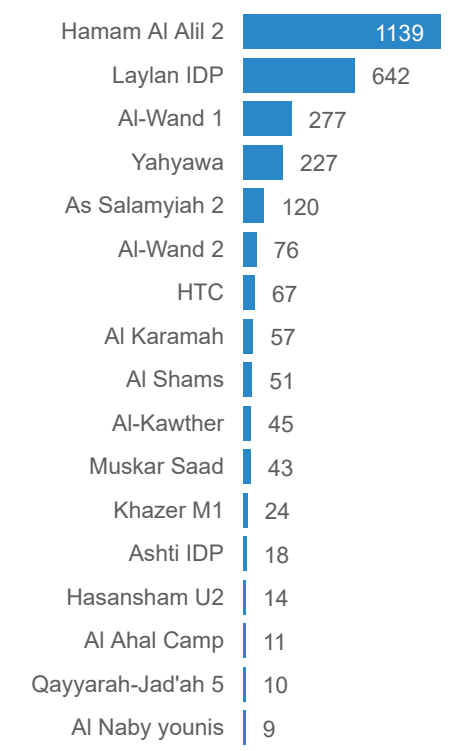

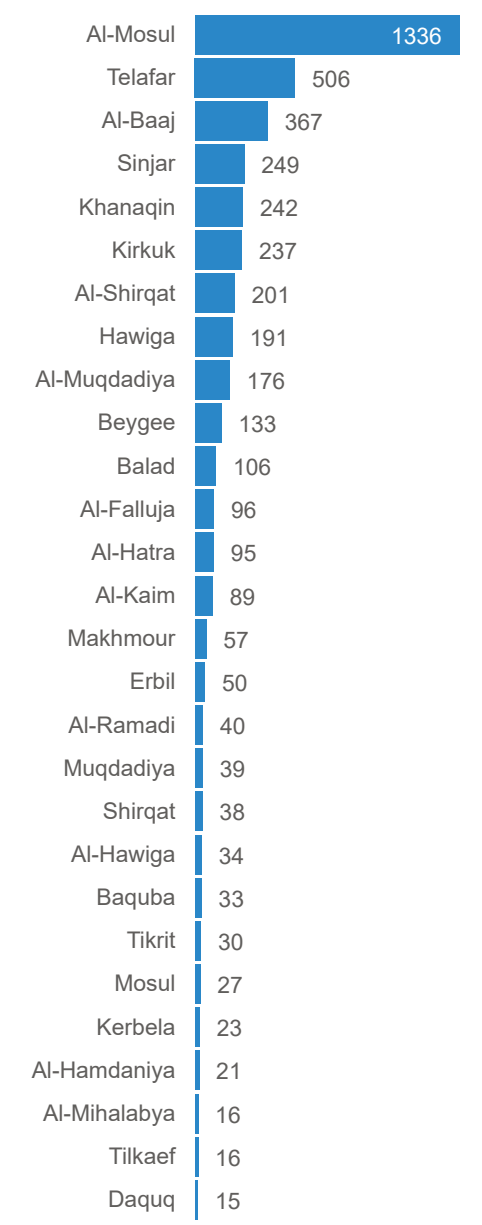

### # HHs by camp of departure (from 22 Sept 2020)

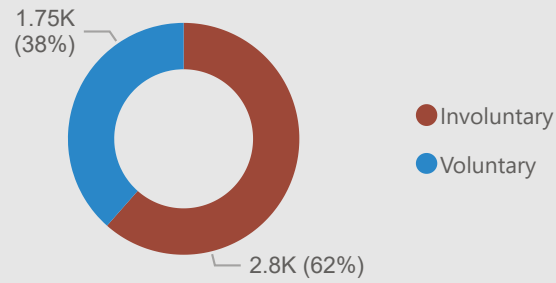


### # of HHs by arrival district

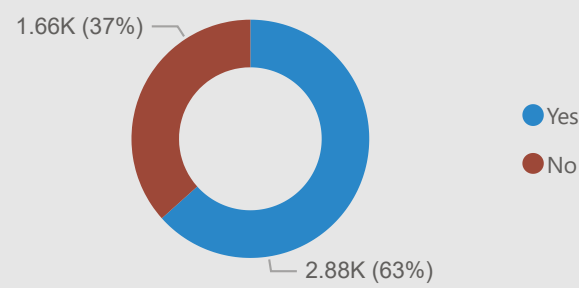

