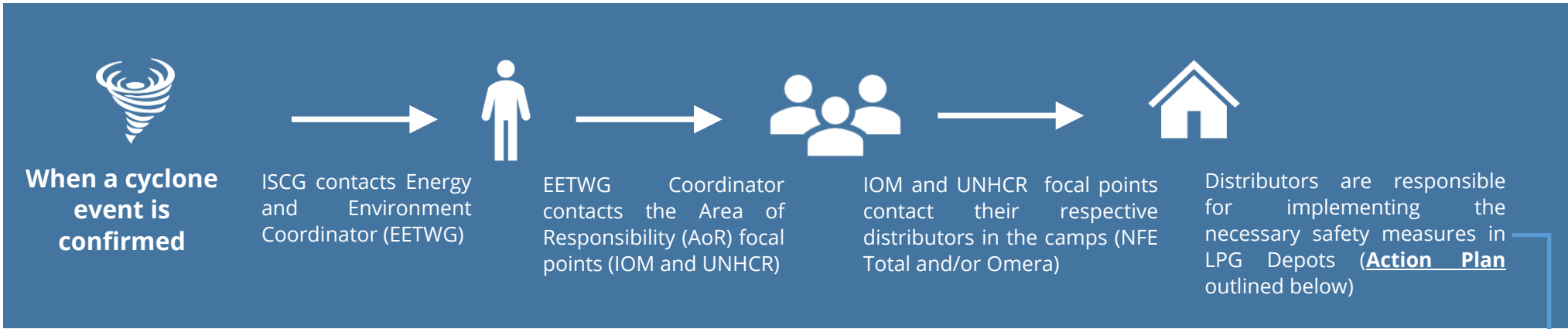


# CYCLONE PREPAREDNESS



## Communication Process & Action Plan for LPG Distribution Points in Cox's Bazar Refugee Camps

COMMUNICATION PROCESS



**Note:** These are preventive measures that do not guarantee to mitigate all risks.

ACTION PLAN FOR DISTRIBUTORS

### Depot Structure

- Each LPG Depot structure is reviewed by the Shelter Sector and EETWG.
- Recommendations for structure improvements are given by Shelter Sector to each LPG Depot.
- Distributors are responsible for implementing those instructions within the timeframe given to them.

### Cylinders and Signage

- All excess LPG cylinders, stoves, and fire safety signage must be taken to Court Bazar for storage.
- Only the allocated amount to meet beneficiaries' needs will be permitted until further notice.
- Distributors must procure chains in advance to tie the remaining cannisters in case the cyclone event is confirmed.

### STEP 1

- Secure any remaining LPG canisters in the Depot by chaining them together.
- If walls are not made of bricks, tie them to the ground.
- Close and lock the doors.

### STEP 2

- Put all fire extinguishers in a secure place, which must be separate from the room where the LPGs are stored.

### STEP 3

- Take photos of the site secured as per these instructions and send them to your respective AoR Focal Points.



### Preparedness

**Risk of cyclone event is high**

**Preparing for Cyclone FANI:** LPG structures were reviewed on 28-29 April 2019; recommendations were given to each structure on 30 April; implementation must be completed by May 2nd. Excess LPG cylinders must be sent to Court Bazar by May 2nd.