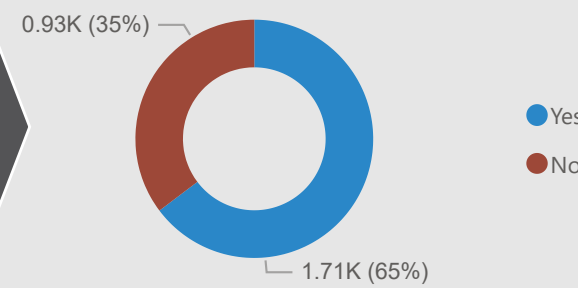
% HHs who report their departure from the camp was voluntary



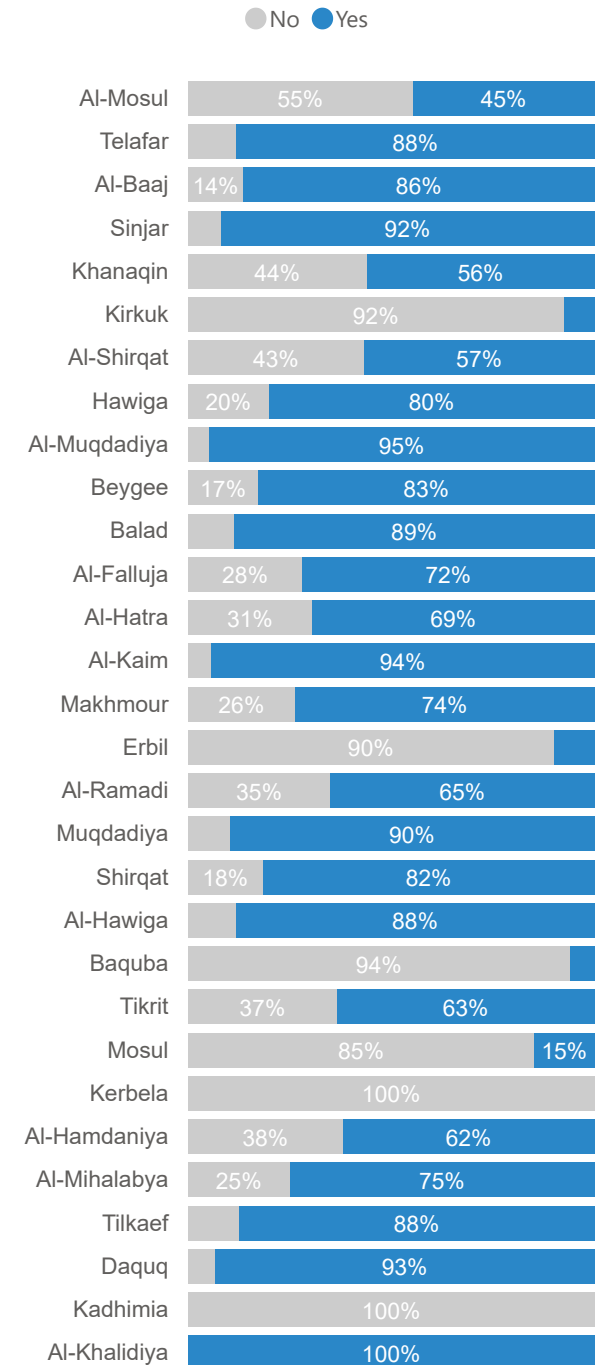
% HHs that returned to their area of origin (neighbourhood of habitual residence)



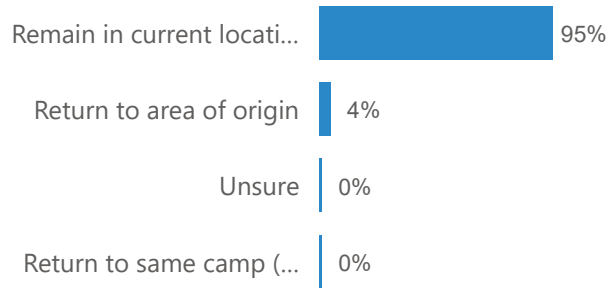
% HH that returned to their previous residence, of HH that returned to AoO



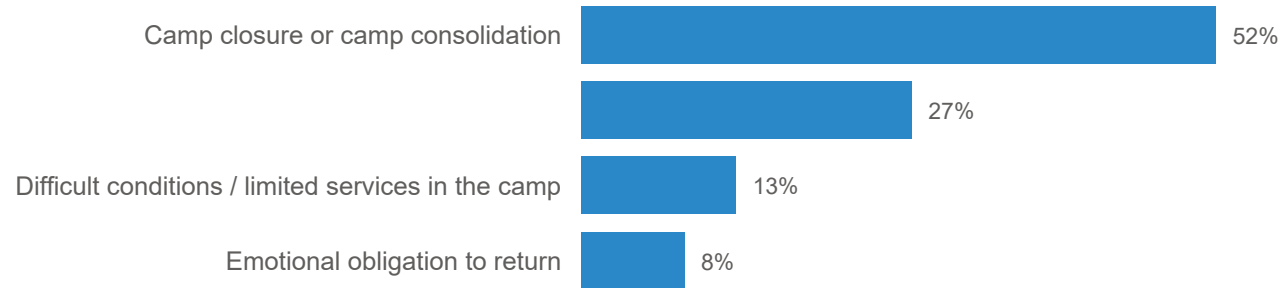
% HH returned to area of origin (neighbourhood of habitual residence), by district of arrival



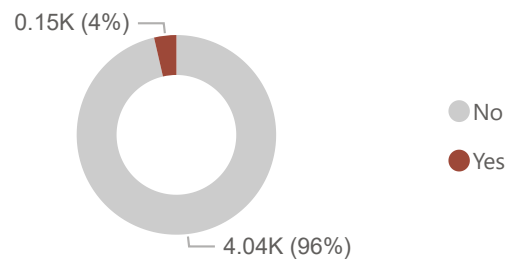
HH intentions in the next month



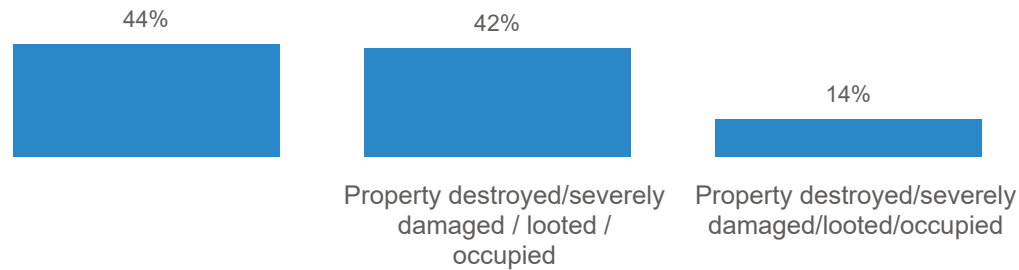
Top reported reasons for leaving the camp



% HH reporting family separation on leaving the camp



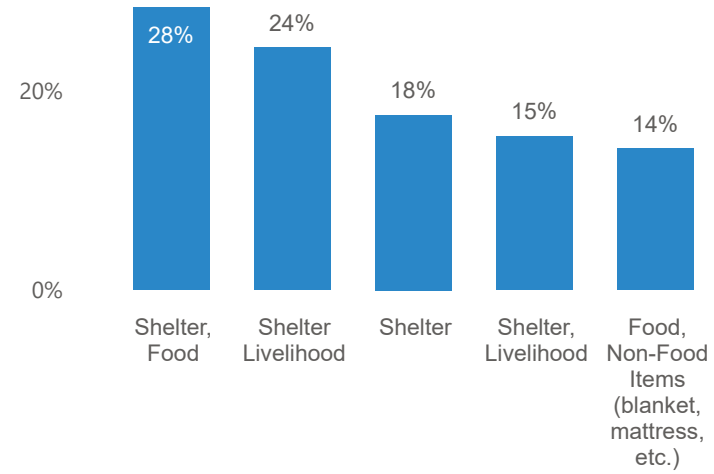
Top reported reasons why HHs did not return to area (neighbourhood) of origin



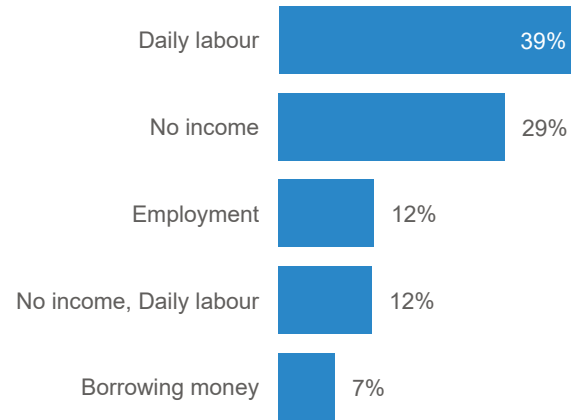

## % HHs reporting access to sufficient food to meet basic needs, by district

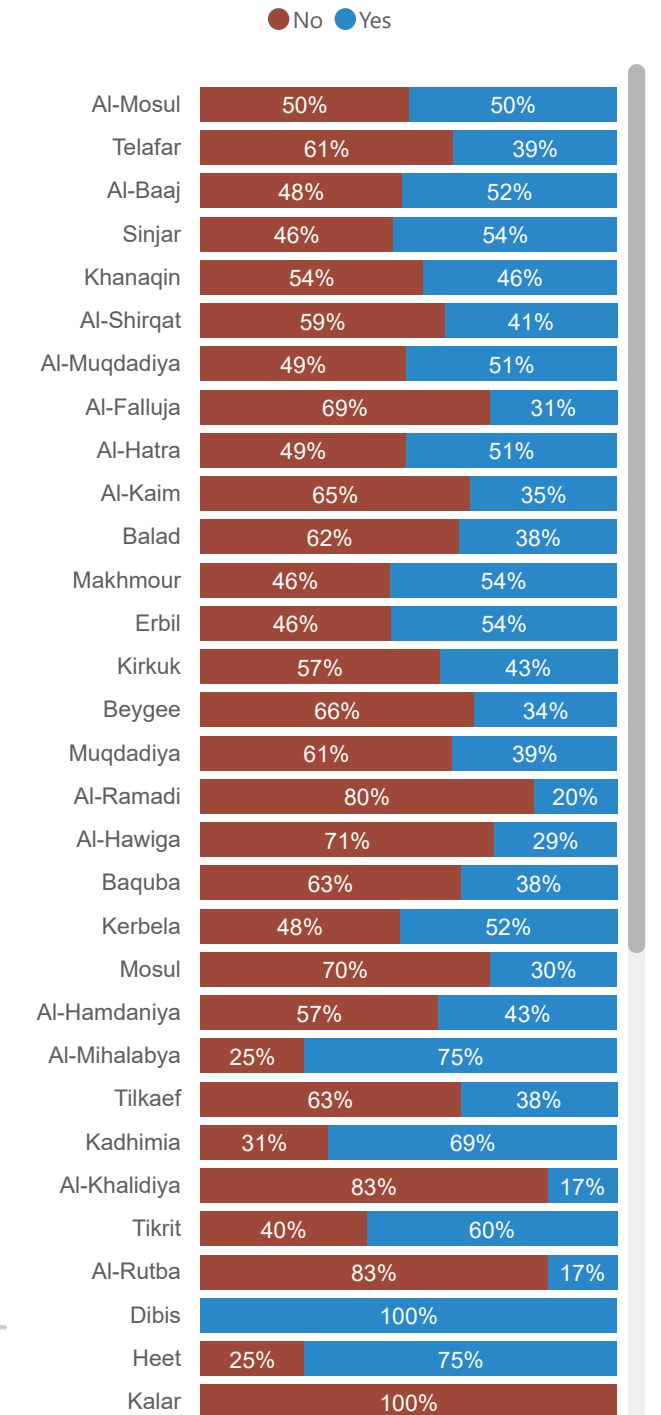
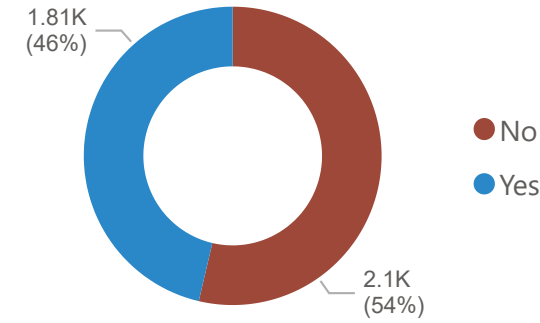
Most commonly reported top two priority needs or concerns



Top reported sources of income, since leaving the camp

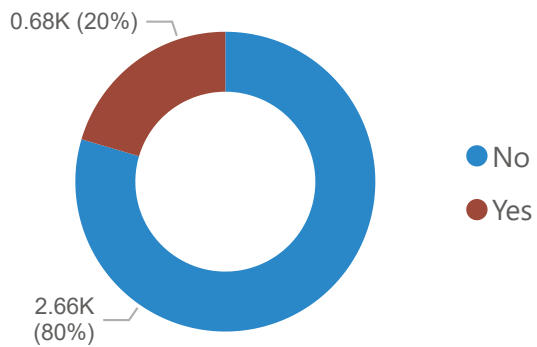


Percent of HHs reporting access to sufficient food to meet basic needs

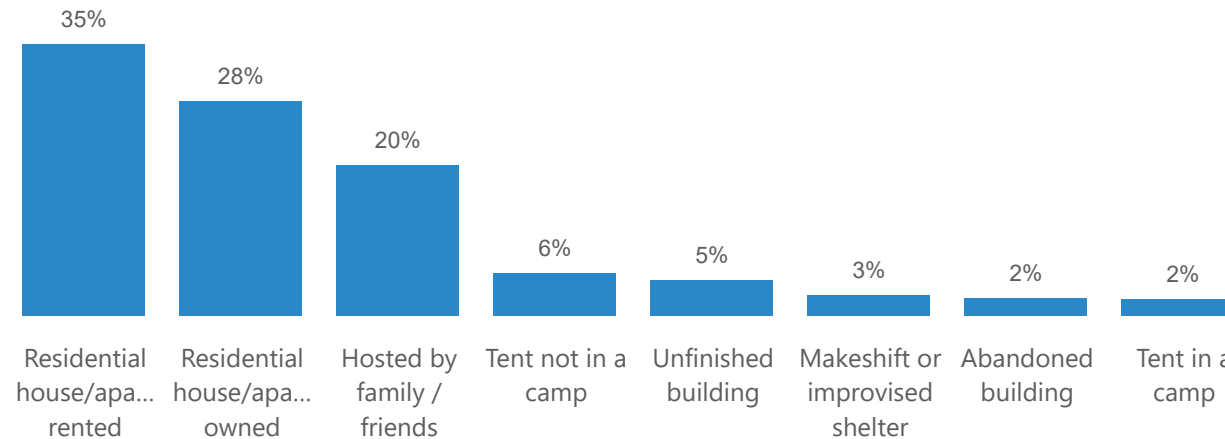

% HH reporting fearing eviction

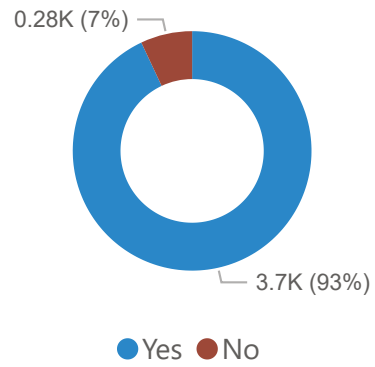


Top reported current shelter type

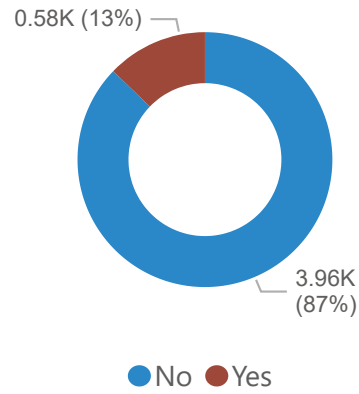

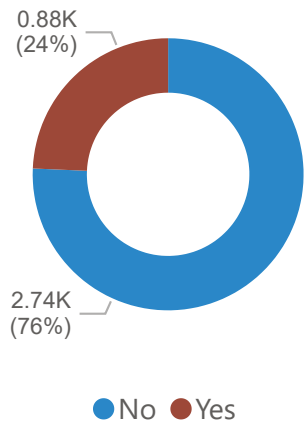
Percent of HHs reporting feeling safe in their current area



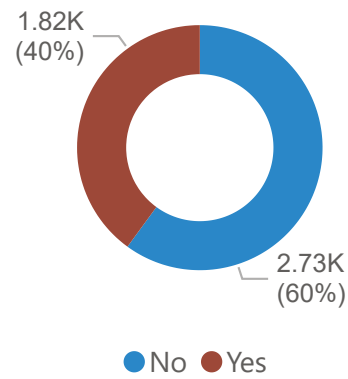
% HHs with family members missing civil documents



% HHs reporting at least one member having a disability

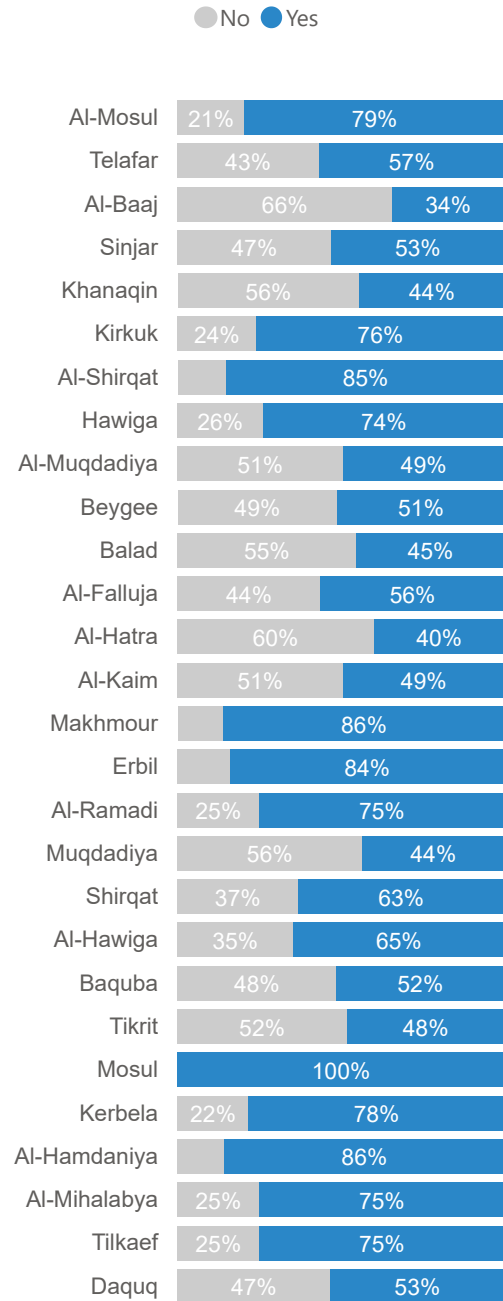


% HHs reporting at least one member in need of & unable to access medical assistance

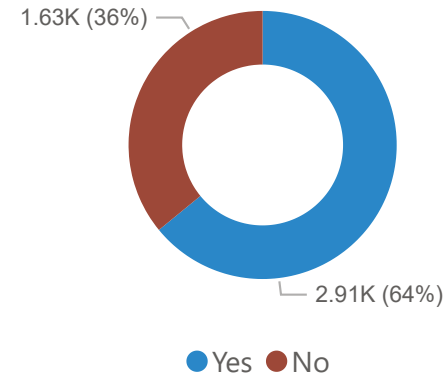

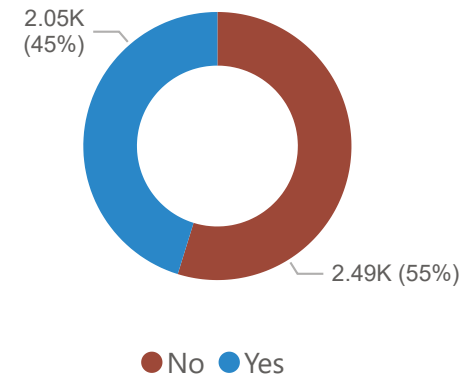
% HHs reporting regular access to sufficient drinking water, by district



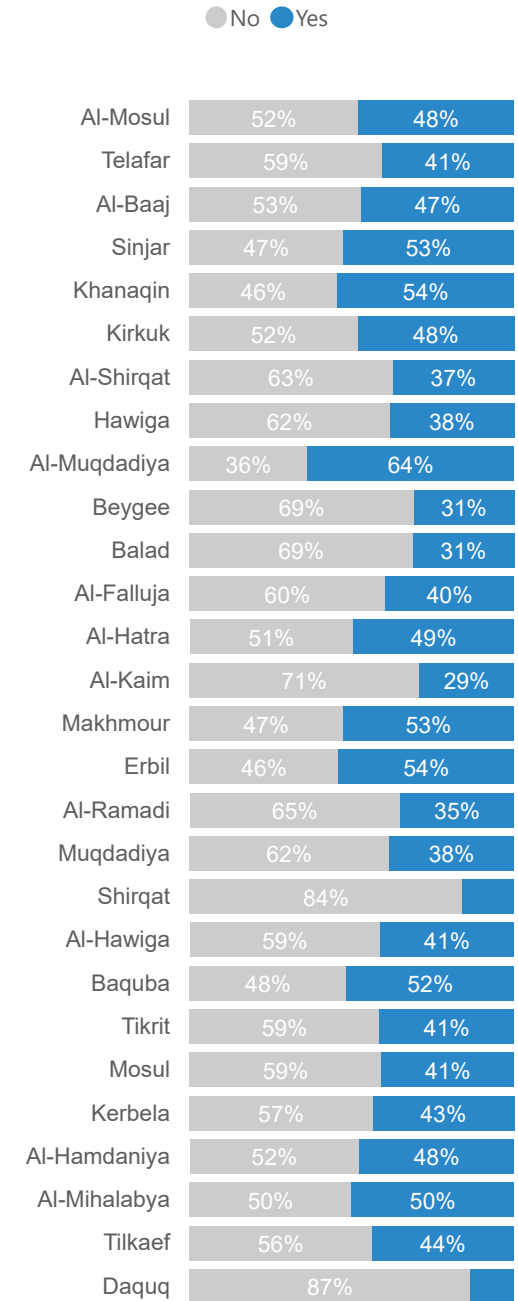
% HHs reporting regular access to sufficient drinking water
